THE PASS OF THE NORTH

♦ The Reno Aces failed to capitalize against the El Paso Chihuahuas in a 7-6 loss on Wednesday.. Despite the loss, **Tim Tawa** continued to shine, collecting two base knocks including his fifth big fly of the campaign... **Sergio Alcantara** continued to swing a hot bat, going 2-for-3 with a double and a two-RBI double to tie the ballgame in the sixth. The switch-hitter has been clutch in the first two games this series, driving in five total runs... **Albert Almora** came through in the bottom of the eighth, smacking his MiLB-leading 43rd double down the left-field line to score two runs and tie the game at 6-6 heading into the ninth... **Blake Walston** posted a solid outing despite taking a no-decision, surrendering three runs on nine hits and two walks across 5 2/3 frames to El Paso, he punched out seven... Reno will look to get back into the win column in Thursday's matchup against the El Paso Chihuahuas, with the first pitch scheduled for 6:35 p.m. PT.
♠ Reno leads Triple-A in AVG (.288), Hits (1341), Runs (821), Total-Bases (2220), and RBI (787)... 2nd in 2B (286)... 2ndleast amount of strikeouts (989).
♥ This is the 9th of 12 matchups between the two clubs this season.

ACES vs CRISMATT

♦ The Aces will take on right-hander Nabil Crismatt in Thursday's matchup... Crismatt made two starts against Reno in their previous series and was lit up, allowing 13 runs on 12 hits and five walks with four punchouts in six combined innings... Reno put up nine runs on Crismatt on August 18, forcing him to exit the game after only two innings of work. Notably, **Bryson Brigman** smashed a three-run shot in the win... The 29-year-old from Barranquilla, Colombia is riding a 9 2/3 scoreless-inning streak in two starts and one appearance out of the bullpen. The streak includes a solid performance against Tacoma on August 30 when Crismatt left the Rainiers scoreless across 5 2/3 frames with a season-high eight punchouts... He spent time with the Aces in 2023, posting a 6.85 ERA with 44 strikeouts and 18 walks in 47 1/3 innings with Reno... He owns a 5.95 ERA with a 60:21 K: BB in 65 frames (24 appearances, 13 starts) this season.

♦ **Tommy Henry** is slated to make his 18th start of the year on Friday against the El Paso Chihuahuas... Henry was efficient in his previous outing, allowing two runs (one earned) across five frames against the Albuquerque Isotopes, he walked two and punched out five... The southpaw was lights out vs El Paso in mid-August, striking out nine batters, and surrendering two runs in five innings with one walk... He enjoyed a dominant month of August, posting a 2.16 ERA with 43 punchouts and 12 walks in 33 1/3 innings (six starts)... The 27-year-old owns a 4.08 ERA with a 102:47 K: BB in 90 1/3 frames this season.

♠ **Logan Allen** is scheduled to make his 15th (16th appearance) in Thursday's matchup against El Paso... The lefty was efficient in his previous outing, allowing three runs on seven hits in five frames to the Albuquerque Isotopes. Notably, he tallied a season-high 10 punchouts... Allen has faced the Chihuahuas twice this season, surrendering seven runs in 10 innings, walking six and striking out five... The 27-year-old was busy in August, making six starts and tossing 30 innings while posting an 8.10 ERA with 28 strikeouts and 15 walks... He owns a 5.35 ERA with a 68:31 K: BB in 75 2/3 innings of work this season.

♥ Made his MLB debut on June 18, 2019 vs. MIL ... dominated in 7.0 IP only giving up 3 hits and 2 walks with 5 strikeouts and earned the win.
