BIG GAME CADE: Somerset's four-game win streak started in game two of Friday's doubleheader, when Cade Smith showed 6.0 scoreless innings on just one hit and one walk, while stockpiling seven strikeouts. The performance earned Smith his first career MiLB Pitcher of the Week honors in what was his second shutout started this season. It's the 15th time in Somerset franchise history that a Patriots starter has won Pitcher of the Week honors, and the second time this season (Xavier Rivas 6/22). Over Smith's last two outings, he's posted a 0.69 ERA, 2-0 record, 0.38 WHIP, .075 BAA with 13 K to 2 BB and 3 H in 13.0 IP.

CARDIAC PATS: The Somerset Patriots enter today on a four-game win streak. In the last three of those wins, they've taken the decisive lead with a 4+ run inning in the 10th, 9th and 11th innings, respectively. The stretch started Saturday with the Patriots taking leads in the 7th and 10th innings to win 9-5 behind a four-run 10th inning. It continued on Sunday, when Somerset trailed 4-0 and 6-4, prior to taking a 9-6 lead in the ninth inning, when they scored five runs. In the series opener on Tuesday, the Patriots began the bottom of the 11th inning trailing 9-5, before scoring five runs in the frame to capture their fourth straight win. The Patriots have scored the decisive run in the 7th inning or later in seven of their 12 August wins, including in four of their last five wins. Since 8/19, Somerset is batting .410 with a 1.116 OPS and 32 runs (5.3 R/G) scored in the seventh inning or later.

COMEBACK KIDS: In six of Somerset's last seven games, their opponent has scored first, with the Patriots winning four of those six games. Dating back to 7/29, over the Patriots' last 25 games, they have scored first just five times (record of 11-9 when opponent has scored first in 20 games during stretch). The Patriots are 36-15 when they score first this year vs. 29-41 when they don't score first.

DRIVE FOR FIVE: As the Somerset Patriots seek their fifth straight win (and their fifth straight playoff berth), they have posted a five-run inning in each of their last three games. Dating back to Wednesday 8/19 @HFD, Somerset has notched four 5+ run frames (all in the seventh inning or later) to push its total to 22 this season, tied with Akron for the most in the Eastern League.

BRIDGEWATER BOMBERS: After Tuesday's three-homer effort, Somerset has registered 3+ homers in 30 games this season and multiple homers in 51 of 121 games this season. Somerset's 51 multi-HR games are the most since the Patriots' franchise-record 55 multi-HR games in 2023. The Patriots' 170 homers this season rank second in Double-A and 11th among 120 MiLB teams.

WINNING CORE: Since Core Jackson's promotion to Double-A, the Patriots have gone 7-0 with him in the lineup. Jackson has collected either an RBI or a run scored in all seven games he's played, while slashing .292/.419/.417 (.836 OPS) with 5 RBI, 6 R, 6 BB and 5 SB, Alongside Rory Fox, Connor McGinnis, Ben Grable and Jack Gebert, Jackson is the fifth member of the Yankees' 2025 MiLB Draft class to make his Double-A debut this year.

JUMPING FOR JACE: Jace Avina used three pivotal RBIs on Tuesday to cap Somerset's four-run come-from-behind win in extra innings. The three RBIs tied Avina's season-high for the third time this season and the first time since 7/9 vs. REA. Avina has now driven in runs in three straight games for the first time since 5/6-5/8 @REA. Avina's 5 RBI over his last three games are equal his 5 RBI total from the prior 23 games dating from 7/24-8/21.

MAMBA MENTALITY: Coby Morales extended his team-high and career-high on-base streak to 19 games with a single in the 11th inning on Tuesday. During the on-base streak which dates to 7/31, he's slashing .313/.452/.478 with 2 HR, 5 RBI and 5 XBH.

20/20 VISION: This season, Coby Morales has accomplished his first career 20/20 season, becoming the second Somerset batter in franchise history to accomplish the feat, joining Oswaldo Cabrera (24/20) in 2021. DJ Gladney enters the day three stolen bases away from a 20/20 season, while Jace Avina is one home run and six stolen bases away from the feat.

MR. DJ SONG PON DE REPLAY: DJ Gladney secured his 27th multi-hit game of the season on Tuesday, using his career-high 23rd home run of the season. Over Gladney's last 23 games since 7/19, he is slashing .349/.385/.698 (1.083 OPS) with 8 HR, 31 RBI, 19 R and 7 BB.

GO DJ, THAT'S MY DJ: DJ Gladney clubbed his career-high and team-high 23rd home run of the season in the 11th inning on Tuesday. Of his 23 home runs, Gladney has hit 11 go-ahead home runs that clinch five in the seventh inning or later. Gladney's 23 home runs rank fourth on Somerset's all-time single-season list (Dermis Garcia, 31 in 2021, Oswaldo Cabrera, 24 in 2021 and Tyler Hardman, 26 in 2023).

MOYLAN'S MASHING: Josh Moylan clubbed his career-high 23rd home run of the season on Tuesday, tying DJ Gladney for the 3rd-most home runs in the Yankees minor league system. Moylan's 23 home runs in 105 games this season succeeded 17 career home runs in his first 239 career games spanning three seasons from 2023-25. Moylan extended his hit streak to four games and on-base streak to six games. Across his last four games he's 5-for-16 with 2 HR and 5 RBI.

HANDY MANNY: Manny Palencia enters today on a six-game hit streak, during which he's 8-for-21 (.381/.417/.619) with 1 HR, 8 RBI, 3 XBH and two multi-hit games. Palencia has reached safely in 14 of his last 15 games. During that stretch, he's slashing .382/.407/.727 with 5 HR, 16 RBI and 9 XBH. Since the beginning of July, Palencia has 11 multi-hit games and is slashing .374/.400/.596 with 5 HR, 19 RBI and 12 XBH in that span. Palencia's .374 AVG leads all Double-A catchers with 105+ plate appearances in that stretch, while tying for second among all Double-A batters.

