Tonight: Coming off a series-opening victory, the Lugnuts play the second game in a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons, the eighth meeting of 24 between the two Michigan-based High-A clubs this season. The Loons previously won four out of six games against the Lugnuts in Lansing to end May and are 4-3 against the Nuts this season. Tonight, like all Wednesday home games, is a Dog Days of Summer, with dogs welcome at the park!

On the Air: Tonight's game is on both MiLB.TV and accessible via streaming online audio via <http://milb.streamguys1.com/lansing>, with **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** and **Adam Jaksa** on the call of the game.

Sunday: Lugnuts 9, Loons 7. Shortstop **Max Schuemann** singled twice, walked twice, was hit by a pitch, and stole a franchise single-game record five bases, and the Lugnuts recovered from losing a 7-2 lead to score two runs in the bottom of the seventh inning on a bases-loaded balk and a **Lazaro Armenteros** RBI single to defeat Great Lakes in the opener of a six-game series.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, the Nuts moved up to the High-A Central, and they accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

LUG•NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

Meet the Boss: **Scott Steinmann** is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017). More info about the skipper can be found on the next page of these notes.

Heating Up: Missouri State product **Drew Millas** has excelled at the plate in his last 12 games, hitting .404 (19-for-47) and raising his batting average from .177 to .275. Millas enters today on a 18-game on-base streak, extended with a second-inning single yesterday. The Lugnuts' longest streak this season is 24 games, set by **Max Schuemann** from May 8-June 6.

Man of Steel: Infielder **Max Schuemann** (Portage Northern H.S. / Eastern Michigan University) set a Lugnuts single-game franchise record last night with five stolen bases, breaking **Samad Taylor's** mark from July 1, 2018. Schuemann leads Minor League Baseball with 27 steals, three more than Augusta's Braulio Vasquez and ten more than the Major League leader, Kansas City's Whit Merrifield. Schuemann is tied for second in the Minors with 12 HBPs and is tied for second in the High-A Central with 32 runs scored.

Double Your Pleasure: The Lugnuts' offense tops the High-A Central with 80 doubles. Nine different hitters have notched at least six doubles.

Roster Moves: Yesterday, pitcher **Jack Weisenburger** was promoted to Double-A Midland, his spot on the roster taken by starter **David Leal**. In addition, **Lester Madden, Jr.** was placed on the Injured List. Today, the Nuts reinstated outfielder **Austin Beck**, the 6th overall selection in 2017, from the Injured List.

Seeking Health: Not only do the Nuts have three players -- pitchers **Charlie Cerny** and **Jeff Criswell** and outfielder **Lester Madden, Jr.** -- on the Injured List, outfielder **Michael Guldberg** has not played in a game since May 29th and first baseman Patrick McColl has not had a plate appearance since June 3rd.

1st in the High-A Central, but.... The Lugnuts' pitching staff tops the High-A Central with a 3.54 earned run average, leading second-place West Michigan (3.87), but that ERA has taken a hit with 33 earned runs allowed in the last five games, seven last night, jumping the team ERA from 3.02 entering June 10.

Highs and Lows: With yesterday's nine-run output, the Lugnuts have now scored at least seven runs in a game 14 times this season, and have also scored two runs or fewer in a game 15 times. The season series against the Great Lakes Loons bears out this divide: In the Nuts' three wins, they have scored 10, 9 and 7 runs. In the Nuts' four losses, they have scored 1, 2, 2 and 2 runs.

Keys to Success: When Lansing scores more than two runs in a game, the club is 16-6. When it scores two runs or fewer, the record is 2-13. Additionally, when the Nuts out-hit the opposition, they are 14-1 this season. When they get out-hit, they are 2-17 - but the second win came yesterday in the opener, with the Lugnuts' offense being out-hit, 14-11.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2017: Bo Bichette singled, doubled, homered and singled. Then he singled, doubled, struck out and singled again. Eight at-bats, seven hits, five runs batted in, all in a doubleheader's worth of excitement at South Bend, swept by the Lugnuts 8-5 and 6-1. In the process, Bichette brought his batting average up to an even .400. Game 1 included a wacky five-run sixth inning that brought the Nuts from 5-3 down, taking the lead on a fluke Nick Sinay RBI single – Sinay did not swing the bat, but Jared Cheek's fastball smacked off the knob and rebounded into play, bringing in Christian Williams with the tie-breaking run.

