LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox outlasted the Binghamton Rumble Ponies for their third consecutive win in a 3-2 victory on Friday night. Tied 1-1 entering the eighth, Frederick Bencosme, who entered earlier in the game for Max Wagner after an injury, broke the tie with a solo home run to right. Dylan Beavers went back-to-back with Bencosme to give Bowie a 3-1 lead entering the ninth. Dylan Heid slammed the door with the tying and winning runs on base. Starting pitcher Seth Johnson threw four innings and did not allow an earned run while Carlos Tavera collected the win after four scoreless innings of relief and six strikeouts.

STARTING OUT RIGHT

Bowie starting pitching has been superb through the first four games of this series. **Ryan Long**, **Trace Bright**, **Brandon Young** and **Seth Johnson** have combined to give up just one earned run over 15.2 innings thrown. The Baysox starting rotation has thrown the fewest amount of innings in the league so far this season (134.2) but have punched out the fifth-most batters (157).

THE BAYSOX BOMBERS

After homers by **Frederick Bencosme** and **Dylan Beavers** last night, Bowie is second in the Eastern League in homers (38) and tied for third in all of Double-A in the long ball category. The Baysox have hit the third most homers in the month of May (13) with five of them alone coming from OF **Jud Fabian**.

JUD FLEXIN' ON 'EM

OF **Jud Fabian** blasted his league-leading fifth homer of the month of May on Thursday to break the scoreless tie in the sixth. The Orioles No. 12 prospect is slashing .295/.353/.659 with five homers and 11 RBI this month. The 23-year-old now has seven homers on the season, which leads the team and is fifth in the league.

RELIEVERS STAY READY

After five more innings and seven more strikeouts from Baysox relievers yesterday, Bowie's bullpen continues to lead the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings thrown (173.1) and strikeouts (216). 19 of the 20 wins accumulated by Baysox pitchers have been credited to the relievers. Bowie's bullpen also has a 1.17 WHIP, which is tied for the fourth-lowest in all of Double-A.

YOU GOOD PHAM

RHP **Alex Pham** makes his eighth start of the season for the Baysox. The Orioles No. 24 prospect is off to a solid start in the month of May with an ERA of just 1.86 in 9.2 innings thrown this month. Pham matched his season-high in strikeouts in his last road start against Richmond on April 24 with six strikeouts in five innings. The right-hander makes his first career start against Binghamton.

SADDLING UP THE PONIES

Entering this week, the Binghamton Rumble Ponies own the best record in the Northeast Division at 18-13. Before their loss on Sunday, they had won a league-best eight in a row. The Rumble Ponies pitching has been a strong suit with the fourth-best ERA in the league (3.76). Eight of the Mets' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- OF/1B **Ryan Clifford** (No. 4), C **Kevin Parada** (No. 9), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (No. 10), RHP **Brandon Sproat** (RHP), OF **Alex Ramirez** (OF), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (No. 18), RHP **Joander Suarez** (RHP), and OF **Rhylan Thomas** (No. 30).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP **Tyler Stuart** makes his seventh start of the season for the Rumble Ponies. The 24-year-old in his most recent start at Portland on May 12 went five innings, gave up two runs on four hits with two walks and struck out three in a no decision. Stuart has thrown five or more innings in four of his six starts this season. This is his second season with the Rumble Ponies after debuting last July. Between High-A Brooklyn and Double-A Binghamton, the Mets 6th rounder in 2022 threw 110.2 innings with 112 strikeouts over just 32 walks.

2023: Named to Bowie Opening Day roster and was named Opening Night starter. **Just 2 ER allowed over 9.2 IP in last two starts. Collected first Double-A win on 5/7 vs AKR after dealing 5.0 IP with 6 K, matching season-high. Owns a 5.00 ERA in two road starts. Has struck out 5+ batters in four of seven starts.**

2023: Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. .163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

2022: Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings, soon finding himself on the injured list for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season. Allowed one run in 2.1 innings of postseason action for Aberdeen.

2021: Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

Personal: Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing seventh in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach
