TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: The Saints played a complete game in an 8-3 victory over Indianapolis on Thursday. Cory Lewis allowed two runs over 5.0 innings in his Triple-A debut. Payton Eeles gave the Saints an early lead with a leadoff home run, his second leadoff blast in four games. Yunior Severino added to the lead with his 21st home run of the season, a two-run homer in the fifth, tying the single-season franchise record. The Saints stole a franchise-record five bases in the eighth inning, scoring a pair of runs to make it 8-3. Jorge Alcala shut it down in the ninth to seal the victory

A LEAGUE OF HIS OWN: DaShawn Keirsey Jr. has put together an impressive 2024 campaign, recording 126 hits, 14 home runs and 36 stolen bases. He is the only International League player and one of four in Triple-A (Samad Taylor - TAC, Dustin Harris - RR and Andrew Velazaquez - GWN) this season to record at least 100 hits, 10 home runs and 30 steals. Keirsey is the lone Triple-A player (and one of three in the minors, joined by Erie's Gage Workman and Tampa's Roderick Arias) with 100 hits, 20 doubles, 10 home runs, 30 steals and 70 RBI. Only six Major League hitters have amassed those totals this season: Elly De La Cruz, Jarren Duran, Zach Neto, Shohei Ohtani, Jose Ramirez and Bobby Witt Jr.

S With 126 hits in Triple-A this season, Keirsey ranks second on the single-season hit charts. He is six shy of Andrew Stevenson's franchise-record 132 hits in 2023.

FINISHING STRONG: In their first three seasons at the Twins' Triple-A affiliate, the Saints have finished each season strong. In 2023, the Saints won four out of five games to finish against Toledo. The 2022 season ended on a five-game win streak, the first two of which came against Indianapolis. In the memorable Final Stretch of 2021, the Saints took six of the final nine games.

However due to the COVID-19 shutdown, followed by a right rotator cuff strain, Raya threw his first professional pitch on April 12, 2022.
