SUNDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox secured a series split against the Erie SeaWolves on Sunday afternoon with a 6-1 victory. Starter **Michael Forret** made his Double-A debut and threw six innings and struck out seven, allowing just one unearned run on two hits. **Austin Overn** recorded three hits and two homers as a part of a three RBI day. **Aron Estrada** also teed off for his fifth Double-A homer.

CREED CRUSHES

C Creed Willems batted .375 (9-for-24) this past week with four extra base hits (three homers) and was tied for the league-lead with nine RBI alongside teammate Adam Retzbach. On Wednesday, he delivered his second multi-homer game of the season and the third of his career. All three of his multi-homer games have been with the Baysox (Aug. 24, 2024 @ AKR, May 2, 2025 @ HFD, Aug. 13, 2025 vs ERI). Willems has collected a hit in six straight games.

SOMEWHERE OVERN THE RAINBOW

OF Austin Overn blasted his first two Double-A homers with a two-homer game on Sunday. It's his second multi-homer game of the month and of his career and the first at Double-A. The No. 30 Orioles prospect leads the Orioles farm with 51 stolen bases and is third in walks drawn (56) this season between High-A and Double-A.

RETZ CAN RAKE

Over his last nine games, C **Adam Retzbach** is batting **.371 (13-for-35) with three doubles, three homers and 12 RBI.** The 24-year-old's eight-game hit and RBI streak came to an end on Sunday. Retzbach's career-high and team-high 51 RBI is tied for fourth-most in the Orioles' system and 10th most in the Eastern League.

SMOOTH LIKE BUTTER

IF **Brandon Butterworth** has adjusted to his new scenery just fine. One of six prospects received from the Padres in the Ryan O'Hearn/Ramon Laureano trade, **Butterworth** has reached base in his first 13 games with hits in nine of those contests since joining the Baysox. The 22-year-old had the sixth-most extra base hits (35) and the most triples (7) in the Midwest League while with High-A Fort Wayne (SD).

ESTRADA IS ELECTRIC

IF **Aron Estrada** hit his fifth Double-A homer on Sunday afternoon in the ninth. **After hitting five homers in 81 games with High-A Aberdeen, Estrada has blasted already five bombs in 16 games with Double-A Chesapeake.** The 20-year-old led High-A Aberdeen in AVG, H, 2B, 3B, RBI and OBP at the time of his promotion.

CLOSE GAMES AND FREE BASEBALL

Chesapeake has won 21 games in one-run fashion - which is tied for the second-most in the Eastern League. Chesapeake has 11 extra inning wins, which is the most in full-season MiLB. The Baysox have played 39 one-run games this season, which is third-most in all of Double-A.

ASSESSING THE SQUIRRELS

The Richmond Flying Squirrels - Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants - are 22-22 in the second half and 3.5 games out of the division lead in the Southwest. Despite a series loss at home to Altoona this past week, Richmond is 14-7 on the road in the second half. Richmond's active roster includes three of the Giants' top 30 prospects (MLB.com) - OF Bo Davidson (No. 5), LHP Joe Whitman (No. 15) and IF Diego Velasquez (No. 24).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Shane Rademacher makes his fourth Double-A start since joining the Flying Squirrels on July 29. The 24-year-old began the season in High-A Eugene and recorded a 2.60 ERA in 97 innings pitched with a WHIP of just 0.98. In his last two starts, Rademacher has given up at least five earned runs and six hits. Rademacher was signed as an undrafted free agent by the Giants in 2023 out of Chowan University, a Division II school located in Murfreesboro, N.C.

2025: 2nd-most K (122) and 5th-most IP (94.2) in Orioles system. Piggybacked Orioles' ML rehabber Albert Suarez and threw Double-A high 6.0 innings, allowed 6 R on 6 H with 1 BB and Double-A high 9 K in most recent outing on 8/12 vs ERI. Set down final 15 batters in a row after giving up six runs in the first two innings pitched. Since giving up 6 ER in AA debut on 6/17 @ ERI, has given up 3 ER or less in all but two outings this season. Promoted to Double-A Chesapeake on 6/17. Started season in High-A Aberdeen. Made 11 appearances (9 starts) and posted a 3.57 ERA with 65 K in 53.0 IP and allowed just 10 BB. Went a career-high 7.0 IP, allowed just 1 R and struck out eight in final High-A start on 6/11 @ JS. At time of promotion, was tied for 9th in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Struck out seven or more batters in five of his 11 outings.

2024: Spent first full season in Minors in Single-A Delmarva splitting time as a starter and as a tandem reliever. In 25 games (14 starts), recorded a 3.15 ERA and struck out 119 batters in 103.0 IP and allowed just 25 BB. **4th in Carolina League in K and 7th in IP**. Amongst O's minor leaguers, threw 8th-most IP and tied for 9th-most K. Posted a 1.69 ERA in the second half. Performed slightly better as a reliever (2.72 ERA) than as a starter (3.49 ERA).

Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
