LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn earned a series victory with a 7-4 come-from-behind triumph at Hudson Valley on Sunday afternoon...Renegades jumped out to a 4-0 lead after 3 innings on a pair of solo home runs by 2B **Ben Cowles** and a 2-run home run by C **Agustín Ramírez**...Cyclones tied it in the 4th on a grand slam by DH **Omar De Los Santos**...Brooklyn jumped in front for good on back-to-back home runs from RF **Stanley Consuegra** (2-run) and 1B **Mateo Gil** (solo)...Cyclones' bullpen combined to throw 6.1-shutout innings...RHP **Benito García** (2.1 IP), RHP **Jace Beck** (1.0), RHP **Dylan Hall** (1.0), RHP **Joey Lancellotti** (1.0), and RHP **Paul Gervase** (1.0) united to allow 3 hits and strike out 9...Beck earned his 4th win, while Gervase stranded a pair in the 9th for his 6th save.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Brooklyn has won 12-of-16 (.750) and 18-of-25 (.720) going into Tuesday's series opener...The Cyclones have won 5-consecutive series dating back to June 20-25 vs. Hudson Valley and have not dropped a set since Greenville won 4-of-6 on Coney Island from June 6-11...The Cyclones are 17-7 in the second half and lead the North Division of the SAL by half a game over Aberdeen (16-7)...Brooklyn a half-game behind Hickory (17-6) for the best record in the circuit during the half.

COMEBACK 'CLONES: Brooklyn earned their 18th come-from-behind victory with a 7-4 win at Hudson Valley on Sunday...The Cyclones matched their largest comeback of the year, erasing a 4-run, 4-0 deficit entering the 4th inning... The Cyclones came from 4 runs down to earn the victory on July 4 vs. Wilmington and on Opening Day, April 7, vs. Jersey Shore...Friday marked the 11th win in their final at-bat with an 8-7 win at Hudson Valley...It was also Brooklyn's second win in 2023 when trailing after 8 innings.

I GOT YOUR SIX: OF **Alex Ramírez** became the first player in Cyclones history to record a 6-hit game with a 6-for-6 performance on Friday night at Hudson Valley...The 20-year-old also stole 3 bases, scored 3 runs, drove in a tally, and robbed 3B **Marcos Cabrera** of a home run in the 2nd inning...Ramírez is 1-of-5 players in Minor League Baseball to compose a 6-hit game in 2023...Alex is the first player in Minor League Baseball since the stat portal began in 2005 to record 6+ hits and 3+ stolen bases in a single game...Only two players in Major League history have accomplished the feat in the modern era (since 1901)...OF **Sammy Sosa** (Chicago-NL, 7/2/93 at Colorado) and OF **Max Carey** (Pittsburgh, 7/7/22 vs. New York-NL)...Since the start of June, Alex is 2nd in the South Atlantic League lead in runs scored (32), 5th in pitches-per-plate appearance (3.978), and tied for 6th in walks (24) (min. 170 PA)...Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Tuesday, the Dominican native is 3rd in franchise history in RBI (72) and is 19 behind INF **José Péroza** (91) for the all-time mark...He is 2nd in doubles (32), 3rd in hits (136), 3rd in total bases (200) and 4th in runs scored (72).

ACE GERVASE: RHP **Paul Gervase** has been as dominant as any relief pitcher in Minor League Baseball in 2023...Through 25 relief appearances, the 23-year-old is 1st and 2nd in ERA (1.16) among SAL and MiLB relievers, respectively (min. 35.0 IP)...The 2022 12th-round pick is 4th in MiLB in opposing batting average (.131)...Since June 9, Gervase holds a 0.53 ERA (1 ER in 17.0 IP) with a hold and 5 saves over 12 relief outings...In MiLB, the former Louisiana State arm is 2nd in strikeouts-per-9 innings (16.41) among MiLB relievers (min 15.0 IP), tied for 3rd in hits allowed (6) tied for 4th in opposing batting average (.105), 5th in opposing OPS (.384), and 6th in ERA (0.53)...He holds a strikeout rate of 44.9% in that time.

CUTTING 'EM DOWN: With 4 strikeouts on Thursday night, RHP **Blade Tidwell** set the Cyclones' single-season strikeout record (107)...The 22-year-old surpassed RHP **Junior Santos'** mark of 105 set in 2022...His 107 K's sit 4th overall in franchise history and is 6 behind RHP **Alec Kisena** (113) for 3rd...Tidwell has earned the win in 5 of his last 6 outings with Brooklyn winning all 6 games...He has permitted just 7 runs on 25 hits over 38.0 innings...He has walked only 10 (6.9 BB%) and struck out 47 (32.4 K%) in those contests...Tidwell punched out a career-high and team-season-best-matching 11 in consecutive starts on July 6 at Wilmington and June 30 vs. Jersey Shore...This comes after he tied a then-career-best with 10 strikeouts on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 11 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 7-0 with a 1.70 ERA (11 ER in 58.1 IP) with just 35 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 30 and struck out 80 (34.0 K%)...Tidwell's holding opponents to a meager .172 batting average (35-204) against him...In that time, Tidwell is 2nd in the South Atlantic League and is 4th in Minor League Baseball in strikeouts (80)...He is also 2nd in ERA (1.70) and 3rd in batting average against (.172) since that date (min. 55.0 IP)...On the season in the SAL, the Loretto, Tenn. native leads in batting average against (.195), is tied for 2nd in wins (7), 3rd in strikeouts (107), and 4th in ERA (3.29).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** entered as a pinch-runner and stole second base on Friday night at Hudson Valley, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The 33 swipes break INF **Walter Rasquin'** franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 3rd in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 103 stolen bases in that span, which is 66th most in MiLB...Only D'Backs prospect OF **Wilderd Patiño** (108), Mariners farmhand OF **Jonatan Clásé** (108), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (108), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (106), and Red Sox prospect OF **David Hamilton** (104) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 60 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 43.

