PAPILLION, NEB. – The Omaha Storm Chasers got within striking distance but after falling behind early, could not pull ahead and lost to the Indianapolis Indians on Wednesday afternoon, 7-4.

- Indianapolis jumped out early, as the Indians scored a run in the 1st inning and four in the 2nd off Omaha starter **Zach Davies** for an early 5-0 lead ... Davies, making his Omaha debut, settled down after the 2nd with a scoreless 3rd inning but did not return to the mound after the third and was charged with the loss ... He walked 2 and allowed 5 hits, surrendering 5 runs (4 earned).
- Indy starter **Paul Skenes** had Omaha's hitters off balance for much of the day, as he struck out 7 over 4.2 innings of work ... The Storm Chasers, however, became the first team to score a run off of him this season, as **CJ Alexander** tripled with one out in the bottom of the second and scored on a single from **Nate Eaton** ... Another run crossed the plate for Omaha in the fourth inning, as **Nick Loftin** scored on a throwing error from Skenes.
- Behind Davies, **Jonah Dipoto** and **John McMillon** each offered 2.0 innings of relief ... both righties allowed a single run, as Indianapolis was able to counter both of the runs the Chasers scored off Skenes and maintain a five-run lead, 7-2, through the first seven innings.
- The Storm Chasers made some noise in the bottom of the 8th inning, as Alexander doubled, then Eaton and **Brian O'Keefe** offered back-to-back run-scoring singles that brought the tying run into the on-deck circle for Omaha, however that was the closest the Chasers got to coming back.
- Not only did Omaha bring the score closer in the 8th inning, but the game settled down on the mound for the Chasers over the final two innings, as former Indian **Colin Selby** retired his old teammates in order in the top of the 8th inning, then **Evan Sisk** struck out the side in the top of the 9th inning. McMillon, Selby and Sisk combined to retire the final 7 Indy hitters and 10 of the last 11.
- The only two runs batted in during the contest were credited to Eaton, while Alexander finished a home run shy of the cycle, his third 3-hit game of the season.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen remains one of the best in the International League and even across the entire Triple-A level.

- Omaha's 3.87 ERA (47 ER in 109.1 IP) ranks 4th out of the 20-team International League and 5th among the 30 Triple-A teams ... The Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a .199 average (79-for-396), which is the 3rd-best mark among Triple-A teams ... a .657 OPS against the relievers also ranks 3rd.
- 6 times this season, Omaha's bullpen has combined to shut out the opponent behind the starting pitcher, including 5 times of 4.0 innings or more, with a season-high of 6.0 scoreless innings, on March 29 (Opening Day) vs. Iowa).
- Reliever **Will Klein** was called up today by the Royals for his MLB debut, he opened this year with 11.0 innings without allowing an earned run.
- Walter Pennington** leads the bullpen with a 5.0-inning scoreless streak currently.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

- Omaha has outscored its opponents 135 to 110 this season, a +25 run differential.
- A +25 run differential ranks as the 2nd-best in the International League and 5th in Triple-A ... Iowa (CHC) ranks ahead of Omaha in the IL at +29 while Tacoma (SEA) leads the Triple-A level with a +39 run differential.
- Omaha actually ranks 3rd of the 4 Minor League affiliates in the Royals organization, behind Single-A Columbia at +43 and High-A Quad Cities at +26.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT

- Infielder **CJ Alexander** has been one of Omaha's top hitters early in the season, leading the team in many categories.
- Alexander is tied for the International League with 24 batted balls over 100mph or greater, 2nd-most in Triple-A... the next-closest Storm Chaser is **Drew Waters** with 14 100MPH batted balls.
- He leads Omaha in homers (5), hits (23), doubles (7), extra-base hits (13), total bases (47), runs scored (18), ... he also leads qualified Chasers hitters in slugging percentage (.603) and OPS (.940) ... he is tied for 6th in the league in extra-base hits.

PUSHING PORTER

Storm Chasers catcher **Logan Porter** will not show up as a qualifier for the league leaders in the average-based categories, with not enough plate appearances to qualify, but he's been one of Omaha's best hitters this year.

- Porter has the Storm Chasers' longest active hitting streak entering play today, he has hit safely in his last 9 games, the 4th-longest streak in the league ... since April 4, he is batting .429 (15-for-35), with 9 extra-base hits and a 1.467 OPS in that span.
- He is also Omaha's best hitter against left-handed pitching, with a .692 average (9-for-13) against lefties, with 4 extra-base hits, 5 runs batted in and 3 walks for a .750 on-base percentage.
- The catcher has also seen some success catching runners stealing this season, with 8 runners caught stealing in 27 tries (29.63%), tied for the MiLB lead in CS with 8.

TODAY'S START

- Cessa is making his **5th appearance** and **4th start** of the season after opening the year on Omaha's Opening Day roster ... he spent a week on the Development List (April 5 to 11), but has made 2 starts since.
- The Royals in 2024 mark Cessa's 7th MLB organization ... was with the Mets for the first 8 seasons (2008-15) of his professional career before being traded to the Detroit Tigers midseason in 2015 and dealt to the New York Yankees later that offseason ... joined the Cincinnati Reds in a trade in 2021 and pitched for them through 2023 ... pitched for Washington and Colorado's Triple-A affiliates in 2023 ... Cessa has made five MLB Opening Day rosters: 2016, 2019 & 2021 with the Yankees and 2022-23 with the Reds.

LAST OUTING: THURSDAY, APRIL 18 @ NASHVILLE

Had his best start to a game this season, retiring his first 7 batters of the game, including 1-2-3 innings in the 1st and 2nd ... a one-out single in the third inning was erased on a double play ... a leadoff triple in the fourth was followed by an RBI single and Cessa was removed in favor of **Anthony Veneziano**, who allowed the inherited runner to score.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 6 Cactus League games out of the bullpen for the Royals and went 0-0 with a 4.60 ERA (4 ER in 7.2 IP), with 5 strikeouts ... held opponents to a .179 average (5-for-28).

CAREER NOTES

- Was on the 2023 World Baseball Classic roster for Team Mexico and pitched 2.0 innings of relief on March 11 vs. Columbia ... returned to spring training with Cincinnati after only pitching the one game, to prepare for the MLB regular season in the Reds rotation.
- In his third season with Cincinnati, opened the regular season with the Reds and made 7 appearances (6 starts) before he was designated for assignment on May 9 and released May 14 ... did not appear in an MLB game the rest of the year.
- Signed a Minor League contract with Colorado on May 23 and made 6 starts for the Albuquerque Isotopes (AAA) before getting released on June 29 ... signed a Minor League contract with Washington on July 6 and pitched in 16 games (1 start) for the Rochester Red Wings (AAA), before the Nationals released him on August 29.

MLB CAREER

- Spent parts of 6 seasons with the Yankees (2016-21), going 10-13 with a 4.19 ERA (136 ER in 292.0 IP) in 131 games (19 starts, from 2016-18) ... had his best year in 2021, with a 2.51 ERA (18 ER in 64.2 IP) between the Yankees and Reds and set career highs in appearances (53) and wins (5).
- After 3 full years as a reliever, wound up in Cincinnati's starting rotation after the 2022 Trade Deadline ... RHP **Luis Castillo** and RHP **Tyler Mahle** were traded ... several other Reds starters suffered injuries ... made his 200th career MLB appearance on September 28, 2022 at Pittsburgh.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER
