TONIGHT'S GAME: The Quakes continue a nine-game, 11-day road trip tonight, with the fifth game of a six-game set at Banner Island Ballpark, as they take on the Stockton Ports (OAK).

VS THE PORTS: This is the ninth of what will now be 10 meetings between the two clubs in 2024 and the fifth of six at Banner Island Ballpark. The Quakes and Ports lost two games due to rain back in Rancho's opening home stand of 2024, with the Quakes winning three of four prior to the final two games getting rained out. With last night's loss, Rancho is 6-2 against Stockton in 2024. In 2023, the Quakes went 7-5 against the Ports, 3-3 here in Stockton.

LAST GAME: The Ports ended Rancho's three-game winning streak on Friday night, scoring four times in the bottom of the seventh for a come-from-behind 5-3 win at Banner Island Ballpark. A three-run double by Esteury Ruiz off Rancho reliever Callum Wallace (1-4) put Stockton ahead to stay. Rancho got RBI hits from Alexander Albertus and Jesus Galiz, in addition to the first career home run from Kendall George, helping them build a 3-1 lead. Rancho starter Luke Fox pitched three scoreless innings, allowing one hit while striking out six in the no-decision. Stockton reliever Tom Reisinger (3-1) got the win in relief, Stockton's first of the series.

ON-DECK*ER*: Cameron Decker has been on fire since rejoining the club from the Arizona Complex League on June 28. Last night, he went 0-for-4 though, snapping a ten-game hitting streak. Since rejoining Rancho on June 28, he's hitting .333 with four homers and 11 RBIs in 13 games. Decker started the year with Rancho, but hit just .143 with two RBIs over his first nine games, before being sent to the ACL. Decker also appeared in 19 games for the Quakes back in 2023, hitting just .203 with ten RBIs over those 19 games.

FUTURE BOYS: A former Quake and a current Quake are slated to participate in Sunday's annual All-Star Futures Game in Arlington Texas. 2023 Quakes catcher Thayron Liranzo and 2024 Quakes infielder Jeral Perez will both represent the Los Angeles Dodgers. Liranzo, who's currently in the High-A Midwest League playing for the Great Lakes Loons, is ranked as the Dodgers' eighth best prospect, while Perez is ranked 17th. The game can be seen on MLB Network with first pitch at 1pm Pacific.

SECOND HALF STUFF: In order to make the playoffs in 2024, the Quakes must win the second half, or else finish second in the South Division's second-half race, while having the first-half champion Storm win the division again. The Storm will meet the second-half winner or the team with the next best second-half record. Lake Elsinore last went to the playoffs in 2022, when they won the Cal League title. Modesto won the North Division First Half Title.

ROQUE GUTIERREZ: Right-hander Roque Gutierrez makes his fourth start of the year and his 19th overall appearance, his second appearance and first start against Stockton. In his only outing against the Ports, he allowed just two hits with four strikeouts over four scoreless innings in a no-decision at LoanMart Field on April 12. In his last outing, he six runs (five earned) on seven hits over just 3.1 innings in a loss at Visalia on July 6. Gutierrez was signed by the Dodgers out of Guasave, Mexico in 2020.

STEVEN ECHAVARRIA: Right-hander Steven Echavarría will make his 13th start of the year and his first against the Quakes. In his last outing overall, he allowed one unearned run on three hits over 4.2 innings in a no-decision against San Jose on July 5. Echavarría was a third-round pick (72 overall) in the 2023 draft out of Millburn High School in Millburn, New Jersey.