PARADA POWER: C **Kevin Parada** registered his 2nd multi-home run game of the season on July 15 vs. Greensboro, tallying solo shots in the 1st and 5th innings...The Pasadena, Calif. native also accrued multiple blasts on June 23 vs. Hudson Valley...Kevin poked a solo home run in the 3rd and a 2-run inside-the-parker in the 6th...Since 2005, Parada is 1 of 2 Cyclones to record a pair of multi-homer games in the same season...INF **Nick Evans** powered a pair of jacks on July 22, 2005, vs. Jamestown and again on August 24, 2005, at Williamsport...Dating back to June 6 vs. Greenville, the 21-year-old is slashing .303/.367/.545 with a .912 OPS and 151 wRC+ in 34 games...Parada has accrued 18 runs scored, 5 doubles, 3 triples, 7 home runs, 22 RBI, 11 walks, and 3 hit-by-pitches...The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Tuesday tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (33) and doubles (19), 6th in total bases (139), and 7th in hits (82)...Since June 6, Parada is tied for 1st in triples (3), tied for 3rd in total bases (72), tied for 5th in hits (40), tied for 8th in extra-base hits (15) and home runs (7), 8th in slugging (.545), and 10th in OPS (.912).

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn returns to Coney Island for a 6-game homestand against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks posses 6 of Washington's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: LHP **Jake Bennett** (8), OF **Jeremy De La Rosa** (10), OF **Daylen Lile** (11), INF **T.J. White** (12), and RHP **Andry Lara** (15)...C **Israel Pineda** (19) is with the squad on a Minor League rehab assignment...Brooklyn and Wilmington are meeting at Maimonides Park for the 2nd time in 2023...The Cyclones dropped 3-of-5 to the 'Rocks from April 18-23...The final game was postponed due to wet grounds...In the last meeting in Wilmington, Brooklyn won 5-of-6 contests from July 4-9...The Cyclones are 9-9 (.500) in 18 meetings against Wilmington in 2023...Overall, the 'Clones are 35-33 (.515) all-time against the Blue Rocks since their first meeting in 2021.

THE RHY-T STUFF: OF **Rhylan Thomas** made a spectacular game-saving catch to close out Brooklyn's 4-3 win at Hudson Valley on Thursday night...The 23-year-old also picked 2 hits and a run scored on Sunday and enters Tuesday on a 7-game hitting streak...Thomas is 10-for-24 (.417) at the plate with a 1.003 OPS, 5 runs scored, a home run, 4 RBI, and 2 walks...In 10 games since July 4 at Wilmington, the former USC Trojan is 13-for-35 (.371) at the dish with a .867 OPS, 5 runs scored, a home run, 6 RBI, and 3 walks to only 2 strikeouts.

O SAY, CONSUEGRA: OF **Stanley Consuegra** collected his first career multi-home run game for Brooklyn on Wednesday afternoon and provided a go-ahead 2-run home run in the 7th on Sunday at Hudson Valley...Consuegra is the 3rd different Cyclone to tally a multi-home run game in 2023, joining C **Drake Osborn** (6/17) and C **Kevin Parada** (6/23 & 7/15)...He has also tallied 3-straight multi-hit games since Wednesday (6-for-13)...The Dominican native has picked up at least one hit in 15-of-19 games since being reinstated...Stanley is slashing .257/.305/.514 with a .818 OPS, adding 9 runs scored, 4 doubles, 5 home runs, and 12 RBI...In that time, Consuegra ranks tied for 2nd in the circuit in home runs (5) and tied for 5th in extra-base hits (9).

SUPER STAFF: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Tuesday, Brooklyn has posted a MiLB-low 2.80 ERA (157 ER in 505.0 IP) over their last 58 games, holding a 34-24 record in that span...The Cubs' Single-A Myrtle Beach (316) is 2nd in the minors and trails the 'Clones by nearly half a run (0.36)...The Cyclones have hurled 6 shutouts in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 28.2% and a walk rate of 11.2%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 2nd lowest opposing OPS (.610), in addition to the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (6.74) in that time period...RHPs **Blade Tidwell** (1.70) and **Tyler Stuart** (1.71) hold the 2nd and 3rd best ERA's in MiLB during that time (min. 55.0 IP).

