LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn took down Hudson Valley in a Wednesday matinee, 3-1...The victory marked the Cyclones' fourth straight win - good for their third four-game winning streak of the season...RHP **Kade Morris** dazzled in his High-A debut, tossing six innings while surrendering only one run and one walk; Morris also picked up seven strikeouts...Offensively, Brooklyn did most of its damage in the home third, when CF **Nick Morabito** singled home a run, and 3B **William Lugo** drew a bases-loaded walk, giving **Gilbert Gomez's** squad a 2-1 lead that it would never surrender...RHPs **Brett Banks** and **Jimmy Loper** each picked up hitless holds, while RHP Josh Hejka notched a five-out save.

GET YOUR NEW YORK SPORTS, HERE! Thursday night's contest between Brooklyn and Hudson Valley will be broadcast live on SNY...The game marks the first of four Cyclones games that will grace SNY's airwaves this season...The TV home of the New York Mets, SNY has also aired live games of Triple-A Syracuse and Double-A Binghamton, giving fans free access to see their future Mets in action...The remaining Cyclones games on SNY include June 6 and 7 against Aberdeen, and August 21 when Brooklyn hosts Jersey Shore...Cyclones broadcasters **Justin Roche** and **Johnny Gadomowitz** will provide live play-by-play commentary for all four contests.

KADE YOU DIG IT: RHP **Kade Morris** put on a show in his High-A debut on Wednesday afternoon against Hudson Valley...The 2023 third-round selection by the Mets tossed 6.0 innings, giving up only one run on four hits, while striking out seven and walking only one batter, all en route to earning his first career win...RHP **Jonah Tong** tossed 6.2 innings in a win vs. Hudson Valley on Tuesday, marking the first time Brooklyn has received quality starts in consecutive days since RHP **Tyler Stuart** (6.0 IP) and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (6.0) accomplished the feat on July 5 and 6, 2023, at Wilmington...Among Mets' farmhands with 30.0+ innings pitched, Morris is second in innings pitched (40.2), fourth in strikeouts (45), and seventh in ERA (3.32).

MORABITO FUEL: OF **Nick Morabito** had his 10-game South Atlantic League and 21-game overall on-base streak snapped on Tuesday...From April 20 to May 18, the third-year pro hit .437/.545/.493/1.038 with 16 runs scored, four doubles, four RBI, and 19 stolen bases...The 21-year-old is fourth in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.487), sixth in stolen bases (23), ninth in batting average (.363), 13th in wRC+ (179), and 17th in wOBA (.458)...Morabito stole three bases last Wednesday and did it again last Saturday...That mark is tied for the most by a Cyclone in the previous 23 years...The McLean, Va. native enters the day tied for ninth in the South Atlantic League in stolen bases (12) despite playing just 12 games.

JONAH'S WHALE OF A START: RHP **Jonah Tong** earned his first High-A and South Atlantic League victory on Tuesday, tossing a career-high 6.2 innings of one-run ball...The 6.2 innings of work was the longest by a Brooklyn starter this year...It was the longest start by a Cyclone since RHP **Jordany Ventura** tossed 6.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in a win vs. Aberdeen on August 9, 2023...The 20-year-old stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames...In nine appearances (even starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 2-0 with a 0.95 ERA (4 ER in 38.0 IP)...Tong is second among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball in ERA (0.95)...Only Arizona's LHP **Spencer Giesting** (0.66) at High-A Hillsboro has a lower mark...The Markham, Ont. native is also fifth among qualifiers in MiLB in strikeout rate (38.3%) and his strikeout-to-walk rate (28.6%) is eighth...Tong's 59 strikeouts are the ninth-most in the minors.

START ME UP: The Cyclones' starting rotation has been one of the best in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Brooklyn holds the best ERA for starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League at 2.64...The Cyclones have the only starting staff with a sub-3.00 ERA in the circuit and hold a mark 0.75 runs better than the next team (Aberdeen; 3.39)...That ERA is also third at the High-A level and fifth among full-season MiLB squads...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro holds the best mark in the minors and the level (2.25).

HOME COOKING: The Cyclones enter play on Thursday with a 14-6 record at Maimonides Park, but a 8-13 record in opposing ballparks...So far in 2024, Brooklyn holds the fifth-best home ERA (2.19) in Minor League Baseball...Chicago-AL's Double-A Birmingham (2.01) has the lowest mark in MiLB...Additionally, the Cyclones are fourth in opposing OPS (.560) and sixth in batting average against (.198) in home games...In visiting parks, the Cyclones' ERA is 4.70...They also maintain a .685 opposing OPS and a .245 batting average against on the road.

LARRUPIN' LORUSSO: INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The 23-year-old is tied for fourth in the South Atlantic League in triples (2) and tied for seventh in doubles (9)...Among Mets' minor leaguers, Lorusso is tied for third in doubles (9) and triples (2), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (15), tied for seventh in RBI (22), eighth in slugging (.483), and tied for eighth in total bases (58).

