### By the Numbers

**1,843** On Sunday, Lake County's 6-3 win over Fort Wayne marked its first road series sweep in 1,843 days, a 2-game series sweep also against Fort Wayne July 4 & 5, 2019.

**1.55** Since May 31, RHP Rorik Maltrud ranks 6<sup>th</sup> in Minor League Baseball and leads the Cleveland system with a 1.26 ERA. Captains RHP Carter Spivey is 10<sup>th</sup> with a 1.55 ERA during this span.

**473** Lake County leads the MWL and ranks 3<sup>rd</sup> in High-A with 473 runs (5.3 per game), its most runs through 90 games since the 2007 Captains scored 508 in this span.

### CAPTAINS LOG

**LAST TIME OUT:** Lake County entered the bottom of the 9<sup>th</sup> inning leading 3-2, but Great Lakes CF Jake Vogel hit a walk-off 2-run double to hand the Captains a 4-3 loss on Tuesday at Dow Diamond.

RHP Zane Morehouse (1-3) got the loss and his 2<sup>nd</sup> blown save of the season. Starter Trenton Denholm (ND) pitched 4.1 innings, allowing 2 runs and fanning 7.

**BE LIKE MAICK:** 1B Maick Collado went 2-for-4 with 2 RBI, hitting a game-tying RBI single in the top of the 4<sup>th</sup> and a go-ahead sacrifice fly in the top of the 8<sup>th</sup>. Collado has reached base in 9 of his last 11 games.

**SEEING GREENE:** DH Isaiah Greene hit a go-ahead RBI double in the top of the 4<sup>th</sup> to make it 2-1. 5 of his 9 hits are for extra bases, while slugging .474 in 12 games.

**HERE'S JOHNNY!** C Johnny Tincher was named Captain of the Week pres. by Official League, after hitting 2 homers against Lansing/Fort Wayne. On Saturday, Tincher hit his 1<sup>st</sup> grand slam of his Minor League career and Lake County's 5<sup>th</sup> of the season. After hitting just 1 home run in his first 36 games this year, Tincher has now homered in back-to-back contests dating back to June 14 versus Lansing.

**MOON LANDING:** 3B Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, posted 2 extra-base hits in the Lansing series. Mooney is 1 extra-base hit shy of becoming the 4<sup>th</sup> Captain in franchise history (2003-present) to record 30 XBH and 30 SB in a season.

**6/24-30 VS GREAT LAKES:** Lake County won 4 of 5 games in Eastlake, OH from June 24-30. The June 29 game was postponed due to rain and will be made up as a double-header on April 15. The Captains won the first 4 games by a margin of 27-9. Jorge Burgos batted a team-best .400 (6-for-15) with 2 HR and 5 RBI in the series.

**GENAO AND LATER:** INF Angel Genao, MLB Pipeline's No. 11 Cleveland prospect, has hit safely in 24 of his first 32 High-A games, and his 103 hits across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg are tied for 10<sup>th</sup> in MiLB. He is the only player in MiLB with a .320+ AVG, 35+ XBH, and 20+ SB this season.

**ONE OF THESE NIGHTS:** LCs 20 runs on July 5 versus Dayton were tied for the most in High-A this season, matched by Eugene's 20 at Tri-City on June 4. The Captains tallied 4 franchise records and tied a franchise-best with 12 runs in the bottom of the 7<sup>th</sup>.

**COOPER (NEVER) TIRES:** C Cooper Ingle, MLB Pipeline's No. 30 Cleveland prospect, leads the MWL in AVG (.329) and 2<sup>nd</sup> in OBP (.435). The last MWL player to win the batting title and OBP title in the same season was Cedar Rapids OF Mike Trout (.362/.454) in 2010.

**TONIGHT'S DEBUTEE:** OF Esteban González will make his Captains debut in LF on Wednesday after being promoted from Single-A Lynchburg on July 22. The 21-year-old from Maracaibo, Venezuela was a 2-time Carolina League Player of the Week, and is 1 of 5 Minor Leaguers with 75+ hits, 35+ stolen bases and 25+ extra-base hits this season.

**STRAIGHT NO CHASER:** Per FanGraphs, the Captains have 4 of the Midwest League's 15 lowest swinging strike percentages. C Cooper Ingle (5.2%) ranks 3<sup>rd</sup>, OF Jonah Advincula (6.8%) is tied for 5<sup>th</sup>, OF Guy Lipscomb (7.3%) is 9<sup>th</sup>, and INF Maick Collado (8.0%) is tied for 13<sup>th</sup>.

**BASE BANDITS:** The Captains have stolen 155 bases through their first 90 games, 2<sup>nd</sup>-most in franchise history and 12 shy breaking a new franchise record. Lake County leads MiLB with an 88.1% stolen base percentage.

**NAVAL POWER:** LHP Matt Wilkinson ranks tied for 1<sup>st</sup> in MiLB with 129 strikeouts this season. Wilkinson (T-1<sup>st</sup>, 129) and former Captains Paker Messick (T-4<sup>th</sup>, 114) and Austin Peterson (T-4<sup>th</sup>, 114) all rank top 5 in MiLB in strikeouts.

**THE ATLANTIC CAMPAIGN:** Since 2021, 13 of Cleveland's draft picks have come from the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC), including 6 in the 2023 MLB Draft and 2 in the 2024 Draft. Of those 13 ACC draftees, 5 have played for the Captains this year (LHP Parker Messick, OF Angel Zarate, 1B/LF C.J. Kayfus, C Cooper Ingle, and INF Alex Mooney), with 5 total '23 draftees being current Top 30 Cleveland prospects by MLB Pipeline.

