Last Time Out: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies defeated the Reading Fightin Phils 3-1 on Saturday night in ten innings. Binghamton has taken four of the first five games this week to clinch the series victory. With the Ponies down 1-0, Jose Peroza tied the game with an RBI double in the seventh. Hayden Senger then broke the 1-1 tie in the tenth on a two-run double to left to put the Ponies up 3-1. Christian Scott allowed just one run and struck out seven over six innings. William Woods shut the door in the tenth and is now 6-for-6 in save opportunities with Binghamton. The Ponies have won three straight games and seven of their last 10.

Christian's Crushing It: RHP Christian Scott allowed just one run on four hits over six scoreless frames Saturday night, with no walks and seven strikeouts. Over his last four starts, Scott has allowed just five runs (no more than two in a start) and has a strikeout-to-walk ratio of 25-to-1. Scott is carrying just a 2.72 ERA in eight starts since being called up to Double-A Binghamton this year.

Senger Slashing: Hayden Senger delivered the go-ahead two-run double in Saturday night's extra-inning victory over the Fightins. It was his second straight multi-hit game and fifth of the season. Over his last five games, Senger is hitting .316 with three doubles, one home run, and four RBI.

Success in Baseballtown: The Rumble Ponies have taken four of the first five games in this series at Reading. The Ponies currently lead the season series 9-2 over the Fightins, with every game thus far played at FirstEnergy Stadium. In 2022, Binghamton went 12-5 against Reading and went 9-3 on the road against the Fightins.

Woodwork: Ponies RHP William Woods pitched a 1-2-3 tenth to earn the save in Saturday's win. Woods is now 6-for-6 in save opportunities and has earned a save in each of his last five outings. The 24-year-old pitched in two games for the Atlanta Braves last year before the Mets picked him up off waivers this past offseason. He has a 1.80 ERA in 11 appearances with the Rumble Ponies this year.

Coming up: The Rumble Ponies open up a six-game homestand on Tuesday night against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats (Toronto Blue Jays AA Affiliate).

Last Start: Chacin tossed one innings and worked around a walk and an error in a rain-shortened start on Tuesday in the series opener. He did not return to the game after the first rain delay that was 50 minutes long, and the game was suspended in the second inning.

June 8 Start @ Reading: Chacin earned the win after allowing four runs over six innings on June 8 at Reading. That was the last time he spun six innings.

2022: Began the season with Brooklyn (A+) and made four starts before being assigned to Binghamton (AA) on May 2. Chacin had a strong Double-A debut last year on May 4 at Hartford. He went seven innings and struck-out three batters, while allowing two runs on four hits. Chacin led the Rumble Ponies in innings pitched (101.2) and starts (20) in 2022. He finished third in strikeouts (94) for Binghamton. Chacin pitched to a 4-9 record with a 5.67 ERA at the Double-A level in 23 appearances.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo.
