April 25: Baysox 3, RubberDucks 2 (12): Matt Wilkinson struck out seven over 5.1 hitless innings and Akron tied the game in the fourth on a **Guy Lipscomb** sac-fly and took the lead in the 11th on a **Nick Mitchell** sac-bunt, but Chesapeake was able to tie the game in the 11th and won on a walk-off single an inning later.

Today's starter: Khal Stephen makes his fifth start of the season on Sunday. The right-hander is coming off a loss against the Baysox on Tuesday when he allowed two runs over five innings and struck out five. Stephen has worked five innings in his last two starts and has struck out five or more in three of his four starts this season. He ranks top 10 in the Eastern League in ERA (1.53, fifth) and average against (.200, tenth) entering Sunday.

Tugboat: Matt Wilkinson has been on fire to start his Double-A career. The left-hander has not allowed a hit over his last two starts (10.1 innings, 1 run, 2 walks and 13 strikeouts). His 10.1 hitless innings is the longest hitless streak by an Akron pitcher since at least 2005 (**Jeanmar Gomez** 10 IP in 2009; **Giovanni Soto** 9.2IP in 2012). Over his four total starts on the year, Wilkinson is 1-1 with a 1.45 ERA and 24 strikeouts (against five walks) over 18.2 innings pitched. He ranks top 10 in the Eastern League in ERA (1.45, fourth), strikeouts (24, tied-fifth), average against (.141, third) and WHIP (0.75, tied first).

Walk this way: After leading the Eastern League and ranking fourth in all of Double-A in walks in 2025, the RubberDucks batters are once again showing impressive patience in 2026. Akron's 109 walks rank second in the Eastern League and tied fourth in Double-A through the season's first 20 games. The RubberDucks have four players with double digit walks in 2026, including the Eastern League leader in walks **Angel Genao** who has 18 free passes. **Nick Mitchell** (14), **Jake Fox** (12) and **Ralph Velazquez** (10) are the other Akron hitters to work double digit walks this season.

Historic Sunday: The Akron RubberDucks tossed their sixth no-hitter in franchise history (since 1989) on Sunday, April 19 in a 4-0 win over Binghamton. **Matt Wilkinson**, **Matt Jachec**, **Magnus Ellerts**, **Jay Driver** and **Jack Carey** combined for the no-hitter with Wilkinson starting the game off with five perfect innings. It was the first no-hitter by the RubberDucks since **Ryan Merritt's** no-no against Reading on July 11, 2015 (7 innings). It was the first nine inning no-hitter by Akron since **Giovanni Soto** no-hit Altoona on July 15, 2012. It was the first combined no-hitter by the RubberDucks since July 7, 2003 when **Chad Durbin** and **Oscar Alvarez** combined to no-hit Bowie on July 7, 2003, also by a 4-0 final score. Long-time RubberDucks press box employee Joe Jastrzemski was the official scorer for April 19th's no-hitter as well as Ryan Merritt's no-hitter.

RubberDucks and Baysox: Akron is facing Chesapeake for the first of four series this season and the first of two in Bowie. In 2025, the RubberDucks went 11-6 against the Baysox including 4-2 in Maryland. All time Akron is 348-279 against Chesapeake. Top prospects in the series includes:

Having a month: **Wuifredo Antunez** launched his fifth home run of the season on April 24. Antunez is now tied for the team lead in homers along with **Alfonsin Rosario**. Both are tied for fifth in the Eastern League and second in the Guardians organization in long balls. Antunez and Rosario are only one home run away from tying **Wes Hodges** (2008), **Carlos Santana** (2009), **Nellie Rodriguez** (2016) and **Yu Chang** (2017) for most homers by an Akron hitter in April since 2005.

Grand swings: **Ralph Velazquez** launched his first professional grand slam in the RubberDucks win over Chesapeake on April 24. It was Akron's second grand slam of the season joining **Alex Mooney**, who hit one on April 7 in Harrisburg. Akron launched just one grand slam in 2025 (**Angel Genao** on Aug. 26 in Richmond) and have two April grand slams for the first time since **Armando Camacaro** (April 6) and **Wes Hodges** (April 15) in 2008.

Genao's hot start: **Angel Genao** is on fire in 2026. The second-year shortstop is batting .294/.443/.426 with 20 hits (leads Akron), two home runs and nine RBI in 19 games played. He has worked 18 walks, which is first in the Eastern League. He tied a RubberDucks single-game franchise record on April 8 by working four walks in a game. He became the first Akron hitter to work four walks in a game since **CJ Kayfus** against Erie on July 1, 2024. Genao has reached base in all 18 games he has started this season.

Akron Homers: The RubberDucks have powered 21 home runs through the first 20 games of the season. Those 21 home runs have Akron fourth in the Eastern League and 12th in Double-A in home runs. Akron's 21 home runs in 20 games have the RubberDucks on pace to have their second most home runs in April since at least 2005: 27 April home runs in 2016, 24 April homers in 2008, 23 April homers in 2017, 18 April home runs in 2013 and 16 April home runs in 2006, 2023, 2024 and 2025.

