LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped its first game of the series to the Emperors on Thursday night, 5-2...RHP Jonah Tong failed to make it through two full innings due to pitch count, as he was tagged with his third High-A loss of the season...C Christian Pregent was the 'Clones biggest bright spot offensively...The former Stetson Hatter collected a career-high three hits, including his first home run of the season - a solo shot off LHP Mitch Farris in the fourth inning...The home run was Pregent's first since the second game of his career on August 2, 2023, with Single-A St. Lucie...3B D'Andre Smith also registered his first hit since being reinstated off the injured list, collecting an RBI single in the bottom of the first...Opponents have scored first in all six games of Brooklyn's current homestand

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY: On July 26, 2002, SS Corey Ragsdale set a franchise single-game record with four stolen bases vs. Staten Island...That single-game mark still stands...In 2003, C Tony Piazza led off the bottom of the ninth inning with a walk-off solo home run in a 3-2 win vs. Williamsport...It is the second walk-off home run in franchise history...In 2013, RHPs Robert Gsellman (70 IP) and Ricky Knapp (2.0) combined on a three-hit shutout in a 2-0 win at Staten Island...In 2016, the Cyclones swept a doubleheader vs. Staten Island, taking Game 1, 2-1, on a go-ahead SS Colby Woodmansee double in the bottom of the sixth and Game 2, 3-2, courtesy of a IB Pete Alonso walk-off sacrifice fly in the bottom of the eighth...In 2023, RHPs Blade Tidwell (5.0 IP), Jace Beck (1.0), Brendan Hardy (1.0), and Dylan Hall (1.0), and LHP Eli Ankeney (1.0) united on a three-hitter in a 3-0 win vs. Wilmington.

TALK 2 'EM: RHP Kade Morris has started to find his stride at the High-A level... Despite being tagged with the loss on Saturday against Jersey Shore, Morris still holds a minuscule 1.63 ERA over his last five starts dating back to June 21 vs. Jersey Shore... Morris' record during that five-game span (four starts) sits at 2-2...He has yielded just 21 hits and 10 walks while striking out 29...Since June 20, Morris and RHP Jonah Tong have been two of the best arms in the South Atlantic League...In that span, Morris is sixth in the circuit in ERA (1.63) and Tong is eighth (2.30)...Additionally, Kade is seventh in Innings pitched (27.2), eighth in batting average against (.204), and 10th in WHIP (1.12)... Since making his SAL debut on May 22, Morris is tied for sixth in the league in innings pitched (51.1), eighth in batting average against (.231), and ninth in ERA (3.33) and WHIP (1.25).

FLARE FOR THE DRAMATIC: Brooklyn's 2-1 walk-off win on Wednesday afternoon marked the second time in the last five games that the Cyclones won via a walk-off single...On Friday vs. Jersey Shore, Chris Suero provided the game-winning RBI single with the bases loaded in the bottom of the 10th in a 6-5...Nick Lorusso delivered the first walk-off win of the year, clubbing a game-ending solo home run in the bottom of the ninth in a 4-3 win vs. Asheville on April 14...On the flip side, Brooklyn has suffered seven walk-off defeats this season, most recently a 3-2 loss at Wilmington on July 12... Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 17 walk-off losses, accumulating 14.78% of all defeats, including 26.15% of all road losses, while earning 10 walk-off wins...27 of Brooklyn's 224 games since the start of the 2023 season have ended in a walk-off (12.05%)...The Cyclones have also earned 21 wins in their last at-bat during that time.

MORABITO BITE: OF Nick Morabito has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The 21-year-old notched the go-ahead RBI single on Tuesday, in addition to scoring from second base on a sacrifice fly for an insurance run...The McLean, Va. native is tied for 10th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (41)...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito has led the league in hits (67), is tied for second in stolen bases (30), and tied for sixth in runs scored (41)...The former second-round selection is seventh in the SAL in stolen bases (30) and ninth in batting average (.277) on the season...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.306), stolen bases (41) and on-base percentage (.406)...He is also second in hits (98) and runs scored (55), and tied for fifth in triples (3).

PAZ DISPENSER: Despite being placed on the injured list as of Thursday, OF Karell Paz is in the midst of one of his best offensive stretches of the 2024 season...Since clubbing a go-ahead two-run home run in the ninth inning on June 30 at Aberdeen, the 24-year-old is hitting .327/.426/.538 with a .964 OPS in 17 games...Paz has scored eight runs and picked up four doubles, two triples, a home run, six runs batted in, eight walks, and seven stolen bases...Since that date, Paz is sixth in the SAL in on-base percentage (.426) eighth in batting average (.327), and tied for eighth in stellan bases...(7) (.426), eighth in batting average (.327), and tied for eighth in stolen bases (7).

**GRAB A PINT-ARO:** RHP **Jonathan Pintaro** has been on a tear over the past month or so...The Pelham, Ala. native surrendered only one unearned run over 4.2 frames of work in Tuesday's win over Rome...The 26-year-old has not surrendered an earned run since June 25 at Aberdeen...Over his four July outings, the veteran has a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 14.0 IP), with eight hits, two hit batters, five walks, and 15 strikeouts...Pintaro is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in ERA (0.00) and is fifth in batting average against

vs. ROME: Brooklyn continues a nine-game homestand with six contests against the Braves' High-A affiliate...The Emperors have six of Atlanta's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP Cade Kuehler (7), RHP Jhancarlos Lara (12), INF Sabin Ceballos (17), and RHP Blake Burkhalter (26)...RHP Owen Murphy (4) and INF Ambioris Tavarez (20) are on the injured list...This marks Rome's first trip to Coney Island and the second series ever between the two franchises...Brooklyn and Rome split a six-game series at AdventHealth Stadium from May 7-12.

