#### FRES-NOTES

FRESNO GROWERS CAN'T PLANT A WIN: The Fresno Growers (24-18) were uprooted by the Visalia Rawhide (17-25) 6-3 Friday night from Chukchansi Park. Fresno fell to 24-4 at home and 45-13 all-time against the Rawhide. The Growers have still won 23 of their last 29 contests against their Highway 99 rivals. Fresno dropped to 0-4 on Friday home games and have split the first four contests of the series versus Visalia. The Growers planted two runs in the bottom of the sixth, cutting the deficit to three. Fells Frena whacked a single to center, notching GJ Hill and Braylen Wimmer. In the bottom of the ninth, Fresno tried to harvest a comeback win. A Ben McCabe single, Hill free pass and wild pitch put two runners into scoring position. Then, Aldan Longwell ripped a single to left, inching home McCabe. With runners at the corners and two outs, Wimmer hit into a force out, concluding the contest. Wimmer was the tying run at the dish. Stu Flesland III was disgustingly good out of the bullpen, catching two batters looking for strikeouts. Flesland III dazzled for three innings, the most by a Fresno reliever in a game this season. Fresno's lineup struck out 15 times, the most by their offense this season. Fresno's staff punched out five batters, tying their lowest amount of strikeouts this year.

HIGHWAY 99: The Fresno Grizzlies and Visalia Rawhide (Arizona Diamondbacks Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game series tonight at Chukchansi Park. This is the first of two regular season series between the clubs in 2024 and the only meeting in Fresno. The Grizzlies are 24-4 at home (three sweeps) and 45-13 all-time against the Rawhide. The Grizzlies have also won 23 of their last 29 contests against their Highway 99 rivals. On the other side, four of the Rawhide's 13 wins have come via one-run walk-offs. The two cities are 39.26 miles from one another, or if you drive non-stop, 43 minutes or so. From Fresno to Visalia, you would drive in a southeast direction, following the CA 99 route.

**COUPET GETS THE NOD:** Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to LHP Isaiah Coupet. Coupet was selected by the Rockies in the 4th round (Pick 109) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Ohio State. The lefty joined Fresno for three games at the tail end of the 2023 season, all in relief. Coupet is known for generating more than 3,000 RPM on both his slider and curveball.

AN ACE IN JACE: Grizzlies' RHP Jace Kaminska has been lights out over seven starts this season. Kaminska is 3-1 with a 1.26 ERA and 0.87 WHIP, with the latter two ranking first among qualified pitchers in the California League. In 35.2 innings, he has allowed five runs (all earned), on 24 hits, seven walks and two hit-by-pitches while punching out 39. Kaminska started two of Fresno's five shutout wins this season. He has tossed 18 straight scoreless innings (spanning three starts), allowing 12 hits and four walks while striking out 18.

WELINTON WINS CALIFORNIA LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Grizzlies' LHP Welinton Herrera was named by Minor League Baseball as the California League Pitcher of the Week for May 13-19. Herrera's dominant relief outings in Stockton helped the Grizzlies earn a series victory against the Ports. Herrera appeared twice out of the bullpen during the six-game series against Stockton. On Tuesday, May 14, Herrera hurled two perfect innings, striking out three of the six batters he faced (24 pitches, 18 strikes). Then, on Saturday, May 18, Herrera chucked a season-high three innings of sensational relief. Herrera did not permit a hit or run, walking one batter and fanning five (37 pitches, 24 strikes). Overall, Herrera dazzled for five shutout frames, allowing no hits or run, walking one and punching out eight. The 20-year-old Dominican gives the 2024 Grizzlies their second California League award this season (Jack Mahoney). Fresno won 10 California League honors (Weekly and Monthly) in 2023 and 14 California League honors (Weekly and Monthly) in 2022, a franchise record. More on Herrera below.

HERRERA IS NOT HORSING AROUND: Grizzlies' LHP Welinton Herrera has been unbelievable out of the bullpen this season. Over 13 games, Herrera is 4-1 with a 2.29 ERA and 0.76 WHIP, while opponents are batting 169 against him. In 19.2 frames, Herrera has permitted five runs (earned), on 12 hits, three walks and three hit-by-pitches while fanning 38 batters. The southpaw has 11 consecutive scoreless outings from April 12-May 22. Herrera has tossed 17 innings, allowing six hits, three walks and one hit-by-pitch while striking out 33 in that stretch. The 20-year-old is in his second season stateside and grew up on a ranch with horses in the Dominican Republic.

RISP IS A RISK: In the month of May, the Grizzlies hold an 11-11 record with 71 total runs scored (3.25 runs a game). A big reason for the lack of offense is the Grizzlies' inability to score with runners in scoring position (RISP). Over the 22 games in the month, Fresno is 43-for-186 (.231) with five different instances where the team went 0-fer with runners in scoring position. They have also left 174 runners on base in May.

A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ: Grizzlies INF Andy Perez has had an outstanding season (40 games), going 44-for-160 (.275 AVG/.326 OBP/.425 SLG/.751 OPS) with four homers (one grand slam), three triples, six doubles, 22 RBI, 17 runs, 12 walks and two stolen bases. Perez had hit safely in his first 18 games and 23 of first 24 games to start the season, his longest hit streak while in a Fresno uniform. It was the second longest hit streak in the Grizzlies/Rockies affiliation since Drew Romo in 2021 (21 games, July 6-August 15) and it was the longest active streak in Minor League Baseball at the time. Perez went 26-for-76 (.342 AVG/.383 OBP/.579 SLG/.962 OPS) with three homers (one grand slam), three triples, three doubles, 18 RBI, 12 runs, five walks and two stolen bases in that hit streak stretch. Perez's triple on April 24th against San Jose was his 10th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him three triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

HITMAN HINCHMAN AND HILL: Grizzlies' OF/1B Jason Hinchman has reached base safely in 17 straight games and 25 of 26 contests this season (April 26-May 24 for the streak). In those 17 games, Hinchman is 15-for-52 (288) with 13 walks. Grizzlies' OF/2B GJ Hill has reached base safely in 11 straight games and 13 of 14 contests since joining Fresno (April 30-May 24 for the streak). In those 11 games, Hill is 6-for-37 (162) with 10 walks.