**PROSPECTING:** Cleveland has experienced a gold rush of prospects, with 5 current Lake County Captains and 6 2023 draftees listed among Cleveland's Top 30 prospects by MLB Pipeline. The latest is C Cooper Ingle, who is MLB Pipeline's No. 30 Cleveland prospect, replacing 2021 Captain and current Triple-A Columbus Clippers SS José Tena, who graduated from prospect status on June 30.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** The Captains have won 4 of their last 5 road games, and are 25-16 on the road this season. Their .581 road win percentage is the 4<sup>th</sup>-highest in High-A. C Cooper Ingle leads the Midwest League with a .340 AVG on the road, and ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> with a .993 road OPS. RHP Trenton Denholm is tied for 3<sup>rd</sup> in the MWL with a 1.10 road WHIP.

LAST TIME OUT: In his 4th High-A start on July 19 at Fort Wayne, Rorik Maltrud (3-0) earned his 3rd High-A win. Maltrud pitched 5 innings, allowing 2 runs on 6 hits, fanning a High-A best 6 and walking 1 in the 3-2 victory.

SINCE MAY 31: In 8 starts since May 31 between Single-A Lynchburg and Lake County, Maltrud ranks 6th in Minor League Baseball and leads the Cleveland system with a 1.26 ERA. Captains RHP Carter Spivey is 10th with a 1.55 ERA.

FINAL SINGLE-A START: In his final start with Single-A Lynchburg on June 19 at Charleston, Maltrud (ND) pitched 6 no-hit innings, striking out 4 and walking 3 in the eventual 8-5 win. He retired each of his final 9 batters faced. Maltrud, fellow current Captain Matt Wilkinson (4/25/2024), and current Cleveland RHP Eli Morgan (6/21/2018) are the only Hillcats since 2018 to pitch 6 no-hit innings in a start.

SIGNING DAY: On January 9, 2024, Maltrud was 1 of 2 prospects signed to a Minor League contract by the Cleveland Guardians. Fellow current Captain and Saturday's starting pitcher Carter Spivey was Cleveland's other signee that day.

CAMPUS TOUR: Maltrud made 59 college appearances at Grayson College (JUCO, Denison, TX) from 2019-20, New Mexico State from 2021-22, and Missouri in 2023. He was committed to Oklahoma out of high school, but transferred to Grayson in the spring of 2019.

EYE OF THE TIGER: Maltrud made 20 appearances and 6 starts at Missouri in 2023, his final season of college baseball. He went 1-2 with a 5.73 ERA, 65 strikeouts and 17 walks in 48.2 innings. Maltrud earned his 1st college save in his SEC debut on March 17 versus Tennessee, pitching 3 no-hit innings and striking out 5. On April 7, Maltrud pitched 7 innings against 2023 SEC Tournament Champion Vanderbilt, allowing 4 earned runs and fanning 7 in the 5-4 win.

UNDER NEW MEXICO SKIES: In his 1st year at New Mexico State in 2021, Maltrud ranked 3rd on the team in strikeouts (55) while posting a 4.55 ERA in 15 appearances and 10 starts. He earned WAC Pitcher of the Week honors on March 22, 2021, after tossing 6 shutout innings and striking out 6 against Northern Colorado. In 2022, Maltrud lowered his WHIP to 1.04 and cut his walk rate down by 9.3%, posting 3 quality starts in 5 starts.

K STRUT: On March 21, 2021 versus Northern Colorado, Maltrud was featured by baseball media personality Rob Friedman, also known as PitchingNinja, after impersonating UFC fighter Conor McGregor with his "K Strut."

## CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

7 former Lake County Captains have made their MLB debut during the 2024 season.

**INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel:** On Wednesday, June 26, **INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Baltimore Orioles. He started at first base and batted 9<sup>th</sup> in the Guardians' order, finishing 1-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. *In his 1<sup>st</sup> MLB at-bat, Noel hit a 413-foot solo home run to center field, becoming the 4<sup>th</sup> player in Cleveland franchise history to homer in his 1<sup>st</sup> career MLB at-bat. He was the first to do so since 2004 Captain Kevin Kouzmanoff, who became the 1<sup>st</sup> player in MLB history to hit a grand slam on his 1<sup>st</sup> MLB pitch on September 2, 2006.* Noel played 88 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .238 with 78 hits, 12 doubles, 27 home runs, 67 RBI, a .521 SLG, and an .827 OPS.

**LHP Raymond Burgos:** On Monday, June 24, **LHP Raymond Burgos** made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Chicago Cubs. He pitched 1 inning of relief, allowing 3 hits, 1 earned run, and 1 walk, while throwing 1 strikeout. **Burgos** made 48 regular-season appearances (11 starts) for the Captains across the 2019, 2021, and 2022 seasons, going 10-6 with a 2.83 ERA, 115 strikeouts, a 1.29 WHIP, a .255 opposing batting average, and 8 holds, converting 1 of his 2 save opportunities. **INF/OF Daniel Schneemann:** On Sunday, June 2, **INF Daniel Schneemann** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the Washington Nationals. He started at 2<sup>nd</sup> base and batted 8<sup>th</sup> in the Guardians' order, going 1-for-3 with a 2-run double on his first MLB pitch and a strikeout. **Schneemann** played 98 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2018, 2019, and 2021 seasons, hitting .267 with 86 hits, 13 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 43 RBI, 12 stolen bases, and a .711 OPS. He also played 3 postseason games for Lake County in 2019, hitting .182 (2-for-11) with 2 runs, 2 RBI, and 1 walk.
