NW ARKANSAS NATURALS (16-27, 45-65) vs. SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (27-16, 58-53)

LHP HUNTER OWEN (1-6, 7.70 ERA) vs. RHP DANIEL EAGEN (5-9, 4.92 ERA)

SETTING THE SCENE: The Cardinals continue their 6-game series with Game 5 against the Naturals (Royals) at Route 66 Stadium ... the Cardinals have won 3 of the first 4 games ... RHP Daniel Eagen makes his Cardinals home debut against LHP Hunter Owen ... Are you ready for it? It's In Our Cardinals Red Era Night at Route 66 Stadium.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: The Cards sit in 1st place in the 2nd half North Division standings, 1.0 game ahead of 1st-half champ Tulsa and 7.0 games up on 3rd-place Wichita ... the 2nd half winner (or 2nd-place finisher if Tulsa is 1st) plays Tulsa in the playoffs ... Springfield is trying to make the playoffs for a 5th-straight year.

DAN THE MAN: RHP Daniel Eagen makes his 2nd start for the Cardinals and his 22nd start in the Texas League ... in his Cardinals org debut on 8/8 at San Antonio he allowed 3 runs on 3 hits with 6 strikeouts and 2 walks over 6.0 innings ... acquired from Arizona along with LHP Sandro Santana for OF Lars Nootbaar at the deadline ... had 20 starts for Amarillo prior to trade including on 7/19 at Route 66 Stadium against Springfield when he allowed 1 run on 2 hits in 5.0 innings.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cardinals erased a 7-run deficit and came back to win 9-8 on Friday ... IF Dakota Harris hit 2 home runs including the go-ahead shot in the 8th inning ... IF Tre Richardson III and IF Daniel Ortiz also homered ... RHP Chen Wei Lin allowed 2 runs over the final 4.0 innings to pick up the win ... RHP Tanner Franklin gave up 6R/4ER in his first start at Route 66 Stadium.

COMEBACK CARDS: The Cardinals overcame a 7-run deficit on Friday night to mark their biggest comeback win of the season ... previous biggest comeback was 5 runs on 6/28 vs. NW Arkansas.

MAKE IT RAIN: C Rainiel Rodriguez went 1x3 with a 2B on Friday to extended his hitting streak to 8 games ... since June 1 he leads the TXL with a 1.014 OPS ... ranks 3rd overall in the TXL with a .297 avg and 4th with a .901 OPS ... has hit safely in 15 of his last 16 games ... is ranked the top prospect in the Cardinals system by MLB Pipeline.

OH, DOYLE RULES: LHP Liam Doyle allowed 1 run over a career-high 6.0 IP on Thursday night to record his first career quality start ... struck out 6, walked 4, and allowed only 2 hits ... Doyle leads the league with a 1.88 ERA and .183 opponent batting average in the 2nd half ... has not allowed more than 2ER in any of his 7 starts during that time.

BYE, BYE, BAEZ: IF Jesus Baez slugged his 16th Double-A homer in his 35th game with the Cards on Tuesday ... has 30 combined home runs this season including his time with High-A Peoria ... is riding a 10-game hitting streak during which he's hitting .350 (14x40) with 4 HR and 13 RBI.
