### LUG•NOTES

**Congratulations:** Right-hander **Jeff Criswell** was named the Midwest League's Player of the Week after nearly delivering Lansing's first ever individual no-hitter in Saturday's Game 2 at Lake County, settling instead for the Lugnuts' first 7-IP complete game since **Jack Cushing** at Great Lakes on July 9, 2021, a one-hitter with six strikeouts on just 65 pitches. The Nuts have two no-hitters in franchise history: a three-pitcher nine-inning no-no in 2003 vs. Dayton, and a two-pitcher six-inning no-hitter in defeat in 2016 at Peoria. Criswell's shutout is the second in all of Minor League Baseball this year and the first in the Midwest League as well as the Midwest League's first complete game.

**Go Green:** UT **Marty Bechina** joins the Lugnuts today from Triple-A Las Vegas, making his Lansing debut. Bechina played four years at Michigan State University, where he competed against the Nuts in the 2016 and the 2017 Crosstown Showdowns. The Chicago native was drafted in the 32nd round in 2019 by Oakland. He becomes the second Spartan to play for the Lugnuts, joining 2011 outfielder Eli Boike.

**That's Weird:** Each of the last three Lugnuts victories over West Michigan have ended with 6-5 scores, though each one has gone a different number of innings: seven innings in Game 2 on Wednesday, nine innings Thursday and ten innings last night.

**Welcome Back:** INF **Drew Swift** played in the Nuts' first game of the year, a 3-0 loss to Lake County, and then went on the Injured List (oblique). The Arizona State Sun Devil, drafted in the eighth round last year, was activated from the IL earlier today.

**Power at Home:** The Nuts hit another homer yesterday, a **Lawrence Butler** three-run shot, and have now hit 14 home runs in their last nine games at home.

**Best in the League:** Lansing's offense leads the Midwest League in batting average (.248) and is the hardest team to strike out in the circuit (203 K's). The Nuts' 193 base hits are tied with West Michigan for the most in the league.

**Amongst the MWL Leaders:** Outfielder **Lawrence Butler** is fourth in the Midwest League with 19 walks, infielder **Euribiel Angeles** is third with 31 hits, southpaw **David Leal** is fifth with a 0.69 WHIP, and reliever **Angello Infante** is tied for first with five saves and second with nine appearances.

**Let's Play Two... Again:** The Lugnuts have played doubleheaders in each of their first five series of this season, getting swept in a twinbill at home against the Captains on April 9, splitting two at West Michigan on April 14, getting swept in two at home against Fort Wayne on April 23, splitting last Saturday's doubleheader at Lake County, and sweeping Wednesday's doubleheader against West Michigan. Last year, the Lugnuts played seven doubleheaders, four in September.

**165 Major League Nuts...:** Infielder **Vinny Capra** (2018 in Lansing) debuted for the Blue Jays on May 1, becoming the 165th all-time Nut to reach the Majors and the fourth this year, joining A's relievers **Zach Logue** and **Zach Jackson** and Oakland infielder **Christian Lopes**.

**Talent Rich:** The Nuts boast the No. 1 prospect in the Athletics' organization in **Tyler Soderstrom**, a 20-year-old catcher drafted 26th overall in 2020 who is considered MLB Pipeline's No. 56 prospect in all of baseball. Soderstrom is one of six Top 25 A's prospects on the roster, joining teenager **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 10) and **Euribiel Angeles** (No. 11), starting pitcher **Joey Estes** (No. 18), first baseman/outfielder **Lawrence Butler** (No. 20) and pitcher **Jeff Criswell** (No. 21).

## 26 PHIL POHL MANAGER

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

**Personal:** Criswell played the trombone, cello and guitar while growing up "but I didn't have any serious musical talent, that's probably why I took the career path I did"... his father, Brian, was drafted by the A's in the 17th round in 1984 from Western Michigan and pitched in the Midwest League for the Madison Muskies, today's West Michigan Whitecaps, eventually reaching Double-A Huntsville, where he was teammates in 1986 with Mark McGwire... Jeff's mother, Patti, has written books for the American Girl company... Jeff's sister, Natalie, was a record-setting swimmer at Bowling Green State University.

**Hail to the Victors:** Rated Perfect Game's No. 1 high school right-hander in Michigan in 2017 while at Portage Central, Criswell was drafted by the Tigers in the 35th round in 2017... turned them down and went to Ann Arbor... named All-Big Ten First Team as a sophomore (2.72, 116 K in 106 IP) and was a key contributor in leading the Wolverines on their run to College World Series Runner-Up to national champion Vanderbilt... in all, went 10-4, 2.88, 50 G, 162 1/3 IP, 174 K at Michigan.

**The Run to Omaha:** A look at how important Jeff was to the Wolverines in their 2019 path to the College World Series National Championship:

**NCAA Regional:** Struck out nine in 7 2/3 innings in a 10-4 comeback victory over Cincinnati. Michigan went on to eliminate No. 22 Creighton to advance.

