### CONINE SLAMS JACKSONVILLE TO 4-3 WIN

Griffin Conine's grand slam lifted the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp to a 4-3 victory over the Memphis Redbirds in Tuesday's series opener. With Memphis ahead 2-0, **Devyision De Los Santos** started the sixth inning with a base hit. After a pair of outs, **Troy Johnston** was with a pitch and **Diego Infante** walked. Conine followed by blasting his second grand slam of the season to give Jacksonville a 4-2 advantage. Memphis crept a little closer in the seventh. **Mike Antico** led off with a base hit and **Thomas Saggese** walked. After a pair of strikeouts, **Luken Baker** notched an RBI single to cut things to 4-3.

### AGUSTÍN THE GREAT

**Agustín Ramírez** had a slow start to 2024 in the New York Yankees organization. In 29 games with Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, he slashed (.224/.328/.364/.692) with 23 strikeouts. Since joining the Marlins organization on July 26, he's 12-for-37 (.324/.432/.595/1.027) with two home runs, eight RBIs and four multi-hit games. Despite his short time with Jacksonville, Ramírez has one of the lower swinging strike rates on the team at 8.4% while logging one of the higher walk rates (13.6%).

### AIN'T NO SUNSHINE

With last night's 4-3 win over Memphis, Jacksonville has won their 30th game in their last 53 contests. In that time span, the Jumbo Shrimp have struggled, posting the seventh-lowest OPS in Triple-A (.743) while drawing the tied for the fewest walks (174). Of those 53 contests, 37 have been within three runs or fewer with Jacksonville winning 22 (.415). Despite outscoring opponents, 158-140 during this run, the Jumbo Shrimp have hit the fourth-fewest home runs in Triple-A (48).

### WHAT IS (G)LOVE?

Last week, Jacksonville committed seven errors in their six-game set against Toledo, including back-to-back contests with three errors. In 2024, the Jumbo Shrimp have been pretty handy with the glove, committing 75 errors (T-seventh fewest) in Triple-A. However, since 8/1, they have seen their fielding percentage drop to the worst in Triple-A (.964) while committing 13 errors in their last 10 games, tied for the second-most errors in both the IL and PCL. After committing just 5 errors in their previous 10 games.

### ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled this season at 121 Financial Ballpark, mustering a meager 25-32 (.439) record. Jacksonville has scored only 240 runs at home (4.2 per game), the fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are scoring more than a half-run more per game on the road, totaling 273 (4.9 per game). Meanwhile, on the road, Jacksonville has surrendered only 251 runs (4.5 per game), the third-fewest in Triple-A. They've yielded the 12th-fewest runs of any team at home (4.9 per game). On the year, the Jumbo Shrimp are 31-26 on the road. Jacksonville hasn't had a winning record at 121 Financial Ballpark since 2021 & 2022 where they went (36-29) & (38-37) respectively.

### SWIPER NO SWIPING!

Through the first 97 games of the 2024 season, Jacksonville mustered just 49 stolen bases (second-fewest in Triple-A). Since the trade deadline on July 26, the Jumbo Shrimp still haven't logged a ton of stolen bases, just nine. (T-fourth fewest in Triple-A). However, their percentage on attempts has jumped astronomically. During this 16-game stretch, Jacksonville has only been nabbed stealing a base once in 10 attempts (90.0%) vs. 73.1% through the first 97 games of the season.

### LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, **Javier Sanoja** was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 69 of his last 80 games, notching 29 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 102-for-317 (.322/.387/.486/.873) with 24 doubles, five triples, six home runs, 48 RBIs, 35 walks and 43 runs scored. On the season, Sanoja ranks fourth in batting average (.303), tied for third in doubles (26) and fifth in hits (108).

### SHRIMP BITES

Since signing a minor league free agent deal with the Marlins on July 9, 2024, **Adam Oller** has been one of the top righties in the rotation. In five appearances (two starts) he's logged 19.2 innings, posting a 3-0 record with a 2.75 ERA with 18 strikeouts to just six walks. His .186 batting average against is the fourth-lowest among JAX pitchers with at least five games pitched.
