YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost the road trip opener against the Somerset Patriots, 10-1. In the first, Oswald Peraza tripled and scored on a groundout by Oswaldo Cabrera. The Flying Squirrels tied the game with a solo home run by **Vince Fernandez** in the second, his sixth of the season. In the bottom of the second, Isiah Gilliam put Somerset back in the lead with a sac fly. Matt Pita opened the lead to 3-1 with an RBI double. Diego Castillo hit a two-run homer in the third to extend the lead to 5-1. Castillo added a two-run single and Danny Sands hit a solo homer in the fifth to open the lead to 8-1. Sands added on with a two-run homer in the seventh to open a nine-run advantage for the Patriots. In his first Richmond start, **Michael Plassmeyer** allowed career highs in runs (7) and hits (10). Somerset starter Glenn Otto allowed one run on three hits over 7.0 innings. He collected 14 strikeouts in his outing, tying his own mark from earlier this season for the most strikeouts in a game in all of Double-A. Richmond combined to hit 0-for-12 with runners in scoring position on the night. The game was the first-ever match-up between the Flying Squirrels and the Patriots.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees at TD Bank Ballpark. The game is the first for the Flying Squirrels against the Patriots, who are in their first season as an affiliated team. This is Richmond's only trip to Somerset this season. The Flying Squirrels will host the Patriots for a six-game series at The Diamond from July 13-18. This series features the top-two teams in the league in ERA on the season so far.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost three of the last four games after winning five of the previous six. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 5.0 games behind first-place Bowie. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked eighth in the league with a .234 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked second in the league with a 3.49 ERA for the season.

THE PATRIOTS have lost five of their last eight games and sit in first place in the Double-A Northeast Northeast Division, 2.5 games ahead of Portland. The Somerset offense is ranked seventh in the Double-A Northeast with a .243 batting average. The Patriots' pitching staff is leading the league with a 3.03 ERA. The Patriots are in their first season as an affiliated team after picking up the Yankees affiliation during Major League Baseball's restructuring of the minor leagues this past offseason. The Yankees' Double-A affiliation was previously with the Trenton Thunder from 2003-2020. The Patriots were a founding member of the independent Atlantic League in 1998 and went on to win five league titles (2001, 2003, 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2015). Somerset's roster includes five of MLB.com's top-30 Yankees prospects, including SS Oswald Peraza (4), RHP Luis Medina (7), LHP Ken Waldichuk (27), RHP Glenn Otto (28) and RHP Hayden Wesneski (30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Caleb Kilian** makes his four Double-A start and first against the Patriots. He last pitched in the first game of a double-header on Thursday against Harrisburg and worked a season-high-tying 7.0 innings, allowing one run on five hits for his first Double-A win. It was the first complete game of his professional career. He opened the season with High-A Eugene, going 3-0 with a 1.25 ERA in four starts with 32 strikeouts in 21.2 innings. He was named High-A West Pitcher of the Week twice in the three weeks he spent with the Emeralds. He was drafted by the Giants in the eighth round in 2019 out of Texas Tech, where he was a First-Team All-Big 12 pitcher. *For more on Kilian, see page two.*

FOR SOMERSET: Right-hander Luis Medina makes his Double-A debut. He was promoted from High-A Hudson Valley this week. During his time with the Renegades, he was ranked ninth in the High-A East with a 2.76 ERA, third with 50 strikeouts, tied for eighth with 32.2 innings pitched and tied for fourth with a .162 opponents' batting average. He last pitched last Wednesday at Brooklyn and allowed season highs in runs (5) and hits. On the year, Medina has allowed one or less runs in five of his seven starts. He has allowed one hit in three starts. He was named High-A East Pitcher of the Week for the first week of the 2021 season. Medina was signed by the Yankees as an international free agent in 2015 out of the Dominican Republic, where he was clocked over 100 mph at age 16. He split the 2019 season between Low-A Charleston and High-A Tampa, combining to go 1-8 with a 5.47 ERA. He closed out the year posting a 0.40 ERA (1 ER/22.2 IP) in his final four outings, two with Charleston before being promoted to Tampa for his final two games of the year. In 2020, Medina worked at the Yankees' alternate site before pitching in the Puerto Rican Winter League, where he was named Pitcher of the Year.

