**YESTERDAY:** The Captains battled back after early mistakes put them behind the eight ball, but could not complete a late comeback and fell to Fort Wayne, 5-4. Lake County committed three errors in the first two innings and the TinCaps homered twice – a two-run homer in the first by Seamus Curran and a two-run homer in the second by Chris Givin – to put Fort Wayne ahead, 5-1. Captains starter **Hunter Gaddis** bounced back from the rocky start and retired the final 13 men he faced after Givin's homer. Meanwhile, the Captains' offense cut into the deficit. **Bryan Lavastida** singled home **Clark Scolamiero** to put the Captains on the board in the third. The TinCaps maintained their 5-1 lead into the eighth when the Captains put two men aboard against lefty reliever Sam Williams and **Victor Nova** blasted a three-run homer to right field that cut the TinCaps' lead to 5-4. Carter Loewen, however, relieved Williams and shut the door for Fort Wayne. After surrendering an infield single and a walk, Loewen struck out pinch hitter **Will Brennan** to end the eighth and worked a perfect ninth to earn the save. TinCaps starter Gabe Mosser picked up the win after spinning seven innings and allowing one run. Gaddis took the loss after allowing five runs, one earned, over six frames. The Captains out-hit Fort Wayne, 11-4.

**SEASON SERIES:** The Captains are 11-6 in the season series against Fort Wayne and have outscored the TinCaps, 91-63 (+28 run differential). Seven different Captains have an OPS of .900 or greater against Fort Wayne – **Mike Amditis** (1.243 – 6 games), **Victor Nova** (1.009 – 12 games), **Will Brennan** (.993 – 15 games), **Quentin Holmes** (.963 – 7 games), **Brayan Rocchio** (.957 – 14 games), **José Tena** (.956 – 14 games) and **George Valera** (.900 – 10 games). In addition, five Captains have hit .300 or better against Fort Wayne – Amditis (.429), Holmes (.370), Brennan (.357), Tena (.327) and Rocchio (.310).

**BRENNAN BASHING:** Captains OF **Will Brennan** has crushed Fort Wayne pitching. In this series, Brennan is 7-for-18 (.412) with a home run, a double, three walks, four RBI, five runs scored and four stolen bases. During the season series, Brennan is hitting .357/.422/.571 (.993 OPS). Seven of Brennan's 18 doubles and eight of his 11 steals this season have come against Fort Wayne. Brennan enters today at second in the High-A Central League (HAC) in doubles, tied for second in hits (57), tied for fifth in extra-base hits (22), seventh in batting average (.294), tied for 13<sup>th</sup> in total bases (86) and 14<sup>th</sup> in on-base percentage (.367).

**HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER:** The Captains are 18-6 at home, compared to 14-21 on the road. Captains pitchers have experienced the biggest home/road disparity. Lake County has a 3.01 ERA at Classic Park and a 4.76 ERA on the road.

**HOT LAVA:** **Bryan Lavastida** saw an 11-game hitting streak come to a close last night, though he still has a 13-game on-base streak. Over the last 13 games, Lavastida is hitting .449/.473/.735 (1.207 OPS) with three homers and five doubles. Lavastida has seven multi-hit games during that span, including three three-hit performances.

**PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE:** **George Valera** and **Joe Naranjo** have both increased their walk-rate recently. Valera walked at an 8.9% rate in June, but has walked at a 16.2% rate in July. Naranjo walked at a 7.6% rate in May, but has walked at a 11.2% rate since the start of June.

**OPPO:** **José Tena** has been among the league's best at hitting the ball to the opposite field. Entering today, Tena has hit the ball the other way 38.4% of the time, which is the sixth-highest oppo% among qualified hitters in the High-A Central League (HAC).

