LAST TIME OUT

Moosic, PA (July 22) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders split Saturday's two games with the Worcester Red Sox winning the continuation of Friday's game 8-3, before falling in the nightcap 9-2.

The RailRiders plated two in the bottom of the first. MLB rehabber Greg Allen was hit by a pitch and fellow rehabber Jake Bauers singled. Allen came around on a wild pitch from Shane Drohan. Bauers scored on a bases-loaded catcher's interference and at the end of the first, SWB held a 2-0 lead. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre struck again in the bottom of the third. With a runner on after an infield single from Austin Wells, Carlos Narvaez Jaunched two-run homer 413 feet to centerfield. Narvaez's eighth long ball of the season gave the RailRiders a 4-0 lead. Before the top of the fourth inning a lighting issue caused a suspension in Friday night's game. The contest would resume at 4:05 P.M. on Saturday.

Morcester would tally one in the top of the seventh when Nick Sogard singled in Ronaldo Hernandez. The RailRiders brought in four more in the bottom of the eighth. An Andres Chaparro solo shot, his 19th home run of the season, would start the scoring. A trio of walks loaded the bases and Michael Hermosillo was hit by a pitch scoring a run. Still in the bottom of the eighth with the bases loaded, Everson Pereira singled in two more to extend his hitting streak to 11 games and SWB's lead to 8-1. Ceddanne Rafaela homered with a runner on in the top of the ninth, but the rally attempt from Worcester stalled there. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre would hold on to win 8-3.

Will Warren got the start tossing three scoreless innings with just two hits and five fanned before the game was halted. After the game's resumption, Clayton Beeter (W, 1-1) pitched four frames giving up just a run on two hits with seven strikeouts. Shane Drohan (L, 2-4) got the start for Worcester going three innings and giving up four runs on four hits.

The second game of Saturday's doubleheader kicked off with a pair of singles from Worcester to put two on. Bobby Dalbec singled in Nick Sogard to give the Red Sox an early lead. Worcester scored four more in the top of the third. Ryan Fitzgerald doubled to plate two and Niko Kavadas hit a two-run home run to make it 5-0 Red Sox. Rodolfo Durán hit his first triple of the season in the bottom of the fourth and scored on a wild pitch to break up the shutout for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. In the bottom of the fifth, Jake Bauers mashed a solo shot into right field to trim SWB's deficit to 5-2. The Red Sox pulled further ahead in the top of the sixth after Rafaela drove in two on a double. Wilyer Abreu walked and both he and Rafaela scored on an error. Kavadas doubled in the top of the seventh and Daniel Palka singled him in. Worcester would take a 10-2 lead and the score would hold from there.

Deivi García (L, 2-2) got the start in a bullpen game allowing a run in 1.2 innings of work with three strikeouts. Rio Gomez started for Worcester pitching three innings without allowing a run and striking out three. Chase Shugart (W, 4-1) got the win going 1.2 innings with two runs given up on three hits and three strikeouts. Andrews Nunez (S, 1) pitched two and a third for the save

FIELDING FAUX PAS - The two teams combined for eight total errors throughout the course of the last two contests. RailRiders have committed a total of 84 errors on the season, while. Worcester leads the International League at 91. They had three errors in Friday's game which ties the most against the home team this summer. Andres Chaparro has the most with 13 and Bobby Dalbec for Worcester with 10. Visalia leads all of Minor League Baseball with 132 errors.

HOMER HEAVEN The RailRiders are the first team in Minor League Baseball to hit 150 home runs on the season and have 155 this season. Worcester has totaled 139 as a team. The New York Yankees have amassed 139, and the Atlanta Braves have the most with 185. The RailRiders have launched a half a dozen homers in two contests in this season. The team homered 20 times in a week against Charlotte, topping the 16 they hit last season against Omaha. Estevan Florial leads the team with twenty-one, while six players are in double digits.

BAUERS BOMB: Last night on a Major League rehab assignment, Jake Bauers hit a home run for his 11th with the RailRiders. This was his second in his rehab appearance where he has recorded seven hits in three contests. Before being placed on the Injured List, Bauers played 49 games with New his rehab appearance where he has record York with 30 hits including seven homers.

AUSTIN ARRIVES: Yankees #2 prospect Austin Wells received the call up to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre yesterday and got his first Triple-A hit. After beginning the season on the injured list with a rib fracture, he played five games of rehab in Tampa before reporting to Somerset. In Double-A, he played in 58 games for a .237 average with 54 hits. The lefty has 14 doubles and 11 homers with a team-high 50 runs batted in.

SEVENTH MONTH STRONG: Andres Chaparro is off to a stellar start in the month of July. He has played a team-high fifteen games with a .333 batting average. The righty has totaled 19 hits, including five doubles and four home runs. He has batted in 19 runs and scored ten of his own. Chaparro is looking to build back up after a tough month of June where he batted .193 in 24 games.

PEREIRA'S POWER: Everson Pereira has really impressed as the Yankees #4 prospect in Triple-A snapped his hitting streak at 11-games yesterday. He had also had four of multi-hit and five multi-RBI. Pereira has batted in 13 runs and scored 11 on 17 hits. The righty has played all three outfield positions. In Somerset, Pereira was batting .291 in 46 total games. There Pereira had 10 doubles and 10 homers.

LEADING THE CHARGE - The RailRiders have had nine different first basemen this season, with Jake Lamb making his debut last night. Andres Chaparro leads the way with Billy McKinney following shortly thereafter. Catchers Rodolfo Duran and Carlos Narvaez have turned into regulars in the corner. Mickey Gasper, Jake Bauers, Franchy Cordero and Max Burt have defended there as well.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM – The RailRiders will showcase top prospects, catcher, Austin Wells (#2 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) and outfielder Everson Periera (#4) in his first Triple-A season. Will Warren (#7), Randy Vasquez (#12), and Clayton Beeter (#13) are set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debuts with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre this summer.
