NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

- 2026 has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.
- ✦ The Chasers enter today's game on a season-high 5 game winning streak after a weekend sweep of Lehigh Valley and have won 6 of their last 7 (since July 10).
 - ✦ Of 17 series played this year, the Storm Chasers have won 6, lost 8 and split 3.
 - ✦ Omaha went 13-12 in April ... with a 13-14 record in May and 10-15 in June, the Chasers had back-to-back losing months for the first time since June/July 2025.

COMEBACK KIDS

- The Chasers have 27 comeback wins and have blown a lead in 28 losses this year.
- ✦ 27 comeback wins are tied for 3rd-most in the International League, tied 5th in Triple-A (Salt Lake's 33 comeback wins lead Triple-A, tied for the most among full-season Minor League teams) ... Omaha's 28 blown leads are the 3rd-most in the league, 5th in Triple-A.
 - ✦ In the last 61 games (since May 9), Omaha is 28-33 ... the Chasers have trailed at some point in 21 of 28 wins and led at some point in 18 of 33 losses, meaning 39 of Omaha's last 61 games (64%) have had a lead change ... in this stretch, 40 of 61 games (66%) have been decided by 3 runs or less.
 - ✦ Omaha's last 3 wins have all been comeback wins and the Chasers have trailed for at least 2.0 innings in their last 4 comeback wins.

PITCH, PLEASE!

- Storm Chasers starting pitchers have not consistently gotten deep into games this year, leaving the bullpen heavily relied upon.
- ✦ Omaha's starting pitchers have thrown 357.2 innings this season, the 5th-fewest among Triple-A clubs, while 7 wins from Chasers starting pitchers are the fewest in Triple-A ... 9 quality starts rank 12th-most in the 20-team IL.
 - ✦ Storm Chasers relievers have had 45 save opportunities, tied 2nd-most in the Minors ... the Chasers have only converted 22 saves, with 23 blown saves ranking as the most in Triple-A and tied for the 2nd-most in the Minors.

SUMMER HEAT

- A pair of Storm Chasers bats have especially been performing well in recent weeks.
- ✦ In his last 22 games (since June 21), **Brett Squires** is slashing .342/.418/.605 (26-for-76) with 17 RBI ... he hit safely in a career-best 14 straight, June 16 to July 2.
 - ✦ Since his first game with Omaha on June 4, **Matthew Lugo** has hit .280 (37-for-132) with 8 home runs and 27 RBI in 34 games ... since his arrival, he is 5th in the International League in extra-base hits (20), tied 6th in doubles (11), tied 8th in home runs, tied 8th in total bases (74) and tied 10th in runs scored (26).

HONEST ABE

- Abraham Toro** started the season slow, but has been one of the International League's best hitters since mid-May
- ✦ Since May 12, Toro has a .320 average (58-for-181) ... in this stretch, he ranks 1st in the IL in OPS (.984), 4th in SLG (.597) and 8th in AVG (.324) ... his 43 RBI over 48 games since May 12 rank as the 6th-most in the league.
 - ✦ From March 27 to May 10, Toro hit .189 (21-for-111) with a .650 OPS and hits in 16 of 33 games ... since May 12, Toro has hits in 36 of 48 games, with 4+ hits in 3 games.

CROSS ME UP

- Gavin Cross** had one of the league's slowest start to the season, but has heated up with the weather as the season has gone on.
- ✦ Over his first 36 games (March 27 to May 15), Cross hit just .128 (15-for-117) ... but in his last 49 games (since May 16), he's hitting .307 (54-for-176), with 17 XBH and 22 RBI, with 16 multi-hit games, including 6 of his last 10 games.
 - ✦ Cross enters today on a season-best 13-game hitting streak since July 2 ... on the streak, he's hitting .358 (19-for-53) with 8 extra-base hits, 9 RBI and a .967 OPS.

TRANSACTION ACTION

- The Storm Chasers have made a flurry of moves in July, including the last 48 hours.
- ✦ Today, INF **Andrew Velazquez** had his contract selected by the Royals, OF **Kameron Misner** was designated for assignment and INF **Alejo Lopez** signed a Minor League contract with Kansas City.
 - ✦ Tuesday, INF **Jack Pineda** was transferred from Double-A Northwest Arkansas and made his Triple-A debut yesterday, while Nebraska Cornhusker LHP **Aaron Bummer** was signed as a free agent and assigned to Omaha and OF **Kyle Isbel** was transferred to Omaha for an MLB rehab assignment.
 - ✦ The Chasers have made 40 roster moves this month, with 9 new players added to the team in the last 20 days.

TODAY'S START

- ✓ Bailey Falter is making his **6th start with the Storm Chasers** this year, his **16th appearance with Omaha** and his **21st overall appearance** in 2026.
- ✓ Playing his **12th professional season** this year, the Royals are his 3rd MLB organization ... has played parts of 6 Major League seasons with Philadelphia (2021-23), Pittsburgh (2023-25) and Kansas City (2025-26).
- ✓ Falter will be making his 1st career start against the Bees and 2nd against the Angels and their affiliates ... he made a start in the Majors in April 2025 against Los Angeles, allowing 3 runs over 4.0 innings, but striking out 5.

THE FALTER FILES

- ✓ **GETTING BACK ON TRACK:** Falter made the Royals' Opening Day roster and pitched in 2 games before he landed on Kansas City's injured list (*left elbow inflammation*) ... he appeared in 9 games with Omaha on a rehab assignment (from April 15 to May 15), but pitched to a 14.21 ERA (10 ER in 6.1 IP) in 3 games after returning to Kansas City and was subsequently designated for assignment and sent outright to the Minors.
- ✓ **TRIPLE-A TALENT:** Falter pitched in 9 games for the Storm Chasers while on a rehab assignment from April 15 to May 15 ... he struggled in his first game, but in the next 8 (April 19 to May 14), he worked a 1.46 ERA (2 ER in 12.1 IP) and ended his rehab stint with three straight scoreless appearances.