(160) and tied for eighth in WHIP (0.93) during the month...As a starter, Pintaro sports a 2.96 ERA across six games, while giving up only one earned run over two relief appearances...Unfortunately, Shorter University has not received a lot of run support...The 'Clones have mustered only four runs with Pintaro on the bump across his six starts this season.

TAKING KELLUM 123: OF Kellum Clark snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game on July 6 at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since... The 23-year-old had a four-game multi-hit streak snapped last Saturday but has five multi-hit efforts in his last ten games...Since July 6, he is 13-for-38 (.342) with four runs scored, a double, two RBI, and three walks...Clark had just one multi-hit game in the first 48 contests.

OMAR-I-GONE: OF Omar De Los Santos rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...Since powering a 421-foot home run on July 13 at Wilmington, the 24-year-old has homered three times in his last six games, going 6-for-21 (.286) at the plate with six runs scored, a double, and five runs batted in...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still fourth in the South Atlantic League with 33 stolen bases... The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT Jaylen Palmer's (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (70) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos has led the South Atlantic League (70) and is fourth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (142). in swiped bags (142).

**SHUT IT:** Brooklyn has been no stranger to tossing shutouts lately...The Cyclones tied a franchise record with its 11th shutout win of the season on July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington...The 11 shutout performances match the 2023 mark for the single-season record... The 11 shutouts are two behind Rome (13) for the most in the South Atlantic League... The Cyclones are also tied for fifth in all of Minor League Baseball in shutouts...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively.

LOCATION, LOCATION: The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024...OF **Nick Morabito** loves his time on the road...He is hitting .302/.385/.396 with a .781 OPS, adding two home runs, nine RBI, and 25 stolen bases in 36 road contests...He is fourth in the circuit in road batting average (.302) and, since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old has had the most road hits (.45) and stolen bases (.25) in the circuit...In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .237/.324/.269 line with a .593 OPS, three extra-base hits, three RBI, and five stolen bases over 23 games...INF **Junior Tilien** has thrived at Maimonides Park, posting a .288/.351/.409 mark with a .760 OPS, three home runs, and 14 RBI in 37 games...On the road, Tilien is hitting .171/.272/.243 with a .515 OPS, a home run, and nine runs batted in over 38 contests...C **Chris Suero** is hitting .261/.388/.420 with a .808 OPS, three home runs, and 16 RBI in 20 games on Coney Island... The 20-year-old is batting .170/.284/.250 with a .534 OPS, a home run, and 16 RBI in 33 affairs in visiting ballparks. affairs in visiting ballparks.

THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Even after suffering a loss on Thursday, the 21-year-old is 2-2 with a 2.30 ERA (7 ER in 27.1 IP), allowing only 18 hits and nine walks, while striking out 40 over his last six starts since June 20...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native leads the circuit in strikeouts (78)...He is also fifth in batting average against (.212), sixth in ERA (3.36), eighth in WHIP (1.25), and tied for 10th in innings pitched (59.0)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 70.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.07), third in strikeout rate (35.4%), sixth in strikeout-to-walk rate (25.8%) and tied for seventh in strikeouts (114).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to Baseball America and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: INF Jesús Báez (9), RHP Jonah Tong (15), RHP Kade Morris (23), RHP Jack Wenninger (26), and Calvin Ziegler (29)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season injured list...Plus six of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (19), Báez (21), Ziegler (22), Wilfredo Lara (23), OF Nick Morabito (25), and Morris (26).

AST TIME OUT: Suffered his third defeat with Brooklyn and sixth of the season last Saturday night vs. Jersey Shore...Surrendered three unearned runs on six hits over 3.1 innings...Did not issue a walk and punched out eight...Tossed 72 pitches and 51 strikes (70.83%)...Relieved by LHP Ryan Ammons with runners at first and third and one out in the top of the fourth and Brooklyn trailing 3-0...Both bequeathed runners were stranded... The Cyclones made it a one-run game with two in the fifth, but the BlueClaws added one in the seventh, two in the eighth, and one more in the ninth in a 7-2 defeat.

TALK 2 'EM: Morris has started to find his stride at the High-A level...Since his start on June 21 vs. Jersey Shore, the 22-year-old holds a 2-2 record with a sparkling 1.63 ERA (5 ER in 27.2 IP)...He has yielded 21 hits and 10 walks (8.55%) while striking out 29 (24.79 K%)...Since June 20, Morris has been one of the best arms in the South Atlantic League...In that span, he sixth in the circuit in ERA (1.63), seventh in innings pitched (27.2), eighth in batting average against (.204), and 10th in WHIP (1.12)... Since making his SAL debut on May 22, Morris is tied for sixth in the league in innings pitched (51.1), eighth in batting average against (.231), and ninth in ERA (3.33) and WHIP (1.25).

**PROSPECT RADAR:** Morris is considered the New York Mets' No. 23 prospect according to Baseball America... He is deemed the organization's No. 26 farmhand per MLB Pipeline.

**2024:** Joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on May 20...Made seven appearances (six starts) in the Florida State League...Posted an 0-3 record with a 3.63 ERA (14 ER in 34.2 IP), 11 walks, and 38 strikeouts...Struck out a career-high nine over five innings in a loss at Bradenton on May 9...Tallied a career-best 7.0-shutout innings of work in his final start on May 15 at Palm Beach... Punched out 27 (28.13 K%) and walked five (5.21 BB%) in his final 22.0 innings in the circuit.

**2023:** Signed with the Mets as a third-round selection on July 15 for \$666,500... Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 17...
