TODAY'S GAME: Sugar Land rounds out their six-game home stand as they conclude their series with Oklahoma City on Sunday afternoon... It is one of the five remaining day games the Space Cowboys have at home this season.

ABOUT SATURDAY NIGHT: Oklahoma City got out to a lead in the first on a solo home run and added three more runs in the third and fourth innings to open a 7-0 edge heading to the home half of the fourth... Sugar Land struck back for a run in the bottom of the fourth thanks to a CJ Alexander double and a James Nelson single, but the Comets added singular tallies in the fifth and sixth to push to a 9-1 lead... Sugar Land collected scoreless innings from RHP Rodderly Muñoz, RHP Miguel Ullola and RHP Jayden Murray but could not mount a comeback offensively as they fell 9-1.

RHP Logan VanWey recalled by Houston... RHP Jason Alexander optioned to Sugar Land... OF Rhylan Thomas placed on the 7-Day IL... LHP Tom Cogrove reinstated from the IL... INF Riley Unroe placed on the Development List... 5/24 - RHP Cody Bolton reports... OF Daniel Johnson released... 5/22 - RHP Alimber Santa contract selected, recalled by Houston... 5/21 - RHP Cody Bolton outrighted to Sugar Land... 5/20 - RHP Jayden Murray optioned to Sugar Land... RHP Jose Fleury reinstated from the Development List... LHP Tom Cosgrove placed on the 7-Day IL.

HOW THE TEAM WAS BUILT: The Space Cowboys roster is comprised of 7 players drafted by Houston, 15 players signed as free agents, 2 international free agents, 1 non-drafted free agents, 1 player acquired via trade, 2 players claimed off waivers and 1 player selected in the Major League Phase of the Rule 5 draft.

PROSPECTING: Per MLB Pipeline, the Space Cowboys roster features three of the Top 30 prospects in the Astros' system... That includes RHP Ethan Pecko (#6), RHP Miguel Ullola (#13) and RHP Jose Fleury (#22).

HARD. CONTACT: OF Zach Cole has stung the ball this week with the Space Cowboys, going 5-for-17 (.294) with a double, an RBI, a run scored and a stolen base in four games against the Comets.

Cole has also registered the two hardest-hit balls in the Pacific Coast League this week per StatCast, ripping a 113.1 mph single on Wednesday night before hitting a 112.0 mph double on Friday night... Cole added on a 109.5 mph single in the first inning on Friday night, giving him three of the 11 hardest hit balls in the PCL this week... His 113.1 mph single is tied for the sixth hardest-hit ball in the PCL this year.

SCORELESS STRETCH: RHP Anthony Maldonado spun a scoreless inning on Friday night, allowing no hits while striking out one... Maldonado has now made five-straight appearances without allowing a run, firing 5.0 IP with 0 H, 3 BB, 3 K... Over his 20 appearances this year, Maldonado is scoreless in 16 of them.

PIRSON GETS THE CALL: Sunday is the final day with the Space Cowboys for Sugar Land Home Clubhouse Attendant DJ Pirson, who is heading to Daikin Park to start a new role in the home clubhouse with the Astros.

RELIEVING ROLE: After pitching 2.0 innings as a starter on Tuesday night, RHP Miguel Ullola entered in the eighth inning for Sugar Land on Saturday night and spun a scoreless frame... It was Ullola's first relief appearance of the season and his first relief outing since 9/21/25 vs. El Paso in his final appearance of the year when he threw a scoreless inning.

On Saturday night, Ullola threw 11 pitches, eight strikes, and allowed only a single before canceling out the runner on a ground ball double play, the first of the year for Ullola... He threw six fastballs and averaged 95.9 mph, topping out a 97.3 mph, tied the hardest tracked pitch that he has thrown in his career, while also getting a whiff on all three swings against his fastball.

SANTA DELIVERS IN DEBUT: RHP Alimber Santa had made his Major League debut on Monday night at Texas, entering in the eighth inning and firing two no-hit frames to help secure the 18th no-hitter in Astros franchise history... Santa struck out Brandon Nimmo for his first Major League strikeout to complete the no-hitter... Per Elias, Santa became the first pitcher since 1900 to pitch in a no-hitter in his ML debut... According to their records, it happened one other time on October 15, 1892 when RHP Bumpus Jones of CIN hurled a 9.0 inning, complete-game no-hitter in his Major League debut.

Santa became the 47th former Sugar Land player (since 2021) to debut in the Major Leagues and the first since Zach Cole on September 12, 2025 with Houston.

PRICE POWERS UP: Collin Price went 1-for-4 on Friday night and has now hit safely in five of his last six games, going 5-for-19 (.263/.417) with a double, three home runs, four RBI, four runs scored, four walks and only two strikeouts in that stretch... Price's 10 home runs this season rank second on the team behind CJ Alexander (11), and seven of those homers have come during the month of May, tying him for the Pacific Coast League lead during the month... Additionally, Price has homered in three of his last five games.

