### RHP Peter Lambert (0-1, 7.20) vs. RHP River Ryan (0-0, 27.00)

TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes hold a 2-1 series advantage after claiming an 8-5 victory last night over Oklahoma City ... Peter Lambert is set to make his third Isotopes start of the season while River Ryan is slated to toe the rubber for Oklahoma City.

**B-ROD**: Rockies infielder Brendan Rodgers played in his first rehab game last night and went 1-for-4 with three RBI. He connected on a two-run double in the third inning (109.6 MPH exit velocity)

SERIES LEAD: The Isotopes hold a 2-1 series advantage for the third time this season and first time against a team other than El Paso. (also: May 7-9 at El Paso and June 11-13 vs. EL Paso).

DUBS: Albuquerque has won four of its last five contests and six of eight, the most wins in an eight game stretch all season

**DINGERS**: Albuquerque has belted a homer in eight-straight contests, tying the team-high set from May 7-15 ... During current stretch they've hit 17 homers compared to 18 during previous

VS. OKLAHOMA CITY: All six of Albuquerque's wins over Oklahoma City this season have been decided by three runs or

SWIPES: The Isotopes did not steal a base last night, just the fifth time in 21 games against Oklahoma City the club didn't recorded a swipe

ALLOWING SB: On defense, Albuquerque allowed multiple stolen bases last night for the first time since May 29 vs. Oklahoma City (two).

ON THE BUMP: Karl Kauffmann allowed just two runs on five hits and five walks with four punchouts over his 5.0 innings of work yesterday ... The five walks are tied for the second-most in a game by an Isotopes starter (high: six, twice, both by Tyler Danish) ... It's also the 14th time an Isotopes starter issued at least four walks in a contest.

ATTENDANCE: Over 39 home openings, the Isotopes have tallied the fourth-highest total attendance in all of Minor League Baseball and most in the Pacific Coast League (256,334). Highest: Lehigh Valley, 271, 614.

ISOTOPES ALL-TIME RBI LEADERS: Jason Wood, 328 (2003-06, 2008); Jordan Patterson, 229 (2016-18); Sam Hilliard, 214 (2019, 2021-24) Coco Montes, 213 (2022-24); Mike Tauchman, 211 (2016-18). STOVIE: Hunter Stovall extended his hit streak to six games with his ninth multi-hit contest and third-straight last night. During stretch, he is 10-for-23 with four doubles, two homers and six RBI. It was his first two double game since Sept. 8, 2022, with Double-A Hartford.

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard extended his hit streak to eight-games with a single Wednesday, tied for the second-longest active streak in the PCL. During stretch slashing .371/.450/.771 with a double, two triples, three homers and nine RBI. Also drew two walks for the eighth time this season.

JC: Julio Carreras has a seven-game hit streak, slashing 423/429/538 with three doubles and two RBI. Tied for the third-longest active streak in PCL ... Raised batting average from .190 to .219 during stretch ... Swiped his 20th bag of the season Wednesday, establishing a new career high.

COOLIN' OFF: Drew Romo recorded a hit and two RBI, his first multi-RBI game since June 1 vs. Oklahoma City ... From April 21-May 18, Drew Romo slashed .450/.459/.725 with eight doubles, four homers, 20 RBI ... Since, over 20 games, hitting .177 (14x79).

T-BONE: Trevor Boone belted his second homer of the year last night (other: June 8 at Sacramento) ... Drew two walks yesterday for the second time in 2024 ... Has reached base in 22 of 24 starts this season.

MR. VANDY: Connor Kasier went 2-for-5 with an RBI last night. It's his fifth multi-hit game of the year and first since May 16 vs. Sugar Land.

REAL SLIM SCHUNKY: Aaron Schunk's 23 doubles are 3rdmost in all of MiLB.

FAN FAVORITE: Coco Montes was 0-for-4 Wednesday but drew two walks in a game for the eighth time in 2024 ... Has four multi-hit games in his last seven contests with three hitless games.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Drew Romo is 6th in average (.305) ... Aaron Schunk is 2nd in doubles (23) and T-6th in XBH (32) ... Coco Montes is 1st in average (.335), 2nd in hits (85), 3rd in OPS (.965), T-3rd in triples (6), 4th in OBP (.414), 5th in slugging (.551), T-5th in total bases (140), T-9th in XBH (31) and RBI (47) and T-10th in walks (37), ... Sam Hilliard is 2nd in runs (57), 4th in XBH (34) and total bases (142), T-4th in walks (38), T-5th in triples (5), T-6th in homers (14) 7th in slugging (.542), hits (76) and OPS (.916) ... ### **NUCLEI NOTES**

**SKIPPER**: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

**HOMETOWN KID:** Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

**BALLS AND STRIKES**: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.

- In 2022, pitched a combined 11.0 innings between Triple-A Albuquerque and the Salt River Rafters of the Arizona Fall League due to forearm injury
- From 2020-2022 threw just 37.1 innings pro innings, including his AFL stint
- Missed the entire 2020 season and most of 2021 after undergoing Tommy John Surgery in July 2020
- Made his Major League debut on June 6, 2019 at Wrigley Field, pitching seven innings of one-run ball with nine strikeouts to earn the win over the Cubs
- Was committed to play college baseball at UCLA but went pro instead
- His older brother Jimmy pitches in the Major Leagues for the Chicago White Sox
- Was the 2015 Los Angeles Times prep baseball player of the year after going 13-0 with an 0.34 ERA as a senior at San Dimas High School