GET THOSE STEPS IN: The Cyclones' offense worked a season-high 12 walks in last Saturday's win over Bowling Green...Brooklyn's previous season-high was 11 on April 21 at Jersey Shore and April 24 vs. Wilmington...Saturday's 12

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn returns home to play a six-game series against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades possess six of New York-AL's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: LHP **Kyle Carr** (11), INF **Roc Riggio** (18), INF **Jared Serna** (19), and OF **Jace Avina** (28)...INF **Jorbit Vivas** (15) and INF **Tyler Hardman** (25) have also joined the team this week on Minor League rehab assignments...The Cyclones went 14-10 against Hudson Valley in 2023, including a 6-6 record at Maimonides Park and a 8-4 mark at Heritage Financial Park in Wappingers Falls...Since 2001, Brooklyn is 142-144 all-time (.497) against Hudson Valley in 286 match-

free passes tied the Cyclones' franchise record...Brooklyn also coaxed 12 team walks on April 7, 2023, vs. Jersey Shore and on August 11, 2016, vs. Vermont...Individually, INF **William Lugo** has accumulated walks in droves in 2024...Lugo's 32 free passes are the second most in the league...Lugo's 22.2% walk rate is also second in the league and third in all of Minor League Baseball.

RUNNING WILD AND FREE: Brooklyn swiped a season-high seven bases in last Saturday's triumph at Bowling Green...LF **Omar De Los Santos** and RF **Nick Morabito** each stole three bases, while OF **Stanley Consuegra** added a single swipe...The Cyclones' previous season-best was four on three occasions, most recently on May 8 at Rome...Brooklyn fell one stolen bag shy of matching the franchise record of eight set on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...DH **Walter Rasquin** and RF **José Miguel Medina** each stole three bases in that affair, while 2B **Edgardo Fermin** and CF **Quinn Brodey** snatched the other two...The seven steals were the most in a game for the Cyclones since they also stole seven bases on August 15, 2018, vs. Vermont...During last week's series against Bowling Green, the Cyclones stole 18 bases to the Hot Rods' 15.

ORELLANA'S OVERWHELMING START: RHP **Douglas Orellana** set a personal and team season-high with 10 strikeouts on May 11 at Rome and continued his impressive start to 2024 on Friday night...Among arms with 29.0+ innings of work, Orellana is second in the league in ERA (1.23), third in opposing OPS (.475), and fifth in batting average against (.165) and WHIP (0.99)...Orellana's 1.23 ERA (4 ER in 29.1 IP) is the sixth-lowest in Minor League Baseball among pitchers with 29.0+ innings of work...The 22-year-old whiffed 10 in his start against the Emperors, the second double-digit strikeout game of his career...The Caracas, Venezuela native punched out a career-high 11 over four frames in Game 2 of a doubleheader for the Florida Complex League Mets on July 14, 2022...Orellana was the first Cyclone to strike out 10+ hitters in a single game since RHP **Robert Colina** punched out 10 in six innings in a win at Greenville on September 2, 2023.

KING STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 71 extra-base hits, 31 home runs, and 103 RBI...The 23-year-old is also three hits away (161) from matching OF **Alex Ramirez's** (164) franchise record for base knocks...He is also four doubles (34) from matching Ramirez's franchise mark (38)...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

A THOUSAND VICTORIES: Brooklyn's 2-1 victory at Rome on May 11 marked the 1,000th in Cyclones' franchise history...Brooklyn has record a mark of 1,004-847 (.542) in 1,851 games since 2001...May 7's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021...The Cyclones are 206-216 (.488) in 422 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's very first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 53 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.57 ERA (24 ER in 84.0 IP) and 5 saves, walking just 21 and striking out 72.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MiLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision in his first start of the year in Game 2 of last Thursday's doubleheader at Bowling Green...Permitted one run on three hits over 3.2 innings...Walked a season-high-tying two and struck out two...Surrendered a solo home run to SS **Brayden Taylor** in the third inning...Tossed 53 pitches and 32 strikes (60.38%)...Relieved by RHP **Joshua Cornielly** with runners at first and third and two out in the bottom of the fourth and the game tied at one...Both bequeathed runners were stranded...Bowling Green scored four in the fifth and two in the sixth to defeat the Cyclones, 7-1.

VAMOS VENTURA: The 23-year-old makes his second start of the 2024 season on Wednesday after dominating in relief...Ventura had a 10.1-inning scoreless streak halted on May 10 and, among South Atlantic League relief arms, he was eighth in strikeouts (25) before joining the rotation...Overall, when narrowed down to arms with 21.0+ innings of work, the right-hander is tied for fourth in fewest walks allowed (5).

WHAT A DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES: One of the biggest changes for Ventura in the 2024 campaign has been a significant decrease in walks, in addition to an uptick in strikeouts...In 10 starts for the Cyclones in 2023, the Santo Domingo, D.R. native held a strikeout rate of 21.70% and a walk rate of 15.57%...So far this season, Ventura has raised his strikeout rate by 7.97% (29.67%) and lowered his walk rate by 7.88% (7.69%).

PROSPECT RADAR: Ventura enters the 2024 ranked as the Mets' No. 38 prospect according to *Baseball America*...The publication considered him the franchise's No. 16 prospect in 2023, No. 19 in 2022, and No. 20 in 2021...MLB Pipeline considered the 23-year-old New York's No. 20 farmhand going into the 2023 season.

2023: The Santo Domingo, D.R. native began the campaign with Single-A St. Lucie...Posted a 4-3 record with a 5.67 ERA (34 ER in 54.0 IP), 50 walks, and 60 strikeouts in 15 appearances (13 starts)...Transferred to Brooklyn on July 14...Collected a 3-2 mark with a 3.86 ERA (21 ER in 49.0 IP), 33 walks, and 46 strikeouts in 10 starts for the Cyclones.

COMEBACK TRAIL: Ventura missed the entire 2021 season after undergoing Tommy John surgery...The right-hander returned in 2022 and made four starts between the Florida Complex League Mets and Single-A St. Lucie...However, Ventura suffered a pectoral muscle injury and was shut down for the remainder of the season.
