Tonight, the Reading Fightin Phils continue a six-game series with the New Hampshire Fisher Cats. It is the third matchup of the season between the teams, as Reading won last year's season-series 11-8. The Fightin Phils went 7-5 at home and 4-2 on the road against New Hampshire. The teams see each other for three more series this season, with one more at home and two at New Hampshire.

Back on Track

Last night, the R-Phils rode a quality start from Tyler Phillips to even the series with a 6-5 victory. Phillips was perfect through five innings, before allowing a base runner in the sixth. Johan Rojas went three-for-four with a run scored, while Carlos De La Cruz and Matthew Kroon each addeed multiple hits as well. Taylor Lehman, Tyler McKay and Brett Schulze combined out of the bullpen for two holds and a save.

Carlos De La Cruzin'

Carlos De La Cruz is picking up where he left off during the first home stand of the season. De La Cruz is riding a seven-game hit streak and has reached base in his last 12 games. So far in May, De La Cruz is hitting .400 with two home runs and six RBI.

Kroon Crushing It

After a bit of a slow spell, Matthew Kroon is heating up as of late. Kroon currently is riding a four game hitting streak and has reached base in his last eight games. Over his last five games Kroon is hitting .444 and added a couple more hits and a RBI last night. Kroon set a season-high with five RBI last Saturday at Hartford.

Chasing 1K

R-Phils Manager Al Pedrique is closing in on a couple of milestones in his stories managerial career. Including winter ball, last night's win gave Pedrique 1,000 wins in his career. But, when including just minor and major league wins, Pedrique needs to get to 46 wins this season to achieve the mark of 1,000 professional wins in affiliated baseball.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies finished off a two-game series with the Blue Jays with a 2-1 walk-off victory in ten innings yesterday. Lehigh Valley picked up an 8-4 win over Memphis to even their series. Jersey Shore fell 8-4 to Greensboro, while Clearwater picked up a 9-4 win over Dunedin to improve to 22-7 on the season. The Phillies, R-Phils and Threshers all are matching up against the Blue Jays or their affiliates this week.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 11, 1967: The Phillies are rained out for the 5th straight time at home as wet weather washes out their scheduled battle with Pawtucket. The Phils had seen seven of their first 11 home dates postponed due to inclement weather.

New Opponent

For the first time this season, Reading and New Hampshire meet. The Fisher Cats are 14-14 this season and won four-of-six games at home against Harrisburg last week. After dropping the first two of the series, New Hampshire was won four straight. After this week, New Hampshire returns home for a six-game series against Binghamton.

The Case on Kloffenstein

Righty, Adam Kloffenstein gets the start on the mound for New Hampshire tonight. He is making his sixth start of the season and owns a 2-2 record and 2.52 ERA. Over 25 innings pitched, Kloffenstein has allowed just 20 hits and 10 walks, while picking up 30 strikeouts. Opponents are hitting just .222 against him. Last time out, he went six-strong innings at Harrisburg, allowing no runs on seven hits with eight strikeouts in the win. He split 2022 between Vancouver and New Hampshire, combining to go 2-7 with a 5.54 ERA over 25 games and 24 starts.

Phillies Number Three Prosepct. Started season on injured list.McGarry has been a prospect since his high school days, when he was a late-round pick of the Rangers before honoring his commitment to Virginia. With the Cavaliers, he showed off his premium arm strength as well as a lack of familiarity with the strike zone, making him an intriguing, yet enigmatic college arm in 2021. The Phillies thought McGarry's stuff was worth taking in the fifth round, and he pitched his way from High-A to Triple-A in his first full season of pro ball. If you're just evaluating pure stuff, McGarry could be considered one of the better pitching prospects in the game. He's flirted with 100 mph in the past and was up to 99 mph at the upper levels in 2022, averaging over 95 mph. It's an elite pitch not just because of velocity, but because of his vertical approach angle as well. His mid-80s slider can be plus at times, missing a ton of bats, and he fools hitters with an upper-70s curve too. He doesn't throw his changeup nearly as much as the breaking stuff, but it has characteristics of a plus pitch. He added a hard cutter at the end of last year to give him a potential five-pitch mix. How often McGarry can land his elite-level stuff in the strike zone will determine exactly what he can be in the big leagues. A 13.9 K/9 rate to start off his pro career shows he can fool pro hitters, but even with some improvements since joining the Phillies, he's walked 5.4 per nine entering 2023. There's hope that as he adds mass to his loose 6-foot-2 frame, he can keep refining his delivery and throw enough strikes to start, a role he'll continue for now unless there's a need as a reliever in Philadelphia.

They found a bargain later on in the period, in January of 2018, when they inked Rojas for just \$10K. In each of his two years of full season ball, he's started slowly but finished well offensively, showing off his plus speed and defense at all stops. He made it to Double-A for the first time in 2022 and then finished with a strong performance in the Arizona Fall League before getting added to the 40-man roster. Rojas has shown he can be an impact player on both sides of the ball thanks to his near-top-of-the-scale speed. He's an elite baserunner, one who stole 62 bases in 67 tries last season and then went 13-for-13 in the AFL. His speed is an obvious asset in the outfield, where he is a premium defender in center field, one who could be a Gold Glov.
