### Back on the Road

The Fightin Phils are back on the road to continue a six-game series at the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. It is the sixth-of-nine matchups between the teams this season and sixth and final at People's Natural Gas Field in Altoona. Following this week, Altoona makes its first trip to Reading since 2023 from July 17-19 for a three-game series out of the All-Star Break. The teams split their lone series in 2025 in Altoona, and the two teams have started the 2026 season series in a 2-2 deadlock.

### Smashing Their Way Into The History Books

The Reading Fightin Phils throttled a season-best six home runs in last night's 14-5 win over the Altoona Curve. Luke Ritter (1, 2), Bryan Rincon (11), Raylin Heredia (14), Alex Binelas (18) and Bryson Ware (13) all went yard in a game where Reading never trailed. It was the first time this group smacked six home runs since May 25, 2018 against the Portland Sea Dogs. Jean Cabrera was ejected in the fifth inning after hitting Curve batter Will Taylor, but the bullpen held down the fort before the R-Phils bats sent seven across the plate in a decisive eighth inning. Binelas was a triple shy of the cycle, while Ritter hit his first two homers in a Reading uniform.

### Bryan Gets on Base

With a 1-for-5 performance on Saturday night, Bryan Rincon extended his season-best on-base streak to 23 games. The Phillies' 27th ranked prospect's on-base streak is the longest by a Fightin Phil this season and is the second-longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League amongst players who are still playing for their teams. The shortstop is slashing .234/.378/.438 during this stretch. Rincon's 23-game on-base streak is the longest by a Fightin Phil since Keaton Anthony had a 25 game on-base streak from May 11-June 10, 2025. It was a streak that never ended as Anthony was promoted to Lehigh Valley (AAA) on June 11, 2025.

### Binelas Bombs Away

Alex Binelas clubbed his team-leading 18th home run of the season on Saturday night. Binelas is now first in homers amongst Phillies Minor Leaguers, as he's knotted up with 2025 Eastern League MVP Felix Reyes. After hitting nine home runs in April, Binelas was held to just one home run in May. But, since the calendar has turned to June, Binelas has lifted eight home runs, all coming over the last 17 games he's played in. Binelas' single-season career-high in home runs was 25 back in 2022. He hit eight homers over 68 games with Reading in 2025. Binelas is also currently riding a 18-game on-base streak, dating back to June 7, and is slashing .309/.413/.721 (1.053 OPS), along with eight home runs and 11 RBI.

### Raking Raylin

Phillies 30th-ranked prospect Raylin Heredia posted another impressive performance last night, going 2-for-5 in the win. Heredia also turned in an excellent two-week homestand, which featured his second-career two home run game last Thursday against Hartford. The 22-year old has already hit 12 home runs this season, which is a single-season career-high, surpassing his previous best of eight. Over the 12 games during the homestand, Heredia slashed .319/.373/.681 (1.054 OPS), along with six runs, two doubles, five home runs and nine RBI. Heredia leads the Eastern League with 21 doubles, while also ranking second with 80 hits, tied for second with 34 extra-base hits and third with 145 total bases.

### León Looks Legit!

Pedro León has stormed onto the scene, making an immediate impact since making his Fightin Phils debut on June 12. He is 7-for-23 this series with a home run, a double, three RBI and four walks. The former Houston Astros outfielder is hitting .286 with three home runs, 10 RBI and seven extra base hits in 13 games with Reading thus far.

### Going, Going, Gone

The Fightin Phils are back to hitting home runs at a torrid pace, as they have hit a league-best 30 since June 9. Through 74 games, Reading has hit 97 home runs, which ranks as second most in the Eastern League and they are on pace for 180 this season, which comes after Reading hit 118 in 2025.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

June 28, 2024: At Reading, The Fightin Phils rode multiple crooked numbers to a 10-3 win on Friday night over the Bowie Baysox. Reading got three runs in the bottom of the second thanks to a three-run home run from Ethan Wilson. The R-Phils then put up five-more runs in the bottom of the fifth in an innings that featured a home run from Marcus Lee Sang and Robert Moore. Reading then added two more in the seventh to jump up 10-3. Robinson Pina went six innings and allowed two runs, with six strikeouts en route to his team-best ninth win of the season. The Fightin Phils put up a season-best eight extra-base hits in the win.

### Curve Baseball

Altoona finished the season's first half with a 31-38 record, which was fifth in the Eastern League's Southwest Division standings. The Curve started the season 0-12, but since they got their first win on Apr. 16, they went 31-26 over the remainder of the season's first half. Altoona most recently split a six-game series at Akron last week and following this week, head north to Portland. The Curve's roster features four of the Pittsburgh Pirates Top-30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline: Omar Alfonzo (14), Jack Brannigan (22), Duce Gourson (26) and Callan Moss (28).

### Altoona Gives the Ball to Ager

Matt Ager takes the hill for the Pittsburgh Pirates' Double-A affiliate. Ager is 4-1 this season with a 4.56 earned run average and 54 punchouts over 53.1 innings pitched. He has made seven starts and six appearances out of the bullpen. All seven of his starts have been with the Curve, while he made five relief appearances for High-A Greensboro. In his last appearance, he spun five innings of four-run ball with a pair of walks and seven strikeouts on June 23 in the series opener. He got the win.
