LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox were shut out for the 12th time this season in a 7-0 loss on Friday to even up the series. Bowie mustered only two hits on the night as Major League rehabber Matthew Boyd threw five innings and left-hander Parker Messick threw four innings to complete Akron's league-leading 13th shutout win of the season. Boyd and Messick combined to set down the final 21 batters faced in the victory. Alex Pham lasted only 1.2 innings after giving up four runs with two outs in the second inning.

ALL-STAR SAMUEL

C/1B Samuel Basallo, the Orioles 2024 All-Star Futures Game selection, has the 10th-most hits in the Eastern League (83). The No. 2 Orioles/ No. 12 MLB prospect is tied for the 3rd-most homers by a teenager in MiLB (13) and is the first teenager to hit double-digit home runs in an Eastern League season since Vladimir Guerrero Jr. in 2018 (NH).

THE FABULOUS FABIAN

After hitting his 15th homer of the season on Tuesday, OF **Jud Fabian** is now the Eastern League leader in home runs amongst active players and is one off sharing the overall league lead. The O's No. 11 prospect has five career home runs vs Akron, including three at Canal Park.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF/1B Dylan Beavers registered his first multi-homer game of his career on Wednesday with his 10th and 11th homers of the season, matching his season total from last year. The 22-year-old has reached base in 64 of 80 games played in his second season with the Baysox. He leads the team in walks (44) and stolen bases (20), tied for 4th-most and tied for 6th-most in the Eastern League, respectively.

EXTRA ORDINARY

After collecting only 20 extra-base hits and four homers through the first 15 games in the month of July, Bowie has collected a whopping 15 extra-base hits and seven homers in just the first four games this week in Akron. 15 of the 25 hits in the series have gone for extra bases and 10 different players have managed to collect an extra-base

BOWENS BATS 'EM IN

1B/OF **TT Bowens** is Bowie's RBI leader with 45 on the season, which ranks 12th in the Eastern League. His 18 doubles this season is good for 7th in the circuit. After playing in only 47 games last season due to injuries, he has managed to stay healthy this year and will play his 75th game. Bowens has the best numbers against Akron this year, batting a team-best .321 with three doubles, a homer and five RBI.

ARMS RACE

The Baysox pitching staff has the 7th-best ERA in Double-A since June 1 (3.56) and has recorded the 2nd-most strikeouts this season (921)...The Baysox bullpen has thrown the most innings (454.2) at Double-A with the 4th-best WHIP (1.21)...The Bowie rotation has also done its part with the 4th-lowest ERA (3.23) in Double-A in July.

LET'S DISCUSS THE DUCKS

Entering this week, the Akron RubberDucks own the best second-half record in the Eastern League at 15-6. The RubberDucks have the best staff ERA in the Eastern League at 3.22 and they are tied with Harrisburg for the most shutouts in the league this season (12). Four of the Guardians top 30 prospects are on the RubberDucks active roster - OF Petey Halpin (No. 15), LHP Parker Messick (No. 21), 1B CJ Kayfus (No. 27) and IF Dayan Frias (No. 28)

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Rvan Webb is scheduled to make his 18th start of the season tonight. The 25-year-old southpaw owns the second-lowest ERA in the Eastern League amongst qualified pitchers at 2.75. His 102 strikeouts on the season is tied for fourth-most in the circuit with Bowie's Alex Pham. Webb has been strong in the month of July with just one earned run allowed over 15 innings (0.60 ERA) and a WHIP of 0.87. The Roswell, GA native was drafted by Cleveland in 2021 in the 4th round out of Georgia.

The- "Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake" are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of Mil.B's "Copa de la Diversión "M" or "Fun Cup" "During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organizations Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain basebal team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia an New Zealand in 2011.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

Fundamentals Coach