RED HOT RELIEF: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Tuesday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.10) in the entire South Atlantic League and throughout Minor League Baseball...The Royals' Single-A Columbia (314) is 2nd in MiLB, while Hudson Valley (3.51) is 2nd in the circuit...The Cyclones' bullpen is also 5th in batting average against (.209) and hits-per-9 innings (6.88).

YO-JOANDER: Suárez continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...The 23-year-old hurled a quality start on Saturday at Hudson Valley and set a new career-high with 7.0 innings of work in a July 8 defeat at Wilmington...Over his last 7 appearances (6 starts) since June 14 at Aberdeen, Suárez holds only a 2-3 record, but a 3.82 ERA (13 ER in 30.2 IP), 12 walks (9.8 BB%), and 43 strikeouts (35.0 K%)...Narrowed down to his last 3 starts, to Cumaná, Venezuela native holds a 2.65 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with 5 walks (7.7 BB%) and 24 strikeouts (36.9 K%)...In his first 9 appearances (8 starts), the right-hander was 1-4 with an 8.02 ERA (30 ER in 33.2 IP), 28 walks (16.5 BB%), and 39 strikeouts (23.1 K%).

AROUND THE CAROUSEL: 2B **D'Andre Smith** picked up his first home run as a Cyclone with an inside-the-parker in the 7th on Friday night at Hudson Valley...It was the 2nd inside-the-park home run clubbed by Brooklyn in 2023...C **Kevin Parada** capped his first career multi-home run game with a 2-run inside-the-park home run in the 6th inning of June 23's win vs. Hudson Valley...They are the first 2 inside-the-park home runs by Cyclones players since Minor League Baseball's stat portal began in the 2005 season...The first one in franchise history was clubbed by **Joe Giannetti** on July 19, 2001.

THE .500 CLUB: With Brooklyn's victory on Friday night, the Cyclones jumped over .500 on the season at 44-43...Brooklyn had not been over .500 since the 3rd game of the season...The Cyclones moved to 2-1 with a 4-2 win vs. Jersey Shore to close out the season-opening homestand on April 9.

HIT 'EM UP: The Cyclones tallied a season-high 18 hits in their 8-7 win at Hudson Valley on Friday night...The 18 knocks were the most by Brooklyn in a single game since they accrued 19 hits in a 20-6 win at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022.


AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on Monday...7 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C **Kevin Parada** (No. 2), OF **Alex Ramírez** (5), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7), RHP **Christian Scott** (9), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (16), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (17), and RHP **Jordany Ventura** (24)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 1), RHP **Mike Vasil** (4), OF **Matt Rudick** (13), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (14), RHP **Junior Santos** (20), RHP **José Butto** (25), RHP **Luis Moreno** (26), and OF **Rowley Jordan** (27)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not receive a decision in a start last Wednesday afternoon at Hudson Valley...Surrendered 2 runs on 1 hit over a season-high 4.2 innings...Walked 1 and struck out 5...Permitted a 2-run home run to 1B **Rafael Flores** in the bottom of the 1st...Relieved by RHP **Joshua Cornielly** with the bases empty and 2 out in the bottom of the 5th and Brooklyn behind 2-1...Cyclones rallied to take the lead, but the Renegades scored 3 in the bottom of the 8th to win, 6-4.

THE ROCO SHOW: The right-hander struck out a season-high 7 on June 21 vs. Hudson Valley and has been on a tear since...Over his last 5 appearances (1 start), Colina holds a 2-0 record with a 1.80 ERA (3 ER in 15.0 IP)...The 22-year-old has surrendered just 8 hits and walked 4 with 19 strikeouts...Colina’s strikeout rate is up 5.4 percent (33.3 K%) and walk rate is down 1.5 percent (7.0 BB%) during the time span.

ALWAYS MOVING: Colina has already pitched at 3 separate levels in 2023...The 22-year-old was assigned to Single-A St. Lucie to start the season...After making 1 appearance, Colina was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on April 16...Earned the win in his lone outing for the Rumble Ponies on April 18...He was transferred to Brooklyn on April 24.

2022: Split the season between St. Lucie and the Florida Complex League...Assigned to St. Lucie on May 2...Returned to the FCL on May 10 and reported back to St. Lucie on May 23...Registered an 0-5 record with a 7.99 ERA (29 ER in 32.2 IP) and 41 K’s in 10 appearances (6 starts) in the Florida State League...Joined the FCL club for the remainder of the season on July 19...Posted a 1-0 mark with a 1.59 ERA (3 ER in 17.0 IP) and 22 strikeouts in 4 outings (2 starts).

STARTING TIME: Colina expects to make his 3rd start of the 2023 season after pitching in relief during his initial 10 of his first 11 appearances...Last season, the 22-year-old started in 8 of his 14 outings...In a starting role in 2022, Colina held a 1-3 record with a 5.56 ERA (21 ER in 34.0 IP) in 8 starts...He held a walk rate of 7.3% and a strikeout rate of 28.7%...In 4 relief appearances, the Punto Fijo, VZ native was 0-2 with a 6.32 ERA (11 ER in 15.2 IP)...Colina’s walk rate was 12.7% and strikeout rate hovered at 28.2%.
