LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox quieted the Binghamton Rumble Ponies in a 5-1 win on Saturday afternoon for their fourth consecutive win. Samuel Basallo and Silas Ardoin both collected three hits each and Collin Burns drove in a game-high two RBI in the victory. Starter Alex Pham struck out a season-high seven over 4.2 innings and allowed just one run on two hits. Kyle Virbitsky grabbed his team-leading fourth win of the year with 2.1 innings of scoreless relief and Trey McGough closed it out with 2.0 scoreless innings.

STARTING OUT RIGHT

Bowie starting pitching has been superb through the first five games of this series. **Ryan Long, Trace Bright, Brandon Young, Seth Johnson, and Alex Pham** have combined to give up just two earned runs over 20.1 innings thrown (0.88 ERA). The Baysox staff ERA in the last nine games is down to 1.69 - second-lowest in all of MiLB.

BURNS BABY BURNS

Over his last five games, IF **Collin Burns** is batting .571 (8-for-17) with a homer, a double and five RBI. The 23-year-old has brought home the go-ahead runs in two games this series with a solo homer in the eighth on Wednesday and a two-run double in the seventh on Saturday. Burns has hits in five straight games and has driven in runs in three of the last four contests.

JUD FLEXIN' ON 'EM

OF **Jud Fabian** blasted his league-leading fifth homer of the month of May on Thursday to break the scoreless tie in the sixth. The Orioles No. 12 prospect is slashing .265/.321/.592 with five homers and 11 RBI this month. The 23-year-old now has seven homers on the season, which leads the team and is fifth in the league.

RELIEVERS STAY READY

After 4.1 more innings and four more strikeouts from Baysox relievers yesterday, Bowie's bullpen continues to lead the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings thrown (177.2) and strikeouts (220). 20 of the 21 wins accumulated by Baysox pitchers have been credited to the relievers. Bowie's bullpen also has a 1.15 WHIP, which is the third-lowest in all of Double-A.

LONG TOSSIN'

RHP **Ryan Long** makes his eighth appearance and his seventh start of the season. The 24-year-old received the start in the series opener on Tuesday and threw four innings of one-run ball with five strikeouts over two walks in the loss. In his last two road starts, Long has allowed just one run in 8.0 innings with 12 strikeouts. Long was drafted in the 17th round of the 2021 Draft out of Division III Pomona-Pitzer in Southern California.

SADDLING UP THE PONIES

Entering this week, the Binghamton Rumble Ponies own the best record in the Northeast Division at 18-13. Before their loss on Sunday, they had won a league-best eight in a row. The Rumble Ponies pitching has been a strong suit with the fourth-best ERA in the league (3.76). Eight of the Mets' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- OF/1B Ryan Clifford (No. 4), C Kevin Parada (No. 9), RHP Blade Tidwell (No. 10), RHP Brandon Sproat (RHP), OF Alex Ramirez (OF), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 18), RHP Joander Suarez (No. 28), and OF Rhylan Thomas (No. 30).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Joander Suarez makes his eighth appearance and his sixth start of the season. The 24-year-old followed Mets rehabber David Peterson on Tuesday in the series opener and spun 3.2 shutout innings with five strikeouts while allowing just one hit in the victory. Suarez has gone five or more innings in five of his seven appearances this season and has gone six or more frames in three of those appearances. In the month of May, the Mets No. 28 prospect has a 0.56 ERA in 16 innings thrown and opposing batters are hitting just .120 against him.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.