BULLPEN BUSINESS: Over Tony Rossi's last 15 appearances, he has posted a 1.33 ERA, 4-0 record, 0.74 WHIP and 130 BAA with 23 K with 6 BB in 20.1 IP. Over Kelly Austin's last 10 appearances, he's pitched to a 0.56 ERA, 0.69 WHIP and .094 BAA with 16 K in 16.0 IP. Over Kevin Stevens' last nine appearances, he's posted a 0.96 ERA, 0.54 WHIP and .121 BAA with 15 K to 1 BB in 9.1 IP. Over Geoff Gilbert's last six appearances, he has registered a 0.87 ERA, 0.77 WHIP and .094 BAA with 16 K to 5 BB in 10.1 IP.

2026 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

JAMES COOPER: Manager (1st year)

James Cooper enters his first season as manager of the Somerset Patriots, his fifth overall year in the Yankees organization and his fourth consecutive as a minor league manager. He spent the 2025 season as the manager of the High-A Hudson Valley Renegades, after serving as manager of the Single-A Tampa Tarpons in 2024 and beginning his minor league managerial career with the FCL Yankees in 2023. Under Cooper's leadership in 2025, Hudson Valley finished with a franchise-record 79 wins (79-50), being eliminated from playoff contention on the final day of the regular season. During the season, the Renegades finished second in AVG (.235), H (970), OBP (.336), SLG (.363), OPS (.699), third in R (598) and HR (547). In 2024 at the helm for Tampa, the Tarpons led the FSL in SB, while ranking second in AVG, H and 2B, and fourth in OPS. During Cooper's first assignment with the Yankees organization in 2022, he served as defensive coach for the FCL Yankees, where he helped the team with the 2022 FCL Championship. The following season, Cooper made his managerial debut with the FCL Yankees and was named the Florida Complex League Manager of the Year in 2023, when his team led the FCL in runs, hits, triples, RBIs, AVG, OBP, SLG and OPS.

MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (2nd year)

Mike Fransoso enters his second season as a coach in Somerset and within the Yankees organization. Under Fransoso's leadership during the 2025 season, the Patriots' offense ranked among the Eastern League leaders with 129 HR (2nd), a .691 OPS (4th) and 600 R (5th). Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots (2018-2019) during the team's run as an independent team and also the Pittsburgh Pirates organization (2013-2015). He previously coached in the Seattle Mariners organization (2021-2024), serving as the hitting coach and interim manager for the Double-A Arkansas Travelers in 2024, when he helped manage the team to a Southern League Championship.

DEMETRE KOKORIS: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Demetre Kokoris enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees. He served as the pitching coach in Hudson Valley in 2025 and guided the team to a league-best 2.82 ERA and 20 shutouts. Prior to joining the Yankees, Kokoris coached in the Texas Rangers (2022-2024) and Toronto Blue Jays (2019-2021) organizations. He spent the 2023 and 2024 seasons as the bullpen coach for the Triple-A Round Rock Express, and was the pitching coach for the Single-A Down East Wood Ducks in 2022. Prior to joining the Rangers, he was the pitching coach for the Short-Season Class-A Vancouver Canadians (2019-20) and was a rehab pitching coach (2021) with the Blue Jays. Before entering the professional coaching ranks, Kokoris was a college pitching coach at Chemeketa Community College, Point Loma Nazarene University, and Santa Barbara City College. He has also served as the pitching coach for the Greek National Team since 2021.

UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (2nd year)

Uziel Viloria enters his second consecutive season as a defensive coach in Somerset and his second season with the Yankees organization. Under his leadership in 2025, the Patriots posted a franchise record .983 fielding percentage. Viloria began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), reaching High-A Jersey Shore in 2022 and 2023.

CALEB HAMILTON: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Caleb Hamilton enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees organization. After a playing career that included MLB experience with the Minnesota Twins (2022) and Boston Red Sox (2023), Hamilton completed his first year in coaching as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley in 2025. During his final season playing in 2024, Hamilton saw time in 39 games for the Rocket City Trash Pandas, the Double-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels. He was drafted by Minnesota in the 23rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of Oregon State University, where he was an All-Pac-12 performer for the Beavers. Despite not catching in college, Hamilton made 323 of his 574 professional appearances as a catcher, and he played at least one game at all nine positions.

Began the season on the 7-day IL for High-A Hudson Valley. Commenced a minor league rehab assignment on 7/7. After three rehab games between the FCL Yankees and Single-A Tampa, he was reinstated off the IL by Hudson Valley on 7/24. Smith ended the season by making eight starts for the Renegades and he went 2-1 with a 2.76 ERA with 16 BB and 35 K in 32.2 IP with a .172 BAA and 1.10 WHIP. Following the season, Smith represented the Yankees at the Arizona Fall League, pitching for the Mesa Solar Sox. After pitching in four games of relief over which he went 1-0 with a 2.13 ERA, 2 BB and 14 K in 13.2 IP, Smith was named an AFL Rising Star, making him the lone Yankees farmhand to be named an All-Star. In the AFL All-Star Game, he earned a hold in an eventual 5-4 walk-off win for the AL Fall Stars with a perfect fourth inning on nine pitches (eight strikes).

College
Pitched three seasons at Mississippi State University (2021-23), going 8-6 with a 4.14 ERA and 132 K in 34 games (24 starts). As a freshman in 2021, Smith worked out of the bullpen and helped the Bulldogs win their first ever national title with three scoreless relief outings. As a junior in his final college season (2023), he served as the Bulldogs' Opening Day starter and the team's Friday night starter.
