### NOTES

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Binghamton Rumble Ponies sprinted past the Portland Sea Dogs, 8-0, on Thursday at Mirabito Stadium in their third shutout win of the season. **Brandon Sproat** tossed six scoreless, **Jordan Geber** went two innings, and **Paul Gervase** finished the shutout in the ninth. Binghamton exploded for six runs in the eighth inning. **Alex Ramirez**, **Duke Ellis**, **JT Schwartz**, and **Kevin Parada** recorded multi-hit games. **Rowdey Jordan** and **Wyatt Young** had multi-RBI games.

**SPROATACTULAR:** Mets No. 13 prospect **Brandon Sproat** tossed six scoreless frames in the win on Thursday. Sproat lowered his Double-A ERA to 1.94 and his season ERA to 1.61 across High-A Brooklyn and Double-A Binghamton. The first-year pro currently ranks 5th in full-season Minor League Baseball with a 1.61 ERA. Binghamton has won each of Sproat's last six starts and the 2023 second-round pick is 3-0 with a 43-10 strikeout-to-walk ratio in seven Double-A starts.

**DOUBLE DIP:** The Binghamton Rumble Ponies will play a doubleheader with the Portland Sea Dogs tonight, which marks their fourth double dip of the season. Binghamton has split two and was swept in one of its twin bills. It is the first doubleheader for Binghamton since being swept by Hartford on May 1 at home. The Ponies have had three of their six games in the doubleheaders go to extra innings.

**SCHWARTZ THE FORCE:** First baseman **JT Schwartz** has been on a tear. After going 2-for-4 with a walk and two runs on Thursday, Schwartz has now reached base in 14-straight games. Over his 14-game on-base streak, the 24-year-old is hitting .340 with a .456 OBP, .924 OPS, 10 walks and just three strikeouts. He has 16 hits, three doubles, one home run, four runs batted in and five runs scored in that span too. Schwartz is currently second in the Eastern League in OBP (.403) and tied for fourth in the EL in walks (36).

**GUTS, GLORY, RAM:** Mets No. 16 prospect **Alex Ramirez** recorded his team-leading 15th multi-hit game on Thursday and is riding a four-game hit streak. Ramirez has recorded at least one hit in eight of his last nine games. Over his last nine games, dating back to June 16, Ramirez is hitting .378 with a .429 OBP, a .996 OPS, 14 hits, one home run, nine runs batted in, and six runs scored. The 21-year-old is hitting .500 (8-for-16) with three RBIs and three runs during his four-game hit streak.

**CLIFFORD THE BIG DOG:** Mets No. 4 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 74 overall prospect **Ryan Clifford** currently leads all of Minor League Baseball with 61 walks, across High-A Brooklyn and Double-A Binghamton. The 20-year-old has reached base safely in 22 of his last 24 games and in 27 of his last 30 games. In 20 games in the month of June, Clifford has a .412 on-base percentage and 1.029 OPS with seven home runs, four doubles, 17 runs batted in, 22 walks, and 18 runs scored.

**JACKSON #5:** Infielder **Jeremiah Jackson** has hits in nine of his last 10 games, hitting .308 over that span with two homers and five RBIs. He is hitting .290 in 18 games in June, after he hit just .179 in April & .148 in May.

**LAST START:** McLean allowed five runs on four hits and two walks over 2.1 innings with four strikeouts in the loss at Akron last Friday...McLean faced the minimum six batters over his first two innings, but allowed a three-run homer and two-run homer in the third inning.

**2024 SEASON:** Began the season with High-A Brooklyn...Went 2-2 with a 2.57 ERA and 36 strikeouts in 28 innings across seven starts for the Cyclones...Hit .222 with an .849 OPS, five home runs, and 13 runs batted in over 25 games as the Cyclones' designated hitter...Made Double-A pitching debut on May 22 at Reading.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Jarvis earned his first professional save with five strikeouts over three innings in relief, while allowing just two hits and one unearned run at Akron last Saturday night...Jarvis struck out the side in the seventh in his first inning of work...He struck out the first four batters and five of the first six batters that he faced.

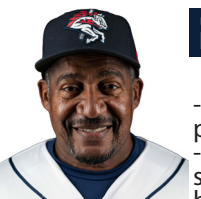

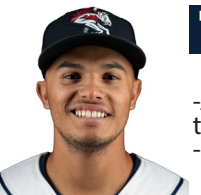