BASES FOR BIGGIO: INF Cavan Biggio worked a pair of walks in Saturday nights game, giving him 33 total free passes on the season... In the month of May, Biggio is slashing .302/.465/.571/1.036 (19-for-63) with two doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI, nine runs and 20 walks... Biggio is tied for second in the PCL in walks in May (1st - Zac Veen; 23) while sitting fourth in both OPS and OBP during the month... Biggio enters Sunday tied for ninth in the PCL in base on balls this season.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: RHP Jason Alexander turned in a masterful outing on 4/7 against Tacoma, spinning 7.0 shutout innings while scattering three hits and a walk, striking out three... Alexander needed just 69 pitches to complete his 7.0 innings, the fewest pitches in affiliated history to complete 7.0 innings... It was the 12th instance of a Space Cowboys starter to go 7.0 frames, all tied for the second-longest outing in franchise history (longest - Ryan Gusto, 7.1 IP, 8/4/24 @ RR).

ONE-HIT WONDER: On 4/3, the Space Cowboys took a no-hitter into the ninth inning and came three outs shy of the first no-hitter in franchise history... However, it was the fifth one-hitter for Sugar Land in a nine-inning game and their first since April 13, 2025 vs. Albuquerque when they won 7-0. The other one-hitters were:

WHERE TO FIND US: All 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on audio streaming at SLSpaceCowboys.com/Listen. All Space Cowboys games can also be seen on the Bally Sports Live App for free, MiLB.TV, MLB.TV and the MiLB App. Garrett Greene returns for his fourth season as the primary play-by-play broadcaster for Sugar Land and will be on the call for all 150 games. He'll be joined at home and on select road games by Gerald Sanchez, who continues in his sixth season calling games for Sugar Land.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his seventh season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his sixth with Sugar Land, continuing as the only manager in Sugar Land's history since they became affiliated with the Astros. Storey earned his 500th professional win on June 4, 2025 over the Sacramento River Cats. He was named the Pacific Coast League Manager of the Year in 2024 after guiding Sugar Land to their first Pacific Coast League title. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with five seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Sean Buchanan, hitting coach Drew Saylor and development coach Wladimir Sutil. 2026 is Saylor's first in the Astros organization after he worked in the Royals organization from 2020 - 2025, mostly as a minor league hitting coordinator. He previously managed in the Pirates organization (West Virginia - 2019), Dodgers' organization (Rancho Cucamonga, 2016 - 2018) and Rockies (Tri-City, 2015). Buchanan enters his second year at the helm in Sugar Land after one season as the pitching coach with Double-A Corpus (2024) and one year with High-A Asheville (2023), along with a year in the Florida Complex League (2022). Buchanan previously coached in the collegiate ranks, working for eight seasons with stops that included Lehigh University, Albright College and DeSales University. Sutil enters his fifth season on the Space Cowboys' staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds the Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

IN THE RANKINGS: In *Baseball America's* Top 30 in-season re-rank, McPherson is now rated as the Astros' #18 prospect.

LAST OUTING: Started last Sunday (5/25) in Sacramento against the River Cats... Had the first batter he faced reach on a fielding error, but faced the minimum through three innings thanks to a caught stealing... Broke a string of nine in a row retired on a solo homer in the fourth... Allowed a on-out single in the fifth and then back-to-back two-out singles that scored a run before walking the final batter he faced... Came one out shy of qualifying for his first Triple A win, but still helped Sugar Land to a 12-3 win over Sacramento... Tied a season-best with 4.2 innings on a season high 82 pitches.

PROMOTED: Promoted to Sugar Land on 5/11, the first promotion to Triple A of his professional career.

WITH CORPUS: Made 6 starts, going 0-1, 5.11 ERA, 24.2 IP, 28 H, 14 R, 14 ER, 8 BB, 30 K, .286 BAA

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: Named the Astros Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April.. Went 0-1, 3.24 ERA in 16.2 IP with Corpus with 24 strikeouts to three walks in four starts.

2025: Pitched across three levels after signing with Houston, appearing with the FCL-Astros (2 G), Single-A Fayetteville (6 G) and High-A Asheville (6 G)... Combined to go 4-3, 3.40 ERA, 14 G, 6 GS, 2-3 SV, 50.1 IP, 28 H, 22 R, 19 ER, 24 BB, 56 K, .162 BAA

ACQUIRED: Signed as a non-drafted free agent on 6/6/25... Had been pitching for Yolo of the Pioneer League.

BEFORE THE 'STROS: Pitched collegiately at North Illinois from 2020 - 2023... After he went undrafted, pitched for Billings in the Pioneer League (Independent) in 2023... Went 3-0, 5.23 ERA, 8 G, 7 GS, 32.2 IP, 40 H, 19 R, 19 ER, 14 BB, 24 K with the Mustangs... Returned to the Pioneer League in 2024 with the Yolo High Wheelers (Davis, CA) and made 16 starts, going 6-2, 5.22 ERA in 89.2 IP, 102 H, 55 R, 52 ER, 30 BB, 78 K... Started 2025 in the Pioneer League with the Yuba-Sutter High Wheelers (Marysville, CA), making two starts... Went 2-0, 2.38 ERA in 11.1 IP, scattering 11 hits to give up only three runs with two walks and 16 strikeouts.
