YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Curve, 7-0. Spencer Bivens started and threw four scoreless innings. Relievers Matt Frisbee, Parker Dunshee and Evan Gates combined to throw five scoreless innings. Vaun Brown opened the scoring with a sac fly in the third. In the fifth, Victor Bericoto drove in two runs with a triple to extend the lead to 3-0. Carter Aldrete drove in two with a double in the seventh and Jimmy Glowenke hit a two-run double in the ninth to extend the lead to 7-0. Shane Matheny finished the game 4-for-5 and scored three runs.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. The two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond from May 2-7 and split another six-game set in Richmond from June 6-11. This series marks Richmond's only visit to Altoona this season.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 24-12 in their last 36 games since June 18. They went 5-1 last week against the Sea Dogs after going 4-5 on the previous road trip to resume play out of the All-Star Break. Over the last 41 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 3.01 ERA (52 ER/155.1 IP) and have allowed 11 home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.74 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 356.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 487.0 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.42 ERA, which is the second-lowest in Double-A and the sixth-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

THE CURVE are 4-7 in their last 11 games since July 21. In that stretch, they are averaging 2.4 runs per game (26 runs/11 games). They have scored three-or-less runs in nine-of-their-last-11 games. Altoona's roster includes four of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 6), OF Matt Gorski (No. 12), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 13) and RHP Braxton Ashcraft (No. 14). Gorski is rated by Baseball America as the Pirates' best power hitter and best outfield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list includes four Curve players, including Solometo (No. 5), Gorski (No. 15), OF Matt Fraizer (No. 20) and Ashcraft (No. 27).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Wil Jensen makes his third start of the season and his fourth appearance of the year against the Curve. He started on Friday against the Sea Dogs and threw four scoreless innings. In his four previous outings against the Curve in his career, Jensen is 2-0 with a 0.60 ERA (1 ER/15.0 IP). This year, Jensen leads the Eastern League in relief innings pitched and has the third-lowest ERA in the Eastern League (min. 50 IP). Last year, he reached Double-A in mid-July and went on to pitched eight games (five starts) for Richmond, going 2-2 with a 4.91 ERA. Jensen was signed by the Giants as a free agent from Pepperdine University in 2020. For more on Jensen, see page two.

FOR ALTODNA: Right-hander Sean Sullivan makes his 16th start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he worked 3.1 innings and allowed four runs in a loss at Harrisburg on Friday. He pitched at The Diamond on May 4 and allowed three runs over four innings in a no-decision. In his first 10 outings of the year through June 16, he went 2-0 with a 2.87 ERA (15 ER/47.0). In his last six outings dating back to June 22, he is 0-4 with an 8.18 ERA (20 ER/22.0 IP). Sullivan was selected in the eighth round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Pirates out of Cal. He made his professional debut last year and spent the entire season with High-A Greensboro, going 2-5 with a 4.58 ERA in 20 games (15 starts).

WADE PROMOTED: Outfielder Wade Meckler was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento this week. After opening the season hitting .456 in 20 games with High-A Eugene, he joined the Flying Squirrels on May 17. During his time in the Eastern League from May 17-July 30, Meckler led the league in batting average (.336), ranked second in OBP (.431), eighth in OPS (.881) and tied for seventh in runs scored (36). Overall in the Eastern League this season (min. 150 PA), Meckler ranks first in BABIP (.407), second in batting average (.336), fourth in OBP (.431), eighth in wRC+ (148), 12th in OPS (.881) and is tied for the fourth-lowest swing-andmiss percentage (6.0). went on a 24-game on-base streak from May 17-July 6, which was the longest on-base streak to begin a Double-A career in Flying Squirrels history, passing the previous record set by Luis Matos (17 games) earlier this season. It was also tied for the ninth-longest on-base streak in franchise history. Meckler also had an 11-game run scored streak from June 23-July 6, which was a Flying Squirrels franchise record, passing the previous mark of nine straight games by Tyler LaTorre in 2014. In Game 1 of a doubleheader on June 23, Meckler tied the single-game franchise record for hits, going 5-for-5 and capping the night with a two-run, walk-off single for a 9-8 win over the Senators. Through his promotion, Meckler led the minors (min. 250 PA) in batting average (.377) and BABIP (.439), ranked eighth in OBP (.452) and eighth in wRC+ (166).

