YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Fightin Phils, 4-1. Mason Black started on the mound and threw five perfect innings, tying a season high with eight strikeouts. Jimmy Glowenke opened the scoring in the top of the fourth with a two-run homer, his first at Double-A. In the fifth, Wade Meckler extended the lead to 3-0 with an inside-the-park home run, his first Double-A homer. Simon Whiteman added a fourth run with an RBI double in the sixth. Spencer Bivens and Evan Gates worked the sixth through eighth inning without allowing a run. The Fightin Phils broke the shutout in the ninth with an RBI single by Oliver Dunn.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. This series is the second of the year between the two teams. The Flying Squirrels opened the season with a three-game sweep against the Fightin Phils at The Diamond on April 8 and 9.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 9-2 in their last 11 games since June 18, including taking three-of-four so far this week in Reading to open the second half of the season. They won six straight from June 23 through Friday, their longest winning streak since a seven-game stretch from April 28-May 5, 2022. Over the last 11 games, the Flying Squirrels are batting .270 (99-for-367) with 12 homers, 25 doubles and have scored 66 runs. In that same stretch, the Richmond pitching staff has a 2.97 ERA (32 ER/97.0 IP) with 121 strikeouts. Over the last 17 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined to go 2-2 with a 2.05 ERA (14 ER/61.1 IP). For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.79 ERA is third-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 2622 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 3631 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.37 ERA, which is third-lowest in Double-A and eighth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

THE FIGHTIN PHILS were 28-40 in the first half of the season, which was last in the Eastern League. They have lost five-of-seven, including three-of-four in this week's series. The Fightin Phils opened the season 0-5, including a three-game sweep at The Diamond to begin the year. The Reading offense leads the league in batting average (.263), hits (641), total bases (1048), doubles (135), triples (16), OBP (.350) and OPS (.780). In this week's series, the Fightin Phils are batting .192 (24-for-125) and averaging 2.8 runs per game (11 runs/4 games). Reading's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Phillies prospects, including RHP Mick Abel (No. 2), RHP Griff McGarry (No. 4), OF Johan Rojas (No. 5), OF Ethan Wilson (No. 11), OF Carlos De La Cruz (No. 17) and OF Jhailyn Ortiz (No. 22). McGarry is rated by Baseball America as having the best fastball, Ortiz is rated as having the best outfield arm and Baron Radcliff is rated as the best power hitter. MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospect list includes Abel (No. 2), McGarry (No. 4), Rojas (No. 6), De La Cruz (No. 9), Wilson (No. 14) and Ortiz (No. 18).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Carson Whisenhunt makes his fourth Double-A start. He last pitched nine days ago in Game 1 of a doubleheader on June 23 against Harrisburg and allowed a career-high five runs (three earned) over two innings. On June 13 at Bowie, he allowed a then-career-high four runs over 3.2 innings. All four runs scored with two outs in the fourth inning. In his Double-A debut on June 7, he threw five scoreless innings with seven strikeouts against the Curve at The Diamond. Last week, MLB announced that Whisenhunt will participate in the 2023 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game on Saturday at Seattle's T-Mobile Park. He closed his time with High-A Eugene with five scoreless innings on May 31 at Vancouver and struck out seven straight batters from the third through fifth innings. He was named the Northwest League Pitcher of the Month for May. During his time in High-A, Whisenhunt led the Northwest League in ERA (1.42), strikeouts (36), BAA (107) and WHIP (0.67). He allowed one-orless hits in five-of-his-six starts for the Emeralds. Whisenhunt began the season with the Low-A San Jose Giants before being promoted to Eugene on April 26. A native of Winston-Salem, N.C., Whisenhunt pitched two seasons at East Carolina University in Greenville, N.C. He was selected by the Giants in the second round (66th overall) in the 2022 MLB Draft. Whisenhunt is rated by Baseball America as the No. 8 Giants prospect and No. 8 by MLB.com. For more on Whisenhunt, see page two.

FOR READING: Right-hander Tyler Phillips makes his 13th start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he allowed one run over five innings in a win at Portland last Sunday. After starting the season 1-4 with a 6.89 ERA in his first 10 starts, Phillips has gone 2-0 with a 1.06 ERA (2 ER/17.0 IP) in his last three starts since June 14. He started that stretch with six scoreless innings and a season-high nine strikeouts on June 14 at Hartford. Phillips was selected in the 16th round of the 2015 MLB Draft by the Rangers out of high school. He was designated for assignment by Texas in July 2021 and claimed by the Phillies. He joined Reading that season for four starts and missed all of 2022 after undergoing Tommy John surgery.

