YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Fisher Cats, 6-3. The Fisher Cats took a 1-0 lead in the first on a homer by Luis De Los Santos. **Kai-Wei Teng** started and struck out 10 over five innings, allowing one run. **Carter Aldrete** tied the score with a solo homer in the top of the seventh. In the bottom of the inning, the Fisher Cats scored five runs to pull ahead, 6-1. **Brandon Martorano** hit a two-run homer in the top of the ninth, the 127th of the season for Richmond, which tied the team record.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. This series is the only set of games between the two teams this year. Prior to this series, the Flying Squirrels and Fisher Cats had not played each other since 2019. This series marks the first set for the Flying Squirrels on the road against an opponent from the Northeast Division this season.

WE ARE HEADED NORTH: The Flying Squirrels are in the first leg of a 12-game road trip to New England, their first visit to the league's two northernmost cities since the 2019 season. The two series against New Hampshire and Portland are the Flying Squirrels' only two sets this year on the road against Eastern League. Northeast Division Richmond does not visit Binghamton, Hartford, Somerset or Reading this season, although all four of those teams have played or will play in Richmond. New Hampshire is the only Eastern League team that does not visit The Diamond this season.

TICKET PUNCHED: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 10-21 to open the second half. They have lost 13-of-the-last-17 games, including a season-high six-game losing streak from July 14-23. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost seven and split three this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 1,109 strikeouts (11.1 per game) and rank fourth with 127 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 23-27 on the road this year. Richmond is 23-19 in games decided by two-or-less runs. They are 11-17 overall against teams from the Northeast Division, including a 2-3 record in road games.

THE FISHER CATS have gone 8-4 since July 23, including winning four-of-six in last week's series at Binghamton. New Hampshire's roster includes eight of MLB.com's top-30 prospects (four active), including INF Orelvis Martinez (No. 2), LHP Ricky Tiedemann (No. 3), RHP Adam Kloffenstein (No. 12), RHP Hagen Danner (No. 17 - on IL), RHP Yosver Zulueta (No. 19), RHP Trent Palmer (No. 23 - on IL), RHP Joey Murray (No. 24 - out for season) and OF Sebastian Espino (No. 25).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Jake Dahlberg** makes his 19th start of the season and his second against the Fisher Cats. He started the series opener on Tuesday and worked five scoreless innings in a win, which snapped an eight-game losing streak for the Flying Squirrels in Dahlberg's starts. Over the eight team losses from June 10-July 27, Dahlberg allowed three-or-less runs in six of them. Dahlberg spent parts of three seasons with the independent Chicago Dogs before signing with the Giants during the 2021 season. He joined the High-A Eugene Emeralds in July and made 10 starts, going 2-5 with a 6.60 ERA. He closed the year with two outings with Triple-A Sacramento and tossed 9.0 scoreless innings. After being named Horizon League Pitcher of the Year twice at the University of Illinois-Chicago, he was selected in the 21st round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. **For more on Dahlberg, see page two.**

FOR NEW HAMPSHIRE: Right-hander Luis Quinones makes his 11th Double-A start and his 13th Double-A appearance. He pitched in relief on Tuesday night against the Flying Squirrels and allowed four runs over 2.2 innings, all in the ninth, and struck out five batters. Quinones was selected by the Blue Jays in the 34th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of San Jacinto College in Texas.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in total attendance (296,258) and average attendance (6,172). Richmond is 14th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 127 home runs this season, which is fourth in the Eastern League and ties the franchise's single-season record, which was set in 2021. The previous record of 109 was set in 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 174 home runs. **Sean Roby** is third in the league with 23 homers on the season, with 19 coming at The Diamond.

MARTY PARTY: **Brandon Martorano** is riding a five-game hit streak dating back to July 28, during which he is batting .500 (9-for-18) with a homer, two doubles and four RBIs. He has hit in the leadoff spot in each of the last two games, including a 4-for-5 game on Thursday night and a two-hit game on Saturday. In his three games this year batting first in the order, Martorano is batting .500 (7-for-14) with two homers and four RBIs.

BACH TO FORM: On Tuesday, **Brett Auerbach** went 4-for-4 with a solo homer, his 12th of the season. It was the second four-hit game of his career, tying a career high. He added a two-run homer in Wednesday's win. Auerbach has picked up at least one hit in seven-of-his-last-11 games since July 23. He also homered in three straight games from Saturday through Thursday.

ALRIGHTY, ALDRETE: On Tuesday night, **Carter Aldrete** hit a grand slam for his first Double-A homer. It was Aldrete's third grand slam of the season. He hit his first of the year with High-A Eugene on June 15 at Vancouver. He hit another grand slam on June 29 for the Emeralds against Everett and also hit a three-run homer in the same game, picking up a career-high seven RBIs. He has hit four grand slams in his professional career. His first came on July 15, 2021 for Eugene at Spokane. On Friday night, he brought in Richmond's only run with a ninth-inning sacrifice fly. On Saturday, he hit his second homer of the series.

GO, DIEGO, GO!: After hitting .173 (22-for-127) over his first 35 games of the season, **Diego Rincones** is batting .307 (46-for-150) with six doubles, seven homers and 28 RBIs over his last 40 games since June 7. Rincones snapped an 0-for-26 slide with a ninth-inning single on Friday night and picked up another single on Saturday night.

ROBUST: **Sean Roby** hit his 21st homer of the year on July 4 against the Fightin Phils, moving him ahead of **David Villar** for the most home runs in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. He added his 22nd homer on July 7 and his 23rd on July 9. Roby is tied for second in the EL in home runs this year behind New Hampshire's Orelvis Martinez (24). He has hit 19 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duvall** in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

FITZ ON FIRE: **Tyler Fitzgerald** homered five times, all solo shots, over a six-game span from July 10-17 heading into the mid-season break. In that stretch, he hit .421 (8-for-19). He went deep in the series finale against Reading on July 10. He added a solo homer on July 14 in Altoona, hit two solo homers on July 15 and hit another on July 17 in the series finale. In his first four games out of the mid-season break from July 22-27, he went 0-for-14, but responded with an eight-game hit streak since July 28, during which he is batting .367 (11-for-30).

DEADLINE DEAL: On Tuesday, the Giants traded Trevor Rosenthal to the Brewers for outfielder **Tristan Peters**, who had been promoted to Double-A that day. The Giants assigned him to Richmond after the trade. Peters is rated by MLB.com as the Giants' No. 25 prospect. Peters made his Double-A debut on Friday night and picked up a single for his first hit. He collected two hits on Saturday night.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked fourth in batting average (.284). **Sean Roby** is third in homers (23). **Shane Matheny** is sixth in OBP (.391). **Mike Gigliotti** is 10th in OBP (.374), tied for ninth in walks (48) and tied for fourth in stolen bases (23). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for 10th in homers (17).

WHERE THE FISHER CATS RANK: In the Eastern League, Spencer Horwitz is third in batting average (.297), first in OBP (.413), fifth in SLG (.517) and third in OPS (.930). Orelvis Martinez is tied for first in homers (24), sixth in RBIs (60), tied for seventh in extra-base hits (38) and ninth in total bases (156). Rafael Lantigua is 10th in hits (88) and second in doubles (27). Cam Eden is tied for ninth in stolen bases (20). Andrew Bash is tied for first in wins (8). Parker Caracci is tied for sixth in games pitched (34).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have five players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Ryan Murphy** (11), **Cole Waites** (19), **Ricardo Genovés** (27) and **Chris Wright** (30). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. Waites is listed as having the "Best Fastball." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Murphy (11), **Tristan Peters** (25) and Genovés (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 20 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 23 overall prospect.
