YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Bowie Baysox, 9-4. The Baysox opened the scoring in the second inning with an RBI single by Willy Yahn. The Flying Squirrels took the lead in the third inning after **Andy Sugilio** reached on an infield single and a throwing error allowed two runs to score. Bowie evened the score in the fourth inning with a solo homer by Jaylen Ferguson. The Baysox pulled ahead in the fifth inning with a two-run homer by Patrick Dorrian. In the fifth, **Heliot Ramos** hit a three-run homer to give the Flying Squirrels a 5-4 lead. The Flying Squirrels pulled away in the seventh inning with an RBI double by Ramos and a three-run homer by David Villar.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels played the fifth of a six-game set against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The two teams will face of 24 times this season, with two series in Bowie and two in Richmond.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have dropped five of the last seven games. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 2.0 games behind Erie. Over the last seven games, the Flying Squirrels are batting .220 (50-for-227) as a team. Through the previous 10 games, the Flying Squirrels hit .264 (84-for-318), third-best in the league.

THE BAYSOX are in second in the Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, a half-game behind Erie. Patrick Dorrian was named the Double-A Northeast Player of the Week after hitting .333 with three homers and 11 RBIs last week against Reading. Bowie's roster includes five of MLB.com's Top-30 Orioles prospects, including Adley Rutschman (1), D.L. Hall (4), Terrin Vavra (11), Kyle Bradish (13) and Kevin Smith (17). The Baysox lead all of Double-A in runs scored (94) and rank fifth in batting average (.251). The Baysox have won eight of their last ten games.

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Sam Long makes his fourth start of the season and his first against the Baysox. Last time out, he worked 4.0 scoreless innings and allowed two hits with five strikeouts against the Senators on Sunday. He has picked up five strikeouts in all three of his starts this season. Long signed with San Francisco as a free agent on November 17, 2020. Long was originally drafted by the Tampa Bay Rays in the 18th round in 2016 out of Sacramento State, where he was the Preseason WAC Pitcher of the Year. He climbed high as the Single-A level with Tampa before being released at the beginning of spring training in 2018. In 2019, Long signed as a free agent with the Chicago White Sox and spent the season with the Single-A Kannapolis Intimidators, where he split time between the starting rotation and the bullpen. Long signed with the Giants on November 17, 2020. For more on Long, see page two.

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander David Lebron makes his first start of the season. He has pitched two relief outings on the season for the Baysox. Tonight marks his first Double-A start. Lebron was selected in the 26th round of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Texas Rangers out of NCAA Division II Tampa. He was traded to the Orioles prior to the 2019 season and spent the season at A-Adv. Frederick.

STRONG ARMS: This season, the Flying Squirrels rank third in all of Double-A in ERA (3.02). The Richmond pitching staff also ranks tied for second in shutouts (2), first in saves (7), fifth in fewest runs allowed (56) and fourth in opponents' batting average (.205). Starting pitcher Matt Frisbee is fifth among qualified pitchers in ERA (0.56). He leads Double-A and sits second in all of the minors in WHIP (0.38).

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: The Flying Squirrels' relievers have the best bullpen ERA in all of Minor League Baseball at 1.85 on the season. The bullpen is tied for sixth in the minors are tied for first in Double-A with seven saves. Richmond relievers have allowed the second-fewest earned runs (14), third-fewest runs (19) and fourth-fewest hits (39) in the minors and have the sixth-low-est opponents' batting average (.165).

CLOSING IT OUT: Reliever Patrick Ruotolo is tied for the third in the Double-A Northeast with three saves this season. He is also tied for third in games pitched (6). Last Thursday, Ruotolo pitched the ninth inning to finish a combined no-hitter, the first nine-inning no-hitter in the history of the Flying Squirrels franchise. **Norwith Gudino** is also tied for third in the circuit with three saves on the season.

TOP OF THE CLASS: Adley Rutschman is the fourth player selected No. 1 overall in the MLB Draft to play against the Flying Squirrels at The Diamond. In 2011, Harrisburg's Bryce Harper (2010 Draft) played five games in Richmond, batting .278 (5-for-18) with a double from July 21-24. In 2019, Reading's Mickey Moniak (2016) played six games in Richmond, batting .308 (8-for-26) with two doubles and six RBIs. Also in 2019, Casey Mize (2018) pitched against the Flying Squirrels on July 21 and allowed six runs (five earned) while only recording two outs in his start. Two other top overall draft picks who played in the Eastern League/ Double-A Northeast during the Flying Squirrels' existence, Gerrit Cole (2011 Draft) and Stephen Strasburg (2009 Draft), never pitched at The Diamond.

RAMOS RAKING: Heliot Ramos clubbed his third home run of the season on Friday night at The Diamond. For the season, he is ranked tenth in the Double-A Northeast in slugging percentage (.571), tied for eighth with 17 hits, tied for fifth with six doubles, tied for fourth with nine extra-base hits, tied for fifth with 32 total bases and tied for sixth with 13 runs scored. Of the balls he has put in play, Ramos has gone the opposite way 45.9 percent of the time, which is the tenth-highest rate in the league and the second-highest rate on the team (behind only Kyle Mottice at 52.3 percent, which is second-highest in the league)

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 10-6 record is tied for the second-best start through 16 games in team history, even with their start in 2014 and trailing only an 11-5 start in 2018.

A BUNCH OF SELLOUTS: The Flying Squirrels have sold out their maximum capacity crowds at The Diamond for seven of their eight openings this year. For the first homestand, the Flying Squirrels drew the maximum alloted crowd of 2,943 for all five openings. In the current homestand, the maximum capacity is 3,448. After drawing 3,057 fans on Tuesday (89%), the Flying Squirrels have sold out the last three games. Tonight's game has also sold out. Limited tickets remain for Sunday's homestand finale.

OVER THE MAP: The Flying Squirrels roster contains 18 players from 11 different states across the United States: California (4), Georgia (4), Florida (2) and one player from North Carolina, Minnesota, Illinois, Massachusetts, New York, Missouri, Washington and Ohio. Nine players grew up in four countries and territories outside of the 50 states, including the Dominican Republic (4), Puerto Rico (2), Venezuela (2) and Colombia (1).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have three players included in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects: Heliot Ramos (3), Tristan Beck (12) and Sean Hjelle (13). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Ramos (3), Hjelle (11) and Beck (20) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: On Monday night, 2019 Flying Squirrels outfielder Johneshwy Fargas made his Major League debut for the New York Mets in Atlanta. He picked up his first MLB hit in the game, an RBI double. In 2019, Fargas was named the Flying Squirrels Player of the Year after hitting .249 over 127 games. He also set the franchise's single-season stolen base record with 50 on the year. RICHMOND
