**Fight the Phils:** Reading and Somerset continue a six-game series at FirstEnergy Stadium tonight. Last night, Reading tied the game at four in the ninth but the Patriots scored a run in the top of the tenth and Kevin Gadea stranded the bases loaded in the bottom half for the win. The Patriots took four of six in Bridgewater to start June. Top-five Phillies prospect Bryson Stott debuted at shortstop for Reading against the Patriots in June.

**Bring in the Lefty:** Left-hander JP Sears makes his eighth start of the season tonight for the Patriots. Sears, who began the season as a reliever, is coming off of an outing in which he allowed seven runs on six hits in a loss against the Altoona Curve.

**Shutouts on Shutouts:** The Patriots are tied with Charleston for the lead in all of minor league baseball with 12 shutouts this season. Somerset leads all of the minors (full season) with a 3.25 ERA, .207 batting average against and rank third in WHIP (1.15).

**Extra! Extra!** The Patriots played in the 11th extra inning game last night, the most of any team in the league. Somerset's seven wins in extras also lead the league. Last night, Somerset stranded the placed runner for the 10th time in 17 opportunities and shut out their opponent for the ninth time in extras.

**Where's OsWaldo:** Infielder Oswaldo Cabrera went 2-for-5 with a double last night and has now reached base safely in 17-straight games. It's the longest such streak for Cabrera this season and is the second-longest on-base streak on the team this year. Cabrera has enjoyed three separate 10+ game on-base streaks this season including a 13-game on-base streak to begin the season.

**Belt it Like Beltre:** Outfielder Michael Beltre recorded his team leading 17th multi-hit game last night. With the three-hit effort, Beltre collected multiple hits for the fifth game in July. Beltre is reaching base at a .402 clip in July. Last night, Beltre hit his 12 home run of the season, more than doubling his previous career-high of five home runs in a season (2018). The left-handed hitter is on track to surpass his career home run total (entering the season) this year alone (17 home runs over seven seasons).

**Battering Bastidas:** Infielder Jesus Bastidas went 1-for-4 with a double and a run scored last night. The 22 year-old has now hit safely in each of his first five games at the Double-A level since he was transferred from Low-A Tampa on July 16th. He is currently batting .333 (6-for-18) over this five-game stretch with one home run, four RBI, five runs and a .400 OBP. Additionally, he has scored a run in four of the five games in which he has played.

**Sempl(e)y the Best:** Starting pitcher Shawn Semple was named Double-A Northeast League pitcher of the week for the week of July 20 through the 25. After beginning the season Semple was transferred to Hudson Valley. In his first start back with Somerset last week, Semple tossed six scoreless innings and allowed just two hits in the 10-0 win. It marks the fifth time a Patriot has won the award this season; Glenn Otto (twice), Janson Junk, JP Sears.