VAUN GONE WILD: Vaun Brown is riding a seven-game hit streak since June 22. He has homered three times in that stretch, including home runs in each of the first two games of this week's series. In his last seven games, Brown is batting .375 (12-for-32) with three homers, three doubles and nine RBIs, adding three stolen bases. Over his previous nine games from June 9-20, Brown hit .057 (2-for-35) with three walks and 16 strikeouts.

LONGBALL LOGAN: Since his promotion to Double-A on June 13, Logan Wyatt is batting .306 (11-for-36) with three homers, two doubles and eight RBIs. Between his time with High-A Eugene and with Richmond, Wyatt has homered 11 times this season in 63 games. Wyatt hit his first Double-A homer on June 23 at The Diamond against the Senators. He hit his second Double-A home run on Thursday night at Reading and finished the game with four RBIs, which tied his career high. Wyatt added another homer, a solo shot, in a two-RBI performance on Friday. He has driven in six runs over his last three games.

RETURN OF THE MECK: In Game 1 of June 23's doubleheader, Wade Meckler closed his historic performance with a two-run, walk-off single, giving the Flying Squirrels a 9-8 win in extras. Meckler went 5-for-5 and tied the single-game franchise record for hits. It was the 11th time a Richmond player has collected five hits in a game. In the first four games of this week's series, Meckler has reached base 12 times with nine hits, including four on Thursday, and three walks. Meckler has now reached base in all 20 of his Double-A games, including 31 hits and 15 walks. His on-base streak is the longest active streak in the league and the longest by a Richmond player this season. Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 180 PA) this season with a .424 batting average and a .492 OBP. On Friday, he hit an inside-the-park homer, his first Double-A home run. It was the fourth inside-the-park home run in Flying Squirrels franchise history, joining Brandon Crawford (2010), Tyler Graham (2014) and Tyler Fitzgerald (2023).

LUVE LUC!: Marco Luciano leads the team with 10 homers this year. He went on a five-game hit streak from June 10-14, during which he hit .588 (10-for-17) with four homers, a double, five walks and 10 RBIs. After going 1-for-20 over his next five games, Luciano has picked up nine hits in his last six games, including going 4-for-4 last Saturday and hitting a solo home run last Sunday.

RAGIN' CANTRELLE: In his last 12 games since June 14, Hayden Cantrelle has reached base 21 times, posting a .447 on-base percentage. In that stretch, he has picked up nine hits, walked 10 times and been hit by a pitch twice in 47 plate appearances. This season, he has been hit by a pitch 13 times, the most in the Eastern League. He also ranks sixth in the league in on-base percentage (.397) and tied for seventh in walks (45). He is also second among Giants minor leaguers in walks for the year.

OLD FRIENDS: Reading's roster includes former Flying Squirrels pitcher Matt Seelinger, who played with Richmond in 2021. The reliever spent that entire season with the Flying Squirrels, going 3-1 with a 3.07 ERA in 36 appearances. He was selected by the Phillies in the minor-league phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft. With Reading last year, Seelinger pitched against Richmond twice, both at The Diamond, and allowed one unearned run over 2.2 innings of work with four strikeouts. Seelinger is one of four former Richmond players in the Eastern League this year. Frankie Tostado, who was with the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is playing with the Senators. Diego Rincones, who was with the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is now playing for the Erie SeaWolves. Pitcher Grey Fenter, a member of the 2022 Flying Squirrels, is now with the Somerset Patriots

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Hayden Cantrelle is sixth in OBP (.397) and tied for seventh in walks (45). Mason Black is ninth in ERA (3.66), tied for ninth in strikeouts (74), tied for first in games started (15), ranks second in BAA (.197) and first in WHIP (1.05). Matt Frisbee is tied for first in wins (6).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 2), LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 6), OF Vaun Brown (No. 8), RHP Mason Black (No. 9), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 14), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 15), OF Wade Meckler (No. 16), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 27) and RHP José Cruz (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Luciano as the best power hitter, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. Luciano is also ranked as Baseball America's No. 55-overall prospect. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes nine Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2), Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29). Luciano is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 17 prospect in baseball.