**NCAA Super Regional:** Facing No. 1 UCLA, relieved Karl Kauffman with the potential tying and game-winning runs aboard in the bottom of the ninth and dispatched Jake Pries with a pop-up and Jack Stronach with a strikeout to secure a thrilling 3-2 win. Started the very next day and allowed one earned run in 5 1/3 innings, departing with a 3-2 lead, only to see the Bruins win 5-4 in 12 innings. Michigan went on to eliminate UCLA in Game 3, advancing.

**College World Series:** Pitched the final two innings scorelessly, earning the save, in a 5-3 CWS-opening win over No. 8 Texas Tech, striking out Brian Klein with the tying runs aboard to end the game. Earned another save in a rematch with Texas Tech six days later, firing the final three innings scorelessly with six strikeouts to complete a 15-3 romp, sending the Wolverines into the CWS Finals against No. 2 Vanderbilt. Secured the final two outs in Game 1 against the Commodores, a 7-4 UM win. Worked the final five innings in relief, striking out seven, in Michigan's Game 3 series-clinching 8-2 loss to Vandy.

**National Pride:** Following the 2019 college baseball season, Jeff was invited to pitch for the Team USA Collegiate National Team... recorded yet another crucial save, firing the final three innings against Taiwan in Game 2 of their three-game series... limited opposing batters to a .120 average, best of all pitchers on the team.

**Prospecting:** Criswell is currently Keith Law's No. 12 overall A's prospect, MLB.com's No. 9 A's pitching prospect and No. 22 overall prospect, and Fangraphs' No. 15 A's prospect... MLB Pipeline's grades: Fastball 60, Curve 50, Slider 55, Change 55, Control 45, writing about him, "Criswell's success as both a starter and reliever at the University of Michigan led to him landing a \$1 million signing bonus from the A's as a second-round pick in the 2020 Draft. After injuries limited him to just 12 innings pitched at High-A in what would have been his first full season with the organization, he did manage to end his year on a high note by returning in time to play in the Arizona Fall League and ranking among the league's top strikeout leaders.... He's been described as Bassitt-ish in reference to Chris Bassitt for similarities in their athletic builds."

**2021 Pro Debut:** Began 2021 as the highest ranked prospect on the Lugnuts' Opening Day roster: Keith Law's No. 5 overall A's prospect, MLB.com's No. 3 A's pitching prospect and No. 14 overall prospect, and Baseball America's No. 14 A's prospect. Wrote Law, "Criswell was mostly a two-pitch guy up to 95 mph at Michigan, but was showing four pitches and hitting 97 mph in instructs, with a cleaner delivery than the violent one he'd had before the shutdown. Criswell's slider was a swing-and-miss pitch in college and it's gotten sharper now, while his changeup, which he barely used in school, was flashing plus in instructs too." ... started the fifth game of the Lugnuts season, May 8 vs. Lake County, and tossed two easy scoreless innings, but then spent May 12-August 27 on the Injured List, limiting season... made six appearances, three starts, for the Arizona Fall League champion Mesa Solar Sox: 2-1, 6.75 ERA, 22 2/3 IP, 26 H, 17 R/ER, 5 HR, 12 BB, 32 K, 3 HBP, 1 balk, 1.68 WHIP... 12.7 K/9 IP.

**History vs. Fort Wayne:** Faced the TinCaps once in 2021, September 11 at Parkview Field... allowed first runs as a professional after opening his MiLB time with three consecutive shutout starts, spanning seven innings... shutout streak reached 10 innings until 4th inning: Tirso Ornelas and Brandon Valenzuela opened frame with singles, knocking out Criswell, and both scored against reliever Brandon Withers in a six-run rally; Fort Wayne went on to win 9-7... notable TinCaps against Criswell: Robert Hassell III 0-2 (groundout, groundout), Euriel Angeles 1-2 (single, K), Brandon Valenzuela (1-2, groundout, single), Justin Lopez 0-1 (groundout), Angel Solarte 1-1 (double), Reinaldo Ibarra 0-1 (K).

**2022:** Debuted as Lugnuts starter in the third game of the year, April 10 vs. Lake County... gave up two third-inning runs, but that was all in 4 2/3 innings in a no-decision... departed with the Nuts leading, 3-2... Lansing went on to win, 6-5, avoiding a three-game sweep... started April 16 at West Michigan; gave up 1st-inning (two-run) and 3rd-inning (solo) home runs to West Michigan's Jake Holton in suffering his first professional defeat... **Midwest League Pitcher of the Week: started Game 2 of a doubleheader April 30 at Lake County, taking a no-hitter into the 7th inning before allowing a Petey Halpin single; finished with a one-hit shutout in 8-0 Lugnuts win: 68 pitches, 1 H, 1 BB, 6 K.**
