Captain's Log

LAST TIME OUT: The Lake County Captains posted their second consecutive one-run victory over the Dayton Dragons, a 3-2 win yesterday. Lake County is now 12-13 in games decided by one run this season.

Aaron Davenport delivered his longest outing of the season finishing six innings, permitting just two runs. The Captains three runs came on a three-run blast from Johnathan Rodriguez in the seventh inning, his tenth longball hit this season.

IS STAT SO?: After last night's 3-2 victory over Dayton, the Captains have now won three games in a row for the fourth time this season. Lake County won five in a row, against Peoria on May 24 through May 28, three straight from June 5 to June 8, one facing West Michigan and two over Fort Wayne and then three from June 11 to June 14, two against Fort Wayne and one over Beloit. This streak started with a Sunday win against Fort Wayne.

ONE RUN GAMES: The Lake County Captains and Dayton Dragons have played eight one-run games this season. The Captains have won three of those games, the last two played and game two of a doubleheader on May 7th, the final score being 4-3. The Dragons won four, all consecutively. Three from April 15th through April 16th and game one on May 4th, the final tally was 8-7, all at Day Air Ballpark.

PLANEZ'S PLACE IN CAPTAINS HISTORY: Alexfri Planez hit streak came to end yesterday at 22 games. It is the longest streak in the Midwest League this season. The 20-year-old was just two hits away from the longest hitting streak in Lake County history. Francisco Mejia had a hit in 24 consecutive games with the Captains in 2016. Over the stretch, Planez had a .333/.340/.667 slash line with eight home runs, 23 runs batted in and 32 hits. Planez only walked once during the streak. The streak began on June 14th.

ON BASE STREAKS: Petey Halpin has gotten on base in his last 14 games. In 10 of the 14 games, Halpin has gained at least one hit. The 20-year old has 11 walks compared to only three strikeouts. Angel Martinez has reached base safely in his last 12 games, smacking four of his eight home runs this season in the span.

2021 DRAFT: Five starting pitchers for the Captains' were selected in the 2021 draft. Doug Nikhazy, the 58th overall selection, has totaled 60 innings over 14 starts allowing 23 earned runs. Tommy Mace was taken in the second round, 69th overall via a competitive balance pick, the right-hander has 37 strikeouts in 40.1 innings pitched. Aaron Davenport, was the sixth round and 186th overall pick in the 2021 draft, his seven home runs allowed is the lowest among qualifying Captains starters. Cleveland selected Jack Leftwich with the 216th overall pick in the seventh round. Leftwich has not allowed a run over 12.1 innings with Lake County. Rodney Boone was an eighth-round selection, pick number 246, and has four starts including a complete game shutout against the Lansing Lugnuts on July 2nd.

NEW NAME, SAME GAME: The Lake County Captains are the High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. Cleveland officially changed their name to the Guardians on November 19, 2021.

LAST TIME OUT: Jaime Arias entered in relief with one out in the sixth inning with Lake County down a run against Fort Wayne. The left-hander got a strikeout and groundout to strand a runner on second. The game was tied entering the bottom of the seventh, but Arias would allow the go-ahead RBI single, despite getting three strikeouts in the frame and six overall.

MAN ON THE MOVE: In addition to the Captains, Arias has made appearances with the Akron RubberDucks (Double-A) and Columbus Clippers (Triple-A), in the 2022 season. With Columbus he last made a relief appearance on the Fourth of July, getting a four pitch strikeout to end the eighth inning. Arias has made a majority of his starts this season in Akron. The best was a four-inning outing allowing just one run on May 24th against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats.

BULLDOG: Arias spent three seasons as a Fresno State Bulldog. In his first two seasons, the southpaw was utilized as a backend bullpen piece. In 2019, Arias earned 12 saves, the second most in a single season in program history. Entering his freshman year Arias was tabbed as a freshman all-American by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, the 14th Bulldog to receive that distinction.

WOODLAND HIGH: For high school Arias attended Woodland High School and played baseball all four years. His senior season, he earned Tri-County All-Conference honors. He also competed in football during his time at Woodland. The school boasts notable graduates in baseball including two-time World Series champion Dustin Pedroia and the first female MLB coach Alyssa Nakken.

CHILDHOOD FAV: Arias' favorite athlete growing up was Clayton Kershaw because he dominates from the left side and is an effective pitcher.

CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

Six former Lake County Captains have made their MLB debut with the Cleveland Guardians in the 2022 season.

Nolan Jones: The 2016 second round pick, played his first game in the show, on July 8th against the Kansas City Royals. In his first major-league at bat, Jones smacked a RBI double down the right field line. Jones was a Captain in 2018, playing 90 games, compiling 90 hits including 16 longballs.

Oscar Gonzalez: The 24-year-old made his MLB debut on May 26th against the Detroit Tigers going 2 for 4, with a single and double. Gonzalez played 114 games in the 2018 season in Lake County, posting 135 hits, 13 Home Runs and 25 doubles.

Richie Palacios: The Brooklyn born Palacios earned two singles in his first two major league at-bats on April 25th against the Angels. Palacios earned had both his mother and father in attendance. Palacios played 20 games with Lake County in 2018 and had 24 hits.

Kirk McCarty: McCarty took the hill for the first time as a Guardian on Sunday, April 24th at Yankee Stadium. He appeared in the sixth inning, going three innings, surrendering four runs but adding three strikeouts.
