TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue a nine-game road trip out of the All-Star break with a six-game set at Erie.

LAST TIME OUT: Po-Yu Chen tossed seven strong, but Erie rallied for a 5-4 win in ten innings.

THE CHEN CHRONICLES: Righty Po-Yu Chen overcame a difficult month of April (7.93 ERA) and hit his stride as of late. Chen has allowed one run or fewer 7 times in his last 11 outings, and since May 25 he has recorded a 2.13 ERA (16 ER / 67.2 IP) with 55 strikeouts

THREE OUTS FOR THE PRICE OF ONE PITCH: For the third time in Altoona's franchise history, first since 2010 by Chase d'Arnaud, the Curve turned a triple play on Wednesday, July 24 at Erie. With runners on first and second after a walk by **Emmanuel Chapman** and an error com-mitted by **Charles McAdoo**, Erie's Julio Rodriguez hit a hard ground ball to third where McAdoo picked it up, touched third base and then threw to second where **Kervin Pichardo** made the quick turn for the triple play.

HE WILL McADOO: Infielder Charles McAdoo, one of the top hitters in the Pirates minor league system this year has solidified the middle of the order for the Curve since his promotion on June 22. McAdoo has reached base safely in 19-of-24 games since joining the Curve with 7 multi-hit games, batting .280/.362/.516/.878 with 5 2B, 1 3B, 5 HR, 10 RBI, 12 BB, and 24 K. He ranks 1st among PIT MiLB in H (101), 2B (20), RBI (62), T-3rd in SB (17), and 2nd in OPS (.947), min. 150 PA's in minor leagues.

THOMAS' ENGLISH MUFFINS: Righty Thomas Harrington is the third Curve pitcher this season to strike out at least 10 batters, doing so in back-to-back starts. Since June 16 (6 starts) Harrington has gone 2-1 with a 1.50 ERA (6 ER / 36.0 IP) and allowed a 0.83 WHIP with 41 strikeouts. Harrington has allowed 2 earned runs or fewer in 10-of-12 outings with Altoona this year and his 52 strikeouts since June 1 are T-3rd-most by an Eastern League pitcher.

The Curve are one of five teams in the affiliated minors and the only Double-A team to have three different pitchers (Harrington, **Bubba**Chandler and Braxton Ashcraft) strike out at least 11 batters in a game. The Curve are one of nine teams in the affiliated minors, one of two a

Double-A (Binghamton) to have at least six 10-K games this season. The six 10-strikeout games this season are the most in a single-season in franchise history (35 total in first 24 years of the franchise).

WHO LET US GET HOT?: Since June 6, the Curve are 22-15 in their last 36 games which includes two series in which they won five-of-six.

SOME NEW FACES: Coming out of the All-Star break, the Curve added two more key pieces from High-A Greensboro in INF/C Nick Cimillo and LHP Hunter Barco. Cimillo batted .293/.419/.619/1.038 OPS with 8 2B, 17 HR and 48 RBI in 52 games with the Grasshoppers this year. His 17 HR led the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion and ranked T-2nd with teammate Shaun Ross in all of High-A. Barco wen 4-1 with a 3.34 ERA in 16G/14 starts at High-A this season. In 62.0 IP, he allowed just 46 hits, 22 walks and struck out 77.

A BIG ADDITION: Utilityman Yoyner Fajardo reached base safely in 23 straight games from June 13-July 13, during which he batted .360/.446/.419 with 5 2B, 6 RBI, 13 BB, 10-11 SB. Since June 1, his .314 batting average is 6th in the Eastern League and his .414 on-base percentage ranks 4th in the circuit. Fajardo's on-base streak was the 3rd-longest by an Eastern League player this season.

QUITE A START: From June 21-July 11 (18 games) Altoona starters have been the backbone of the team's success. 9 times in the 18 game stretch, a Curve starter threw a quality start (6.0 IP+ and 3 ER or fewer) with 7 outings lasting 7.0 innings or longer. Altoona's 3.26 ERA since June 21 was 5th-best among Double-A teams. Curve starters went 8-5 with a 2.64 ERA (30 ER / 102.1 IP) allowing 70 hits, 28 walks (0.96 WHIP) and 97 strikeouts from June 21-July 11.

BUBBA'S BURGERS: Bubba Chandler has hit his stride since returning from the injured list on May 29. Chandler has walked just 7 batters in 44.0 IP with 50 strikeouts, recording a 4-3 record with a 2.45 ERA (12 ER / 44.0 IP) with a 0.80 WHIP, Since June 21, he ranks 2nd in the Eastern League in BAA (.121), 1st in WHIP (0.56), 4th in ERA (1.59) and 4th in strikeouts (33). Chandler is the 22nd player in franchise history to be selected to the MLB Futures Game which took place on July 13 at Globe Life Field, home of the Texas Rangers. Chandler tossed a scoreless seventh inning to finish off a win for the National League.

THE 'WOLVES OF THE SEA: Gabe Alvarez helms the SeaWolves for a third straight year, after leading them to an Eastern League Championship in 2023 where they defeated Somerset. Top Tigers prospects on their roster according to MLB Pipleline include: No. 1 RHP Jackson Jobe (IL), No. 10 RHP Troy Melton, No. 13 INF Hao-Yu Lee, No. 27 RHP Tyler Mattison and 0F No. 30 Trei Cruz.

THE FIRST HOWLER: Jackson Jobe, the No. 11 prospect in the minors accorind to MLB Pipeline, takes the ball for Erie today. Jobe missed time with a hamstring injury this season, but tossed the first 6.0 innings of a combined no-hitter in his last start at Binghamton. Jobe was picked 3rd overall in 2021 out of Heritage Hall HS in Oklahoma and was committed to be a 2-way player for Ole Miss in college when the Tigers drafted him and signed him to a \$6.9 million dollar bonus. Jobe is the son of Brandt Jobe who is currently a member of the PGA Champions tour after turning pro on the golf course in 1988. His best season on the links came in 1999 when he finished T-14th at The Masters and T-16th at the PGA Championship.
