TRIPLE-A SUBWAY SERIES: The Syracuse Mets begin their second home series of the season and first set of the year against the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the Triple-A affiliate of the New York Yankees.

On Syracuse's and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's active rosters, five players have suited up in the Subway Series in the Majors.

For the Mets, C Hayden Senger and RHP Austin Warren appeared in one game each against the Yankees. For the RailRiders, INF Oswaldo Cabrera has played against the New York Mets in six games, OF Jasson Dominguez played five times, and RHP Yerry De Los Santos pitched once.

LAST SERIES RECAP: Syracuse dropped its first series of the season last week, taking two of six at Buffalo. The Mets collected two one-run victories, including a 3-2 win in the series finale on Sunday.

Syracuse was led offensively by MJ Melendez. The 27-year-old paced the Mets with five hits, going 5-for-21 (.238/.273/.286) with 1 RBI. Christian Arroyo, Cristian Pache, and Nick Morabito each recorded 2 RBI to lead the team.

LAST TIME OUT: Syracuse took an exhilarating series finale over Buffalo 3-2 on Sunday. CF Nick Morabito crushed a three-run homer in the eighth inning to put the Mets up by two. With the tying and go-ahead runs on base, RP Ofreidy Gomez collected his first save of the season by punching out C William Simoneit. Each of the six arms used by Syracuse struck out at least one batter. RP Jonathan Pintaro pitched 2.1 innings out of the bullpen and recorded three strikeouts.

MORE OF MORABITO: OF Nick Morabito comes into the series as Syracuse's team leader in AVG (.295), H (13), OBP (.367), SLG (.477) and OPS (.844). The Mets No. 12 prospect leads all Mets minor leaguers with 21 total bases. Morabito's three-run home run in Sunday's win against Buffalo traveled 442 feet, the fifth-longest home run in the International League this season.

TONG TIED: RHP Jonah Tong is scheduled to make his team-leading fourth start of the season on Tuesday. The Mets No. 2 prospect is tied for New York's minor league lead with 13 K (J. Pintaro, SYR).

Through six starts against Yankees full-season affiliates, Tong has posted a 1.63 ERA. In 27.2 IP, the 22-year-old has 44 K to 8 BB. Last season, Tong made three Double-A starts against Somerset in which he tossed 15.0 IP, allowed 1 R and posted 27 K to 5 BB. Tong's 8 K in 5.0 IP performance on August 10 at SOM was his final Double-A start and he would make his MLB debut 19 days later.

YOUNG ROSTER: The Syracuse Opening Day roster features six Top-30 Prospects: Tong (2), Clifford (4), Wenninger (6), Morabito (12), Lambert (17), Pintaro (21). 18 of 28 players on the roster have big league experience with 1,889 total major league games combined (2,214 MLB games on last year's Opening Day roster, 4,240 MLB games in 2024).
