Highlights

Logan Allen blanked Omaha for a quality start win (6.0IP, 3H, 9K). At the plate, **Joe Lampe** was 2x4 with an RBI, while **Angel Genao** hit a double.

Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Rorik Maltrud** to the mound tonight, looking for his first win of the second half (one win in first half). Omaha will counter with RHP **Randy Dobnak**. Columbus is 36-19 (.655) versus right handers this year. Dobnak has pitched against the Clippers nine times in his career, going 3-4 with a 3.86ERA (39.2IP, 30H, 20R, 17ER, 18BB, 36K).

vs. the Storm Chasers

Columbus has lost 48 of the last 78 regular season games against Omaha, dating to 5/5/22. Of those 78G, the Clippers are 10-45 (.182) when they allow at least four runs to Omaha (3-2 in last 5G), while going 20-3 (.870) when they hold the Storm Chasers to three or fewer. Individually, **Kody Huff** has played 18G against Omaha in his career, hitting .290 (18x62) with 4HR and 10RBI.

Not Quite

A 9th inning rally from Omaha last night put the kibosh on a Clipper shutout, leaving Columbus alone in last place with one shutout this year (4/11 at Worcester). The current run of games allowing a run (62) is the longest since 73G from 4/4-6/28/24 (started and ended with Omaha). From 2021-25, the Clipper pitching staff had a middle of the pack ERA (4.86, 10th), but tossed the 3rd most shutouts (44).

Close-ing the Gap

Each of the last 3G have been 1-run games (11-9 on the year, .550, t-7th in the IL) and each of the last 9G have had a margin of three or fewer (30-21, .588, 3rd; previous 5G were all decided by at least five). Regardless of the margin, the Clippers are 21-12 over the last 33G, going +6 in the run column (169-163). On the year, Columbus is -9 (14th; all other IL teams with more than 40 wins average +60).

I Love Lampe

Joe Lampe has multiple bases, including 3XBH in each of 4G with a plate appearance since joining Columbus, following 4XBH in his final 21G with Akron (.289SLG). His game-tying homer on 6/19 vs. Scranton/WB was his first in Triple-A and first since going deep on 9/11/25 with Akron at Harrisburg. Lampe is batting leadoff for the second time in the last week (once in previous 377G of career).

Brito Slump

Juan Brito is hitting .136/.271/.153 in his last 16G, with half his hits coming on 6/13 at Indy (4x5). He became the 53rd Clipper to amass 1,000PA on 6/19, with 905PA coming while batting second in the order (199G since IL debut on 9/19/23, +110G and 509PA on 2nd place, Omaha's **Drew Waters**; only batter with more PA at a particular spot: Omaha's **John Rave**, 930PA at leadoff).

Naying It

Bo Naylor has reached base in 19 of 21G, posting a .398OBP (14BB in last 70PA; also has 4HR and 23K, yielding a 59% three true outcome rate). Since joining the team on 5/27, he has the 2nd most RBI (14), while scoring the 2nd most runs (15). Columbus catchers are hitting .306/.438/.574, leading the IL in all three categories by a wide margin (2nd in all is Memphis: .284/.392/.495).

Fourth and One

George Valera will get a crack at the cleanup spot tonight, his third such start of the year (3x9, 2RBI). **Ralph Velazquez** (6/7 vs. Omaha) has the only homer from the #4 Clipper in the last 45G (fewest in the IL; 167AB, .341SLG in that time ranks 19th). Valera has reached safely in 24 straight starts (.408OBP since 5/5; 1x2 in 2G as PH), but has not homered since 5/19 vs. Louisville (46AB).

Another Personal Best

Kody Huff established a career high with a 16G on base streak last night (.383OBP since 6/2), after having twice established career best hitting streaks (10G from 4/1-4/12 and 12G from 5/1-5/16). In addition, Huff has already hit top marks in triples (3) and HR (10), while being set to make new personal records with his next run and RBI (at 45 and 47, respectively). He is one steal from a high (7SB in 2024).

Rounding Into Form

Over the last 28G, the Clippers lead the International League in fielding percentage (.985) while turning in the fewest errors (14; ranked 15th in fielding, .976, with 8th most errors, 39, in first 48G). Columbus is 26-15 (.634, 5th in the IL) when playing error-free, including 12-6 (.667) during the hot streak. Last season, the Clippers set a franchise record for defense (.985), including .986 in the second half.

This Date in Clipper History

6/25/1992

Hensley 'Bam-Bam' Meulens turned in one of the greatest performances in Columbus baseball history during a 13-3 romp over the Red Sox in Pawtucket. Meulens went 4x4, hitting 3HR and driving in 8RBI (at the time, tied franchise record for HR and set record for RBI). He was named to his 2nd IL All-Star team in 1992 after leading the IL in HR (26) and RBI (100).

First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,447 to 1,396).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 110-94 (.539) in pitch reviews, with batters going 57-62 (.479) and pitchers/catchers going 53-32 (.624). They have run out of challenges in 35G and have not challenged in 3G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 4-3 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 54-36 when playing past regulation (.600, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 90G to require extra play, 71 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to easily top 800 again, with an outside chance to establish a new team high (on pace for 823, would rank as 4th most all-time; 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 96 through the first 76G (on pace for 188SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 25CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the 3rd most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (49; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

Crazy Eighthths

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 119 runs while crafting a .935OPS (nearly 100 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 52 runs from the 8th on, resulting in a +67 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 187-122 from innings 5-7).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 78 grand slams and 1,946RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.29 through the first 76G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 173HR (average of 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 7th in the IL this year (.979), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 41G this season (26-15, .634), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Good Baseball

Milan Tolentino bunted the winning run into scoring position in an extra-inning win at Indianapolis on 6/14. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 88-23 (.793) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 5-2 mark this season (.714, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers have the 2nd most last at bat wins this year (12, Syracuse at 13) while playing in the 2nd most games decided in the last at bat (20; Scranton/WB has played 21). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 94G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 46-48 (.489, 15th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 428-440 (.493), 398-394 with Columbus (.503).