**50 LONG, SANCHEZ:** Lefty reliever **Juan Sanchez** was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento this week. In his 28 games with Richmond, he went 6-4 with a 2.39 ERA and 52 strikeouts over 49 innings, adding three saves. At the time of his promotion, Sanchez ranked fifth in the Eastern League (min. 40 IP) in ERA (2.39), was tied for the eighth-lowest HR/9 (0.55) and was tied for the eighth-lowest BAA (194). Among EL relievers (0 starts, min. 30 IP), Sanchez ranked sixth in ERA and eighth in BAA (194). In his final outing before his promotion on Sunday against the Sea Dogs, Sanchez set a Double-A high with five strikeouts while working a six-out save.

FULL MUNGUIA: In his 11 games since returning from the IL, Ismael Munguia is batting .350 (14-for-40) with two doubles, three walks and seven RBIs. He picked up four hits in his three games in his first series back on the road in Akron from July 21-23. He had nine hits and two walks over six games in last week's series against the Sea Dogs. He entered as a pinch-hitter in the ninth on Saturday night and tied the game with an RBI single, later scoring the winning run. Munguia was placed on the injured list on May 20 and reinstated on July 20, missing 49 games.

**GLDW SHDW:** Over his last 17 games since July 6, **Jimmy Glowenke** is batting .316 (18-for-57) with two homers, six doubles, 12 RBIs and seven walks. On July 18 at Akron, he closed the game a triple shy of the cycle and went 3-for-6 with a three-run homer, a two-run double and an RBI single, picking up a career-high six RBIs. On Saturday against the Sea Dogs, he hit a lead-off double to start the bottom of the ninth in Richmond's comeback win. He had two hits, including a double, and drove in two runs.

**ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny** has reached base 19 times in his last eight games since July 25 (11 hits and eight walks), posting a .528 on-base percentage and a .393 batting average. On Sunday, he hit a three-run homer and finished the afternoon with four RBIs. He went 4-for-5 with three runs scored on Wednesday night against the Curve. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 116 walks, moving ahead of **Ricky Oropesa** (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

**TAKE A WALK:** Hayden Cantrelle has walked 62 times this season, which is second-most in the Giants organization and is tied for the third-most in the Eastern League. His 19.0% walk rate is the second-highest in the league this season. He also has the third-best on-base percentage (.397) in the league this year. His 62 walks this season are tied for the second-most in a single year in Flying Squirrels franchise history, even with **Jarrett Parker** (2013) and **Mark Minicozzi** (2013). The single-season record of 80 was set by **Jacob Heyward** in 2019. Cantrelle is on pace for 87 walks this season.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have seven players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 6), OF Vaun Brown (No. 8), RHP Mason Black (No. 9), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 14), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 15), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 27) and RHP José Cruz (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes seven Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25) and Cruz (No. 28).

#### THIS DATE IN SQUIRRELS HISTORY

In 2022, the Flying Squirrels beat the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 3-2, at Delta Dental Stadium. Wil Jensen started and threw six scoreless innings, allowing one hit with five strikeouts. That performance led to Jensen being named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week. The game remained scoreless until the top of the seventh inning when Franklin Labour hit an RBI single. Brett Auerbach added a two-run homer in the eighth inning. Cole Waites closed the save.

#### IN OTHER WORDS..

Manager **Dennis Pelfrey** on the team playing well while continuing to promote to Sacramento:

"There have been a lot of changes with personnel, a lot of positive movement to Triple-A and even the big leagues. Sometimes it's really hard for teams to get back on track. We saw a little bit of that earlier in the year where we lost several key guys and went on a little bit of a slide. I think with the culture we have and what we've created over the last two years, it's really easy for guys to come in and feel comfortable, get into a good roll and have some success really quickly. I think it's a testament to our players and the work they put in on a day-to-day basis to prepare."