Major League Lugnuts: Two former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, pitcher **Ty Tice** '18 and outfielder **Josh Palacios** '16-'17, with the duo making their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: **Carlos Febles** and **Carlos Beltrán** for the Kansas City Royals.

Familiar Settings: 14 of the 30 Lugnuts active players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members **Scott Steinmann**, **Don Schulze** and **Anthony Phillips** all have experience in the league.

A Full Complement of Starters: The Lugnuts have used 11 starting pitchers this year, namely **Brady Basso**, **Reid Birlingmair**, **Jeff Criswell**, **David Leal**, **Stevie Emanuels**, **Richard Guasch**, **Rafael Kelly**, **Colin Peluse**, **Seth Shuman**, **Shohei Tomioka** and **Brock Whittlesey**.

Fly Like an Eagle: **Max Schuemann** (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut from Eastern Michigan University.

Finally: Pitchers **Stevie Emanuels** and **Shohei Tomioka**, catchers **Jared McDonald**, **Drew Millas** and **William Simoneit**, first baseman **Patrick McColl**, and outfielder **Michael Guldberg** are all making their pro debut this season.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman **Patrick McColl** played for Harvard, reliever **Michael Danielak** was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher **William Simoneit** spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (**Michael Guldberg**, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (**Brady Basso**, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (**Dalton Sawyer**, Minnesota); and the SEC (**Colbie Vance**, Alabama, and **Ryan Gridley**, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (**Stevie Emanuels**, Washington).

International Appeal: In addition to 16 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada, North Carolina, Ohio, Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B **Jordan Diaz** played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Teammates Then, Teammates Now: Several of the Nuts are familiar with one another. **Reid Birlingmair** and **Charlie Cerny** pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons; though **William Simoneit** played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing **Colin Peluse** by a year, Peluse hosted Simoneit on his visit and convinced him to attend Wake.

Last Outing: Scratched from his scheduled start on June 9 at West Michigan in favor of reliever Brock Whittlesey because of the threat of rain in forecast, but when rain never arrived, relieved Whittlesey (1.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 2 K) with two outs in the 2nd inning and tossed 4 1/3 innings, allowing one hit, one run and one walk with four strikeouts... received the victory as the Lugnuts cruised to an 8-1 win over the Whitecaps... only 'Caps run came when Rey Rivera led off the 5th with a single, moved to second and third on back-to-back Shuman wild pitches, and scored on a Trei Cruz groundout.

2021 in Lansing:

- Started on Opening Day, May 4 vs. Lake County, and dominated the Captains: 4 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 7 K, needing only 50 pitches (37 strikes)... both hits allowed were Bryan Lavastida singles... departed with Lugnuts leading, 7-0... Nuts went on to win, 8-1... catcher: Drew Millas.
- Did not pitch again until starting May 15 at Dayton, tossing two perfect innings on 29 pitches (21 strikes) with 2 K's... catcher: William Simoneit.
- Appeared in relief May 20 at Fort Wayne, as part of four-pitcher, 18 strikeout gem; followed Richard Guasch, who threw five scoreless innings with seven strikeouts; handled the 6th and 7th innings with 5 K's, allowing solo HR to Dwanaya Williams-Sutton; Lugnuts won, 12-1... catcher: William Simoneit.
- Started vs. Great Lakes, May 27... tossed 2 2/3 innings, allowing three hits, two walks, one HBP, one run and striking out four in Lugnuts 10-1 loss to the Loons... Loons broke the game open with nine unearned runs in the sixth inning against Richard Guasch and Charles Hall, handing Lugnuts a 10-1 defeat... catcher: William Simoneit.
- Started June 2 vs. South Bend, charged with loss... allowed one unearned run (due to a Millas throwing error) in four innings on three hits, no walks, with three strikeouts... used 73 pitches, 47 strikes... Cubs added two runs in 7th, one in 8th against Michael Danielak, beating Lugnuts, 4-1... catcher: Drew Millas.



