SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

THE BEST WEEK EVER: On Sunday, C Jefferson Quero tallied his second multi-home run game of the week against the Chattanooga Lookouts... He capped off a five-home run week with a 430-foot blast in the sixth inning to help the Shuckers extend their lead... During the six-game series, Quero hit five homers, drove in 10, and went 7-22 (.318) at the plate... Quero's week also earned him a spot on the MLB Pipeline Prospect Team of the Week.

INSIDE THE TOP 30: After RHP Gus Varland was returned to the Los Angeles Dodgers on Sunday, RHP Justin Jarvis entered the MLB Pipeline Brewers Top 30 prospects as the 30th in the system... Jarvis is the 10th Shuckers player to appear in the Brewers Top 30, more than any team in the organization... This year, the righty has a 2.31 ERA in seven starts... Over 11 starts in his Double-A career, Jarvis has a 2.44 ERA.

HOMER HAPPY: In six games against the Lookouts last week, the Shuckers scored 13 of their 21 runs off home runs... C Jefferson Quero led the way with five while C Jason Lopez, INF Noah Campbell and OF Jackson Chourio each tallied one... The eight home runs tied the most in a single series for the Shuckers this year... Over their last 12 games, the Shuckers have hit 16 home runs, tied for the fifth-most in Double-A.

EXTRA-INNING MADNESS: The Shuckers took home their second extra-innings win of the year on Sunday with a 9-7 win in 10 innings against the Chattanooga Lookouts... The win marked their first in extra-innings since the home opener on Tuesday, April 11 against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos... In 2023, the Shuckers are 2-2 in extra-inning games, with both losses coming on the road against the Montgomery Biscuits.

MOVING TOWARDS HISTORY: Shuckers manager Mike Guerrero enters today needing nine more wins to reach 1,400 in his managerial career... Guerrero is in his 25th season in Minor League Baseball in 2023 and his 24th with the Brewers organization... Over his seven-year managerial career in Biloxi, Guerrero has earned a two trips to the Southern League Championship Series, in 2018 and 2019... Guerrero also led the Shuckers to a franchise-best 82 wins during the 2019 season, a year after he led the Shuckers to a then-record 81 wins.

TODAY'S STARTER // LHP NICK BENNETT (2-1, 3.48): LHP Nick Bennett is set to make his first start since September 17, 2022 at Pensacola where he set a career-high with 11 strikeouts and tied his career-best with seven innings... This year, Bennett has appeared in nine games as a reliever, including twice against Montgomery... In his two appearances, Bennett has allowed a run in 4.2 innings with six strikeouts.