FABULOUS FABIAN: Over his last 11 games since June 1, **Sando Fabian** is batting .438 (14-for-32) with one homer, five doubles and nine RBIs while scoring four runs. On Saturday night, Fabian drove a two-run double to put Richmond ahead in the seventh inning. Fabian hit .184 through his first 18 games of the season, but his performance since June 1 has raised his season average to .284.

TORRES ON A TEAR: In his last seven games since June 1, **Bryan Torres** is batting .438 (7-for-18) with one double and two RBIs. He has seen time defensively this season at catcher, second base and third base. Torres is in his first Double-A season. Prior to 2021, he had not played higher than the rookie level.

MO' TIME: Over his last six games since June 5, **Kyle Mottice** is batting .333 (7-for-21) with a double and three RBIs. On the season, he is batting .353 (12-for-34) against left-handed pitchers compared to .218 (12-for-55) against right-handers. He has hit the ball to the opposite field on 44.2 percent of his balls put in play, which is the third-highest rate in the Double-A Northeast, trailing Erie's John Valente (48.8 percent) and Harrisburg's Aldrem Corredor (44.6 percent).

AMAYA REBOUNDS: After surrendering five runs (four earned) in his first two Double-A appearances on May 4 and May 8 (G2), reliever **Luis Amaya** has worked nine straight appearances without allowing an earned run. That stretch spans 10.2 innings of work. The span has lowered his season ERA from 15.43 through the first two outings to 2.77. He has not allowed a run in his last seven outings, covering 9.0 straight scoreless innings.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 21-16 record is the second-best start in team history through 37 games, trailing only the team's 22-15 mark in the franchise's inaugural season in 2010. That year, the Flying Squirrels went 22-16 through 38 games, a mark the team can tie with a win today.

GETTING ON THE BOARD: Dating back to August 25, 2019, the Flying Squirrels have scored at least one run in 46 consecutive games. That streak includes all 37 games of the 2021 season. The next closest streak in the league is Bowie, which has not been shut out in 45 consecutive games dating back to August 23, 2019.

LAW OF AVERAGES: The 12 teams in the Double-A Northeast have combined to hit .240 this season. In 2019, the Eastern League combined for a .238 batting average, which was the lowest for the circuit since a .234 mark in 1971 and the sixth-lowest since the league was first classified as "Double-A" in 1963.

SWINGS AND MISSES: On Tuesday, Somerset starter Glenn Otto struck out 14 Flying Squirrels batters in the series opener. It was just the fourth performance with 14 or more strikeouts in the Eastern League/Double-A Northeast in the last ten seasons. On June 18, 2019, Trenton pitcher Deivi Garcia picked up 15 strikeouts, also against the Flying Squirrels. On April 22, 2013, Reading's Jesse Biddle struck out 16 batters at Harrisburg. On May 13, 2011, Harrisburg pitcher Brad Peacock picked up 14 strikeouts against the Flying Squirrels at The Diamond.

PITCHERS WHO RAKE: For the season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Double-A Northeast with seven hits, six RBIs and four runs scored by pitchers at the plate. Richmond is also tied with Hartford for first in the league with three walks worked by pitchers while batting. On the year, Richmond has gone 19-11 (.633) against National League affiliates, but have gone 2-4 (.333) against affiliates of American League clubs. After using the designated hitter for this week's series against Somerset, pitchers will return to the batter's box for the next two sets against Hartford and Binghamton. After July 4, the Flying Squirrels will return to using the DH for the remaining four series in July.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12), **Sean Hjelle** (13) and **Jose Marte** (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Four players, Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
