SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the SeaWolves, 6-1, in the series finale. Gage Workman opened the scoring with a solo homer in the top of the third inning. In the bottom of the third, **Simon Whiteman** brought in a run with a sac fly to tie the score. In the top of the fifth, Workman added his second home of the game to put the SeaWolves ahead, 2-1. Ben Malgeri added a two-run homer in the top of the seventh to open a 4-1 lead. In the eighth, Andrew Navigato and Malgeri added RBI singles to extend the lead to 6-1

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh. Today is the seventh of 18 head-to-head games this year. The Flying Squirrels went 3-3 against the Curve at The Diamond from May 2-7. Along with this week's series, the Flying Squirrels will head to Altoona for six games from August 1-6.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS snapped a seven game-losing streak, their longest since 2018, with Friday's win but have lost nine-of-10 since May 25. The Flying Squirrels were 14-7 through their first 21 games but have lost 21-of-their-last-29. Their 8-21 record since May 3 is the worst in the Eastern League. Richmond starters have thrown 171.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 258.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.14 ERA, which is the lowest of all 120 teams in the minors.

THE CURVE are in second place in the Southwest Division, one game behind first-place Erie. The Curve have won five consecutive games, their longest winning streak of the season. The Altoona offense has struck out 388 times this year, the fewest in the Eastern League. Altoona's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including INF Liover Peguero (No. 7), RHP Jared Jones (No. 11), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 14) OF Matt Gorski (No. 16) and INF Andres Alvarez (No. 30). Nicholas Dombkowski is rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Pirates organization and Sanchez is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list includes Peguero (No. 6), Jones (No. 11), Gorski (No. 16), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 19) and OF Matt Fraizer (No. 22).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Landen Roupp makes his sixth start of the season and the first of his career against the Curve. Last time out, he worked three innings and allowed one run, striking out a season-high seven batters against the SeaWolves on Wednesday night. In his first full professional season in 2022, Roupp climbed three levels in the Giants system. He began the year working primarily as a reliever with Low-A San Jose, going 5-2 with a 2.59 ERA in 14 outings. Roupp moved to High-A Eugene in late-June for seven starts, going 3-0 with a 1.67 ERA. He was promoted to Richmond on August 18 for the remainder of the season and went 2-1 with a 3.76 ERA in five starts. Roupp made one start against the SeaWolves last year, allowing two runs over five innings in his final outing of the year on September 15 at The Diamond. Roupp was selected by the Giants in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of UNC Wilmington, where he was the 2021 CAA Pitcher of the Year. For more on Roupp,

FOR ALTOUNA: Right-hander Kyle Nicolas makes his 11th start of the season and his third against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Wednesday against the Rumble Ponies and worked six scoreless innings, striking out eight. He has not allowed a run over his last two starts, spanning eleven innings of work. Nicolas faced the Flying Squirrels on May 2 at The Diamond and tied a season high with five earned runs allowed over five innings in a loss. He pitched in Richmond again on May 7 and surrendered three runs over three innings in a loss. Nicolas made his Pirates organization debut in Richmond on April 12, 2022 and worked 3.2 scoreless innings. In his seven career starts against the Flying Squirrels, Nicolas is 0-2 with a 5.40 ERA (15 ER/25.0 IP). Nicolas was selected by the Marlins with the 61st pick in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Ball State University. He was traded along with outfielder Connor Scott to the Pirates on November 29, 2021 for catcher Jacob Stallings. Nicolas is rated by Baseball America as the No. 14 Pirates prospect and is currently third in the Eastern League with 56 strikeouts.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, they are again leading the level in average attendance (6,767) and total attendance (175,937). The Flying Squirrels are ranked ninth of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance.

GLDW SHOW: Infielder **Jimmy Glowenke** was assigned to Double-A Richmond last week and made his Double-A debut on Wednesday. He was selected in the second round (68th overall) by the Giants in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist. Glowenke started the season with High-A Eugene. Among Northwest League hitters (min. 100 PA) this year, Glowenke ranked sixth in OPS (.956), sixth in batting average (.313), sixth in wRC+ (146), seventh in OBP (.413), tied for seventh in doubles (10) and eighth in SLG (.542). He also had the fourth-lowest strikeouts percentage (14.3) in the league. He picked up his first Double-A hit on Thursday night, an RBI single, and he has five hits over his last four games.

WHERE THERE'S A WILLIAMS THERE'S A WAY: Carter Williams has hit safely in each of his last six games since last Saturday at Binghamton. During that stretch, he is batting .375 (9-for-24) with two homers, a double, two RBIs and five runs scored. Last year in his first full professional season, Williams hit .336 over 80 games between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, which ranked second among Giants minor league hitters (min. 300 PA).

VAUN RETURNS: Outfielder Vaun Brown was reinstated from the injured list with the Flying Squirrels on May 16. After missing the start of the season with an injury, he joined Low-A San Jose on a rehab assignment in late-April and played five games before joining High-A Eugene for five games. Last year, Brown played his first full professional season and led all full-season minor leaguers in batting average (.346) and OPS (1.060). He also ranked third in the minors in SLG (.623) and sixth in OBP (.437). Brown joined the Flying Squirrels last August and made his Double-A debut in Akron, but left that game in the fifth inning with an injury and did not play again for the year. Brown has reached base in each of his nine games with Richmond. Last Wednesday, he set a Double-A high with three hits, including a homer and a double. On Friday, he again picked up three hits and scored the walk-off winning run in the pinth

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Ismael Munguia is ranked sixth in batting average (.300). Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for second in triples (3). Hayden Cantrelle is tied for ninth in walks (32). Evan Gates is tied for eighth in saves (4). Kai-Wei Teng is tied for fourth in strikeouts (55).

WHERE THE CURVE RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Mason Martin is tied for sixth in homers (10), sixth in RBIs (30), seventh in OBP (.406), eighth in SLG (.517), fifth in OPS (.923) and tied for fifth in walks (35). Liover Peguero is tied for fourth in doubles (12) and ranks 10th in stolen bases (13). Connor Scott is first in triples (4). Kyle Nicolas is third in strikeouts (56). Juan Minaya is tied for first in games pitched (19) and Cameron Junker is tied for third (18).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1, No. 30 overall), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Wade Meckler (No. 23) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter. Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and the best athlete. Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Brown (No. 5), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
