SHRIMP HALT SLIDE, WIN 4-3 IN EXTRA INNINGS

Joe Mack's drove in three, including the walk-off RBI single in the 10th inning on Tuesday, to lead Jacksonville to a 4-3 win over Syracuse. Mack's sacrifice fly in the first opened up the scoring. After Luis De Los Santos' two-run double in the second, Mack tied the score with an RBI double in the sixth. Andrew Pintar, who matched a career-high with four hits, tied the game again in the bottom of the 10th with an infield single before Mack's walk-off hit. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen pitched 6.0 scoreless innings, striking out eight. Patrick Monteverde fanned six in his 3.0 scoreless frames.

JACK OF ALL TRADES

Jumbo Shrimp infielder Jack Winkler played in just four of the club's first 11 games, going just 2-for-14 with seven strikeouts at the plate. The Littleton, Colo., native has appeared in 17 games since then, racking up seven multi-hit games. Over his last 18 contests, Winkler is 24-for-65 at the plate, slashing .369/.397/.523/.920 with four doubles, two home runs, six RBIs, three walks, 10 runs scored and eight stolen bases.

MEET THE METS

For the first time since the Jacksonville Suns were a New York Mets affiliate from 1966-68, Northeast Florida will welcome in a Mets minor league team on Tuesday when the Jumbo Shrimp host the Syracuse Mets at VyStar Ballpark. These six games, however, are not the first meeting between the clubs; Jacksonville split a series with the Mets in Syracuse from July 12-17, 2022. The 1966-68 Suns featured legendary Mets Tom Seaver, Nolan Ryan, Jerry Koosman and Tug McGraw, with the '68 team winning the International League title.

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded multiple stolen bases in 20 of their last 33 games. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have five games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte; Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. The Jumbo Shrimp currently rank fourth in the minor leagues and first Triple-A with 82 stolen bases.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Of the Jumbo Shrimp's last 25 games, a whopping 20 have been decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville is a remarkable 14-6 (.740) in these closely-decided affairs during this stretch. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp are 16-7 (.696) in games decided by no more than three runs, including a 11-3 (.786) mark in one-run games. Those 11 one-run victories are the most of any team in Minor League Baseball; none of the other 119 MiLB teams have more than nine victories by precisely one run.

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp are an extraordinary 17-2 at home this season, outscoring their opponents by a nearly 2:1 margin at 87-49 at VyStar Ballpark and claiming the Minor League Baseball lead for home wins. The road, however, for Jacksonville has been a different story. The Jumbo Shrimp are 5-10 on the road, getting outscored by an 87-59 margin. Jacksonville has a team OPS of .767 (16th in Triple-A) and at home compared to .657 on the road (25th). Their team ERA is 2.05 at home (1st) and 5.64 on the road (25th).

BULLPEN BOUNCEBACK

Jacksonville relievers came into their series at Durham last week leading Triple-A in ERA by more than a full run at 2.40. Against the Bulls, the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen combined to surrender 30 runs, all earned, on 37 hits in 26.0 innings for an 10.38 ERA (12 BB, 31 K), seeing their season ERA rise all the way to 3.75. In their series opener against Syracuse, however, the club's bullpen bounced back to their old ways. Four relievers combined to work 6.0 shutout innings, yielding just three hits without a walk. They totaled eight strikeouts.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has taken the extra base on 47.7 percent of opportunities this season, above the MLB average of 42.0 percent... Connor Gillispie was the 12th different starting pitcher for the Jumbo Shrimp this season. Last night, Jacksonville played its 34th game of the season. The club set a franchise record with 28 different lid-lifters during the 2024 season... Jacksonville has four of the top 12 players in the International League in stolen bases, led by Jakob Marsee's league-leading 20.
