JUMBO SHRIMP FALL IN PITCHERS' DUEL

Yonny Chirinos fired 6.1 innings of one-run ball, but the Jumbo Shrimp were shut out 1-0 by the Storm Chasers at Werner Park. The lone run of the game came in the first inning. John Rave led off with a single. Two batters later, Nick Loftin walked. Nick Pratto followed with an RBI single to plate Rave for the contest's only run. Chirinos went 6.1 frames, ceding just one run on five hits. He struck out six against one walk. Jacksonville's best opportunities to score came in the eighth and ninth innings, but in both frames, they hit into an inning-ending double play.

ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Jonah Bride** has had two short stints in the major leagues this season, batting 2-for-12. With Jacksonville, however, Bride is 32-for-101 (.317/.453/.644/1.097) with seven doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 18 RBIs, 22 walks and 16 runs scored in 29 games played. The Owasso, Okla., native ranks second in the IL in slugging percentage and OPS, respectively, fourth in OBP, tied for 10th in home runs, 10th in batting average and tied for 18th in both extra-base hits (16) and walks.

TO THE VICTOR GO THE SPOILS

Jacksonville outfielder **Victor Mesa Jr.** missed the first six games of the season with an injury, but the 22-year-old has quickly made up for that lost time. In 29 games thus far with the Jumbo Shrimp, Mesa Jr. is 34-for-117, slashing .291/.354/.504/.858 with seven doubles, six home runs, 26 RBIs, 12 walks and 22 runs scored. In 123 games last season with Double-A Pensacola, Mesa Jr. struck out in 22.9 percent of his plate appearances. He has shaved that to 15.4 percent this season with Jacksonville.

TWO DOWN, A MILE TO GO

Over the club's last eight games dating back to May 3, the Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 48 runs (6.0 per game), the ninth-most in Triple-A during that span. Of those 48 runs, a whopping 29, or 60.4 percent, have come with two outs. On the season, Jacksonville pitching has ceded 115 hits in 106.0 innings pitched with two outs, the fourth-most in Triple-A. Opponents are hitting .266 with an .806 OPS against the Jumbo Shrimp with two down, which respectively place as the fourth- and fifth-highest marks at the level.

NOT GREAT, BOB

After falling 1-0 on Satuday at Omaha, Jacksonville has now dropped 10 of its last 11 games. The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled in nearly every facet of the game during this stretch. Offensively over this stretch, the club ranks 27th in Triple-A in batting average (.219), 27th in on-base percentage (.307), 28th in slugging percentage (.335), 27th in OPS (.642), 27th in hits (79) and tied for 27th in runs scored (40). On the other side of the ball, Jacksonville has surrendered the eighth-most hits (103) and 13th-most runs (62) on the seventh-worst BAA (.275) and eighth-worst OPS-against (.810).

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 25 of Jacksonville's 38 games (65.8 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including seven straight contests and 10 of the club's last 11 affairs. After beginning the season 12-3 (.750) in these narrowlydecided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost nine of its last 10 games decided by three runs or fewer. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests.

TROY MEETS WORLD

Troy Johnston, the Miami Marlins Minor League Player of the Year in 2023, got off to a slow start this season. Through his first 16 games, the Puyallup, Wash., batted just .203/.292/.234/.526 with two doubles, six RBIs, four walks and three runs scored. In his last 22 games, however, Johnston is 27-for-91 at the plate, hitting .297/.333/.429/.762 with nine doubles, one home run, 10 RBIs, four walks and 13 runs scored. He has reached base at least once in 19 of the 22 games during this hot stretch, recording multiple times on base nine times.