**ALUMNI UPDATE:** 2017 Captains RHP **Justin Garza** became the 102<sup>nd</sup> former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on June 27. A record 10 former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF **Ka'ai Tom** (2016), RHP **Luis Oviedo** (2018-19), LHP **Sam Hentges** (2016), RHP **Louis Head** (2012-13), RHP **Nick Sandlin** (2018), INF **Ivan Castillo** (2014), **Jean Carlos Mejia** (2018), RHP **Eli Morgan** (2018), INF **Ernie Clement** (2018) and Garza. That breaks the record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year, besting the nine alumni that debuted in 2013 and 2016.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Hickman made one mistake on Independence Day, but it was enough to saddle the right-hander with the loss against South Bend. Nelson Velazquez drove home the only runs of the ballgame with a three-run homer off of Hickman in the third inning, as the Captains lost to the Cubs, 3-0. Hickman surrendered just two hits and two walks over six innings with six strikeouts.

**COLLEGE ACCOLADES:** Hickman was named a Preseason All-American by *Collegiate Game*, and Second Team Preseason All-America by *Perfect Game* before the shortened 2020 season.

**2020 DRAFT:** Cleveland selected Hickman in the fifth round (154<sup>th</sup> overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. This was considered a bit of a steal by some outlets with both *Perfect Game* and *Baseball America* ranking Hickman as the 65<sup>th</sup> best draft prospect entering the draft.

**COLLEGE WORLD SERIES CLINCHER:** Hickman's shining moment at Vanderbilt came in 2019 as he helped lead the Commodores to their second National Championship in school history. In the series clinching win, Hickman started for Vanderbilt tossing six strong innings, allowing just one run while fanning 10 Wolverines in the 8-2 win. He also started in the CWS semifinals against Louisville throwing six scoreless frames and surrendering just two hits with three strikeouts. In four total NCAA Tournament starts he went 2-0 with a 1.57 ERA in 23 innings.

**CAPTAINS AND VANDY:** Hickman is just the second Captain ever to come out Vanderbilt. The first and only other Commodore to come to Lake County was catcher on the 2003 Captains and Lake County Manager in 2012, David Wallace.

**STAFF LEADER:** In 2019 Hickman found himself starting 2019 out of the bullpen despite being the teams Sunday starter as a freshman, appearing out of the bullpen three times in 2018. After coming out of the pen in his first six appearances of 2019 with a 2.50 ERA Hickman rejoined the rotation and thrived. He finished the year with a 2.05 ERA to lead the team and finish 4<sup>th</sup> in the SEC.

**COACHES WORDS:** Hickman worked with Tim Corbin at Vanderbilt who has built a powerhouse in Nashville churning out top baseball talent. In recent years Walker Buehler, Sonny Gray and David Price among others have all starred in the big leagues after pitching for Vandy. Corbin says "Mason has turned into one of the most dependable and reliable starting pitchers that we have had in our program. He continues to develop and get better as his craft while taking on a leadership role on our pitching staff. He is a quality young man that excels in the classroom as well. Very competitive in everything that he does."

**STRIKEOUT BUMP:** After striking out just eight batters per nine innings as a freshman in Nashville, Hickman saw an increase in whiffs towards the end of his sophomore season. In his final six starts of the season he struck out nine or more batters five times. He finished 2019 with 129 strikeouts to finish 13<sup>th</sup> in the country and struck out 12 per nine innings.

**PROFESSIONAL STAFF:** The teammates Hickman worked with at Vanderbilt have been highly regarded around baseball. Pitchers that Hickman joined in the clubhouse that have recently been drafted include Tyler Brown (2020, HOU), Jake Eder (2020, MIA), Drake Fellows (2019, SD), Zach King (2019, MIA), Jackson Gillis (2019, MIL), Joe Goblott (2019, TB), AJ Franklin (2019, KC), Patrick Raby (2019, CIN), Maddux Conger (2018, DET) and Justin Wilson (2018, NYY). In 2021, Commodores Kumar Rocker and Jack Leiter are both expected to be first round draft picks in 2021 and were teammates of Hickman's in 2019 and 2020. Vanderbilt has also had 12 position players since 2018.
