LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox defeated the Somerset Patriots in the series opener of a six game road trip by a final score of 10-2. Bowie scored four runs in the fourth behind RBIs from Jud Fabian, Frederick Bencosme, and John Rhodes. Kyle Brnovich pitched five innings of one-run ball with three strikeouts to record the win. The Baysox added six more runs in the final three innings, including a two-run homer by TT Bowens, to reach double figures for the seventh time this season.

STRUGGLES IN MAY

After batting a league-best .256 in the month of April, Bowie has batted a league-worst .211 in the month of May. Bowie scored the most runs in the league in the month of April (118) but has scored the third-fewest runs (98) in the month of May. The Baysox have also struck out the most times this month (232).

BASALLO IS HOT

Over his last 10 games, C **Samuel Basallo** is batting .395 (15-for-38) with two homers, a double and seven RBI and an OPS of 1.031. The Orioles No. 2 prospect has collected a hit in six consecutive games, which is his longest hit streak of the season. After posting an OBP of just .276 in April, Basallo has posted an OBP of .367 in the month of May.

TT HITS TATERS

1B **TT Bowens** smacked his fifth homer of the season last night with a towering two-run homer in the ninth off the top of the sponsorship signage in left-center. Bowens, who turned 26 on Monday, owns the longest active hit streak on the team at seven consecutive games and has reached base in eight consecutive games. His 29 RBI on the season is tied for fourth in the Eastern League.

TOP OF THE LEADERBOARD

OF **Jud Fabian** has six homers in the month of the May, which is tied for the league-lead with Harrisburg's Brady House. The Orioles No. 12 prospect's 16 RBI this month is tied for the fifth in the league....1B **TT Bowens** is tied for fourth in the Eastern League in RBI with 29....C **Samuel Basallo** has 45 hits on the season, good for fifth best in the circuit....OF **Dylan Beavers** owns an OPS of .892, which is fifth-best in the league.

JOHNSON AND JOHNSON

RHP **Seth Johnson** makes his ninth start of the regular season and his fifth on the road. The Orioles No. 10 prospect is coming off his longest start of the season where he went five innings and allowed just one run on two hits over one walk and six strikeouts in a no decision last Thursday vs Richmond. Johnson has posted a 2.93 ERA in the month of May after starting out the year with a 4.38 ERA in the month of April. Johnson is looking for his first Double-A win. This is the right-hander's first career start against Somerset.

PREVIEWING THE PATRIOTS

Entering this week, the Somerset Patriots are fourth in the Northeast Division at 22-23. The Double-A affiliate of the Yankees most recently took three of seven at New Hampshire but have won two of their last three. Nine of the Yankees' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- OF Spencer Jones (No. 2), LHP Brock Selvidge (No. 10), C/1B Ben Rice (No. 12), C Agustin Ramirez (No. 20), RHP Zach Messinger (No. 21), RHP Trystan Vrieling (No. 22), RHP Jack Neely (No. 24), RHP Danny Watson (No. 27), and IF Benjamin Cowles (No. 29).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Zach Messinger makes his 10th start of the regular season. The Yankees No. 21 prospect most recently dealt 5.2 innings and gave up three runs (two earned) on seven hits with one walk over eight strikeouts last Thursday in game one of a doubleheader in New Hampshire. Messinger is tied for the second in the Eastern League in strikeouts (56) and third in the league in innings pitched (50.1). In four starts in the month of May, Messinger has an ERA of just 2.01.

2024: In most recent start, threw longest outing of season and at Double-A with 5.0 IP, over 2 H, 1 R, 1 BB, and matched season-high 6 K in no-decision on 5/23 vs RIC. Has posted a 2.93 ERA in four May starts after recording a 4.38 ERA in four April starts. Still looking for first Double-A win. Owns a 4.38 ERA in four road starts.

2023: Placed on 60-day injured list to begin season by Triple-A Norfolk. Sent on rehab assignment to FCL Orioles on August 19. Made one start before being sent to Single-A Delmarva on August 22. Made one start with Shorebirds, then assigned to High-A Aberdeen on August 29. Made two starts with IronBirds. Struck out five in three shutout innings on Sept. 6 vs Greenville. Assigned to Double-A Bowie on Sept. 13. Struck out four in three innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits and two walks in lone start of season against Harrisburg.

2022: Started season in High-A Bowling Green. Made seven starts and struck out 41 batters over 27 innings to an ERA of 3.00. Placed on injured list in late May with right forearm inflammation before discovering that he suffered a torn UCL and needed Tommy John surgery. Traded from TB to BAL in a three team deal on August 1 that sent Trey Mancini to Houston.

2021: Entered first full season in minors with Single-A Charleston. Made 23 appearances (16 starts), pitched 93.2 innings and struck out 115 batters, good for fourth in the TB system. Posted an ERA of just 2.88 and allowed 33 walks.

2019: Debuted professionally with TB rookie ball affiliates in Princeton and GCL Rays.

College/Personal: Drafted by the Rays out of Campbell with the 40th overall selection in the 2019 Draft. At the time, was the highest-drafted player in Campbell history. A former two-way player at Louisiana (N.C) junior college as a shortstop before committing to pitching full time at Campbell.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League.
