SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

MULTI-HOME RUN MADNESS: When INF Freddy Zamora smashed his second home run on Friday night, it marked the second multi-home run game of his career, with the other coming on July 7, 2021 with the Carolina Mudcats against the Lynchburg Hillcats... Zamora's multi-homer night was the 33rd in franchise history (since 2015) and second in 2023... Along with OF Jackson Chourio's multi-home run night in the home opener, it marks the first time in franchise history two multi-home run games were tallied in April.

RUNNING DOWN A DREAM: On Friday night, the Shuckers stole a season-high five bases, led by INF Ethan Murray with three... The total was one shy of the single-game franchise record, set on June 28, 2015 at Jacksonville with six and tied three times... This year, the Shuckers have stolen 34 bases in 43 attempts, a 79% success rate... Their 34 stolen bases are the sixth-most in Double-A, and the second-most in the Southern League.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: With eight runs in Friday night's win, the Shuckers improved to 7-0 when scoring at least seven runs... They also improved to 8-1 when allowing three runs or less... The eight runs on Friday for the Shuckers were the most they've scored in a game this year against the M-Braves.

RUNS? HOW ABOUT NO?: The Shuckers pitching staff enters today with a 3.58 ERA, the second-best in the Southern League and the seventh-best in Double-A... Since last Saturday, when the Shuckers started a stretch that's seen them win five of their last seven, the staff has a 2.44 ERA and has allowed 19 runs... Over that span, they've struck out 78 batters, the third-highest total in Minor League Baseball.

#SHUCKANCER: Tonight's game is the annual Shuck Cancer Night at MGM Park... Players are wearing special Shuck Cancer jerseys designed by Julia Reyes, a local artist... The jerseys will be auctioned off during the game, with proceeds going to benefit the American Cancer Society.

CLOSING IN ON HISTORY: Shuckers manager Mike Guerrero enters today needing nine more wins to reach 1,400 in his managerial career... Guerrero is in his 24th season in Minor League Baseball in 2023 and his 23rd with the Brewers organization... He earned his 1,000th managerial win on July 14, 2016 in his first year with the Shuckers after spending two years on the Milwaukee Brewers coaching staff.

TODAY'S STARTER // LHP ADAM SEMINARIS (1-2, 8.78): LHP Adam Seminaris makes his fourth start after earning his first win last time out against Rocket City... In the Sunday match-up with Rocket City, Seminaris earned the win after allowing three runs over six innings... After allowing three runs over the first two innings, Seminaris retired 10 of the final 12 batters that he faced.