Professional Career Entering 2021: Drafted 194th overall in the 6th round from Georgia Southern in 2019, signed for \$235,000 (one round in front of Lugnuts teammate Millas)... one of 10 2019 draft-ees on the Lugnuts roster... made pro debut with Short-Season A NYPL Vermont Lake Monsters on June 29, 2019... of 14 runs allowed in 11 games in 2019, nine came in two poor outings; dominated otherwise, finishing with back-to-back five-inning scoreless performances.

Family Ties: Seth's father, Bart, was the starting shortstop on the 1979 NCAA Division-II National Champion Valdosta State Blazers, hitting .277 and striking out just eight times in 61 games... sister, Sloan, was a two-time national champion cheerleader at Valdosta State... brother, Scott, nine years older (first name: Rutherford), was drafted in the 19th round in 2009 by Tampa Bay from Auburn University and pitched in the Midwest League with the 2010 Bowling Green Hot Rods (3.01, 14 saves, 46 G, 71 2/3 IP, 38 BB, 111 K), rose as high as Double-A, and spent the 2019 season as a relief ace for independent Lancaster.

Glory Days on the Diamond: Coached by his father, Bart, at Valdosta High School... named Region 1-6A Pitcher of the Year as a senior after posting 1.53 ERA, with 80 strikeouts and 15 walks in 59 innings... tossed a no-hitter vs. Tift HS... 1st-team All-Region infielder, hitting .313 with 20 BB / 13 K.

Glory Days on the Gridiron: Starting quarterback at Valdosta H.S., named 2nd-Team All-State by the Georgia Sports Writers Association and Honorable Mention All-State by the Atlanta Journal-Constitution in 2015, breaking the school's single-season passing record with 3,194 yards... 25 touchdowns, 3 interceptions... Valdosta High School football is one of the nation's most storied programs, owning the most wins in USA history (929) in addition to six national championships and 24 state championships.

Saying No to the O's: Shuman was drafted in the 39th round from Valdosta HS in 2016 by the Baltimore Orioles, 11 picks ahead of the Toronto Blue Jays' selection of 2018 Lugnuts outfielder Chavez Young... Orioles drafted his high school teammate, DL Hall, 21st overall in 2017, signing him for \$3 million... Baltimore drafted a third Valdosta HS baseball player, outfielder Colby Thomas, in the 37th round in 2019, but Thomas turned down the Orioles to attend college (in his case, Mercer University).

Speaking of Valdosta: The only Valdosta Wildcat to make the Major Leagues to date is Buck Coats, who played for the Chicago Cubs (2006), Cincinnati Reds (2007) and Toronto Blue Jays (2008). Coats, coincidentally, played two full seasons with the Lugnuts, 2002 and 2003, totaling 265 games and 989 at-bats.

Transitioning from Football to Baseball in Statesboro: Wore No. 10 and played in four games as a freshman QB on Georgia Southern football team, taking 114 snaps, in 2016-2017, passing for 357 yards and a touchdown and rushing for 39 yards... considered a walk-on with Georgia Southern baseball due to football scholarship, and split his time between baseball and spring football... quickly impressed as an impact pitcher as a freshman, going 8-0, 3.34, 46 2/3 IP, 49 K, and received the honor of the start in Sun Belt Tournament Championship game vs. South Alabama (received no-decision)... left football team after freshman year to gain full baseball scholarship... named Preseason All-Sun Belt Conference in both 2018 and 2019 as sophomore and junior... named First-Team All-Sun Belt Conference in 2019 (3.83, 16 GS, 91 2/3 IP, 27 BB, 114 K)... earned nickname "The Franchise" at Georgia Southern because of his importance to the program during his three years.

Fly Eagles Fly: Georgia Southern University baseball has produced 17 Major Leaguers, led by Joey Hamilton, John Tudor, Scott Fletcher, Todd Greene, Sam Howard, longtime MiLB manager Marty Pevey, and longtime MiLB manager John Tamargo Sr., father of the former Lugnuts hitting coach and manager John Tamargo, Jr.

A Fun Georgia Southern Note: The Eagles' most notable game in team history might have been on March 15, 2008, when they hit 14 home runs in a 26-8 victory over Columbia. In the eighth inning alone, the Eagle crushed five homers, including three consecutive shots by pinch-hitters. "I thought we took some good swings, and certainly conditions with the wind were right for it today, as well," coach Rodney Hennon said afterward.
