Reading's record on the road this season (21-21, 500) is vastly better than at home (16-28, 364). The R-Phils are also scoring over half-a-run more per game on the road than at the friendly confines. Reading has homered more at home than on the road, but has allowed 72 long balls at home to 44 while away. Reading's ERA on the road is exactly a full-run lower than it is at FirstEnergy Stadium (4.30 to 5.30).

Reading returns to Altoona for the first time since the last week of the 2022 season for game five of this week's six-game series. Altoona won the

Reading won 4-1 as Griff McGarry was the star with a season-high ten strikeouts over a career-high seven innings pitched. He allowed just three hits, no runs and issued zero walks. It matched a season-high for strikeouts for an R-Phils pitcher and set a new team-high in innings pitched. It was the fourth time McGarry struck out 10+ batters in his career. Carlos De La Cruz also hit his 18th homer of the season in the win.

Cody Roberts homer Thursday was Reading's 100th long ball of the season, which ranks third in the league behind Somerset then Erie. Reading hit just 119 home runs in 2022 (0.86), but is on pace to beat that mark in 2023. So far, Reading is pacing for 159 (1.2 per game) homers for the season.

Reading Manager Al Pedrique sits just nine wins shy of 1,000 in his Major/Minor League managerial career. Pedrique is in his first season with the R-Phils and last managed with the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp in 2021. He also had a stint as a manager at multiple levels in the Yankees system.

#### De La Cruz Amongst the Leaders

With a hit last night, Carlos De La Cruz now leads the Eastern League in hits (99) and surpassed Johan Rojas' previous league lead. The closeset player to De La Cruz is 10 hits behind. With his 18th home run last night, De La Cruz is in third in the league in home runs, and five behind the league. He also ranks second in the Phillies organization in home runs, trailing Lehigh Valley's Weston Wilson, who has 23 on the season.

#### Around the Organization

The Phillies fell to Cleveland yesterday to open a weekend series as Bryce Harper made his first base debut. Lehigh Valley fell 4-2 at Toledo as Aramis Garcia had three hits and Weston Wilson doubled. Jersey Shore beat Winston-Salem 9-5 as Hao Yu Lee had four hits and Marcus Lee Sang had a double and three runs scored. Clearwater beat Tampa 7-0 behind five shutout innings from Jonathan Petit. Otto Kemp also had three hits in the win for the Threshers.

#### This Day in Baseballtown History

July 22, 2009: At Altoona, after making his first eight starts at FirstEnergy Stadium, Kyle Drabek finally toes the rubber on the road, picking up the win in the R-Phils' 7-2 decision over the Curve. Carlos Leon's 1st inning home run, his lone homer of the season, kick starts Reading's offense and Drabek lasts 8.0 innings, giving up 2 earned runs on six hits while striking out seven.

#### Curve Work

Altoona enters tonight with a 7-9 record in the second half, and 41-43 record overall in 2023. The Curve were in New Hampshire last weekend and lost Friday. Saturday was suspended and Sunday's game cancelled due to inclement weather. After this week, Altoona is on the road for a six-game series at Harrisburg. Top Prospects Henry Davis and Liover Pegeuro both are no longer with Altoona and now on the Pittsburgh Pirates roster.

#### Throw A "Curve" Ball

Righty Sean Sullivan gets the start tonight for Altoona. At Reading on April 27, Sullivan went five shutout innings, allowing just four hits and six strikeouts in a no decision. Overall, Sullivan is 2-2 with a 4.10 ERA over 14 appearences and 13 starts. Across 63.2 innings pitched, Sullivan has allowed 63 hits, issued 19 walks and has 19 strikeouts. He pitched a shutout inning on Tuesday for Altoona and last started July 4 against Erie, allowing five runs on eight hits over five innings in a loss. He spent 2022 with high-A Greensboro, going 2-5 with a 4.68 ERA. He was drafted by the Pirates in the eighth round of the 2021 draft out of California.
