#### ZAVALA HOMERS IN LOSS TO WICHITA:

The Frisco RoughRiders notched a 4-2 win over the San Antonio Missions on Tuesday night from Riders Field. San Antonio (12-16, 51-46) struck first in the top of the first when Devin Ortiz led off with a solo home run, taking a 1-0 lead. Frisco (10-18, 48-48) then answered in the bottom of the fourth when **Keyber Rodriguez** hit a sacrifice fly and **Cam Cauley** served an RBI single to pull ahead 2-1. In the bottom of the seventh, Rodriguez added an RBI single to expand the RoughRiders lead to 3-1. The Missions then answered when Moisés Gómez smashed an RBI double, before Frisco reliever **Gavin Collyer** induced an inning-ending fly out to preserve a 3-2 lead. **Abimelec Ortiz** then provided insurance in the bottom of the eighth when he snuck a solo home run over the left field fence, stretching the Riders lead to 4-2. In the top of the ninth, Frisco reliever **Gerardo Carrillo** pitched a shutout frame to nail down his third save of the season. After allowing the leadoff homer, Riders starter **Mitch Bratt** (6-3) retired 14 of his last 20 batters and pitched 5.2 frames to earn the victory. Missions reliever Jared Kollar (0-5) took the loss, yielding three runs over four innings.

After a tough month in June on offense, hitting .218/.308/.306/.614 with a league-worst 3.4 runs per game and just 13 homers (tied for second-fewest in the league), the Riders have been better in July. The Riders are tied for sixth in batting average (.237), fourth in slugging (.362), seventh in OPS (.664), third in home runs (20) and fifth in runs per game (4.5). The Riders are also 28-for-34 in steals during the month.

Abimelec Oritz has been on fire at the plate in July. In the month, he is hitting .312/.372/.597/.969 over 19 games with seven doubles, five home runs, 11 RBIs and seven walks. In his last 10 games, he is batting .425 (17-for-40)/.442/.800/1.242 with six doubles, three home runs and seven RBIs.

#### WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

Aaron Zavala walked twice on July 18th, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilder Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

#### **HOLD ME CLOSE AND DON'T LET GO:**

In their last 15 games, the RoughRiders have had the lead or a tie game in the eighth inning in 12 of the 15 games, but they are 6-9. The Riders have blown six saves during that span. Their bullpen ERA of 4.95 in July is last in all of Double-A and while they have allowed 50 earned runs, they have also surrendered 12 unearned runs.

#### K-ROD ON FIRE:

Keyber Rodriguez has been swinging a hot bat for the Riders recently. Since June 15th, in his last 27 games, he is hitting .337 (33-for-98)/.411/.408/.819 with seven doubles, seven RBIs, 12 walks, 12 runs scored and just 16 strikeouts. In July, he is batting .306 (19-for-62) over 17 games.

#### **CAULEY! CAULEY, CAULEY ANYTIME:**

Cam Cauley has been incredible for the RoughRiders lately on offense. In his last 64 games since May 7th, he is batting .275/.333/.457/.790 with 17 doubles, eight home runs, 26 RBIs and 15 stolen bases. In his last 28 games, he is slashing .297/.339/.500/.839 with seven doubles, five home runs, 15 RBIs, 20 runs scored and eight steals.

The RoughRiders have now stolen at least one base in 24 of their last 29 games. Over those 29 games, they have stolen 46 total bases, which is tied for second in the league. **Sebastian Walcott** is first in the league with 12 steals in that span while **Cam Cauley** is seventh with eight. Overall this season, the Riders are fourth in the league with 114 stolen bases.

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239, but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.2 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.6 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 35 steals over 124 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively. Over an 14-game on-base streak, he is hitting .278 (15-for-54)/.361/.500/.861 with one double, one triple, three home runs and