2026 RUBBERDUCKS FIELD STAFF

#26 Manager Greg DiCenzo enters his sixth season with the Guardians organization. The 2025 season will be DiCenzo's third as RubberDucks manager, and fifth as a manager in Cleveland's organization. He's led the RubberDucks to a 157-118 record in two seasons as Akron's manager including an Eastern League playoff appearance in 2024.

Prior to becoming Triple-A Columbus' bench coach in 2023, DiCenzo spent the 2021 and 2022 seasons as the manager in High-A Lake County. He guided the Captains to a 141-108 record in his two seasons including a Midwest League finals appearance in 2022.

A native of Duxbury, MA, DiCenzo was the head baseball coach at Holy Cross for 12 seasons prior to joining the Cleveland organization. The Crusaders went 137-109 in Patriot League play during his tenure, including a 2017 Patriot League Championship, and posted 20-win seasons in 10 of those 12 years.

#48 Hitting Coach Jordan Becker enters his seventh season with the Guardians organization and third with the RubberDucks. In 2023, Becker served as the hitting coach for Lake County.

Becker joined the Cleveland organization in 2019 after a collegiate coaching career that saw stops at Riverside Community College and New Mexico State University.

#43 Hitting Coach Cole Nieto enters his fifth season in the Guardians organization and first season in Akron. Nieto joins the RubberDucks after serving as the hitting coach for the Lynchburg Hillcats in 2024 and their Carolina League championship season in 2025.

A graduate of St. Ignatius High School in Cleveland, Nieto played four years at Baldwin Wallace University in Berea. While at Baldwin Wallace, he hit .341 with 17 home runs and 109 RBI in 137 career games.

#55 Pitching Coach Angus Adams enters his first season in the Guardians organization and first season in Akron. Prior to joining the RubberDucks, Adams served as a performance coach for Tread Athletics and was a pitching coach at Elmira College.

#54 Pitching Coach Michael Poole enters his fourth season in the Guardians organization and third season with the RubberDucks. He will be a pitching coach in 2025 after spending 2024 as Akron's assistant pitching coach. Prior to joining the RubberDucks, Poole was the pitching development coach on the Arizona Complex Academy staff.

A native of [Akron](#), Poole played at Cuyahoga Community College and Lake Erie College before starting his coaching career at Inspiration Academy (FL) in 2019. Poole was an assistant coach at LSU-Eunice for the Bengals D2 JUCO World Series Championship season in 2021.

#33 Bench Coach Yan Rivera enters his fifth season in the Guardians organization and first season in Akron. Prior to coming to Akron, Rivera spent 2025 as the bench coach for Lake County and 2024 as the manager for the ACL Guardians.

Rivera is the son of former Cleveland minor league manager and Toronto Blue Jays coach Luis Rivera.

#47 Development Coach Gustavo Nava enters his second season with the Guardians organization and first season with the RubberDucks. Prior to coming to Akron, Nava served as the Development coach for Lynchburg in their 2025 Carolina League championship season.

Athletic Trainer Derrik Diaz enters his ninth season in the Guardians organization and third season with the RubberDucks. Diaz was the Eastern League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2024. Prior to coming to Akron, Diaz served as the head athletic trainer for the Dominican Republic Complex in 2023.

Assistant Athletic Trainer Laura Gutiérrez-Sogel enters her third season in the Guardians organization and first season in Akron. Prior to coming to the RubberDucks, Gutiérrez-Sogel spent the 2025 season as the Assistant Athletic Trainer in Lake County.

Strength and Conditioning Coach Jack Baldwin enters his third season with the Guardians organization and first season in Akron. Prior to joining the RubberDucks, Baldwin served as the Strength and Conditioning coach for Lynchburg in 2025.

Mental Performance Coach Andie McGregor enters her third season with the Guardians. She previously worked as a Mental Performance Coach at IMG Academy, supporting middle school, high school and post-grad student athletes in the baseball program. Also served as a Mental Performance intern with the New York Mets, working with the FCL Mets during the 2021 season. Has a Master of Science in Educational Psychology – Sport Psychology at Florida State University and a Bachelor of Science in Exercise Science at Georgia College & State University.

Baseball Technology Fellow Ryan Chambliss enters his first season in Akron. He spent the 2025 season with the Guardians ACL affiliate.

We Are the RubberDucks

On October 29, 2013, then team owner **Ken Babby** and general manager **Jim Pfander** stood before a capacity audience at the Akron Civic Theater and announced that the team would be known henceforth as the **Akron RubberDucks**. In addition to being symbolic of the fun, family-friendly brand of entertainment offered by minor league baseball, the name also honors Akron's long history as the "**Rubber Capital of the World**." Brandiose Marketing of San Diego, California designed the team logo, colors, and various marks and insignias. Please note that for print coverage, *RubberDucks* is spelled as one word with a capital "D." In broadcast coverage, referring to the team as "*the 'Ducks*" is an acceptable variation of the team's nickname.
