LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones swept Friday's doubleheader from the BlueClaws in impressive fashion...Brooklyn routed Jersey Shore, 10-1, in the lid-lifter and again in the nightcap, 9-3...The 'Clones scored 2 runs in the 1st and added 5 more in the 2nd before tacking 3 more on in the 7th...**CF A.J. Ewing** tallied 3 hits and drove in a run...**3B Jesús Báez** added 3 hits of his own with 2 RBI...**1B Estarling Mercado** collected 3 knocks and scored twice...**CF Eli Serrano III** picked up 2 hits and drove in 3, while SS **Boston Baro** reached base 3 times with 2 hits and a walk...**RF Troy Schreffler Jr.** came off the bench and added a 3-run double...All 10 players in Brooklyn's lineup reached base at least once...**LHP Jonathan Santucci** earned his 2nd-straight win with 5.0 innings of 1-run ball, striking out a career-high-tying 6...In the nightcap, SS **Jesús Báez** went 3-for-3 and reached base 4 times...The 20-year-old powered a pair of home run and drove in 5...**DH A.J. Ewing** collected 2 more hits and **1B Chris Suero** reached base 3 times with 2 walks and a RBI single...In the twinbill, Brooklyn outscored Jersey Shore, 19-4, and outhit them, 23-9.

DOUBLE THE FUN: The Cyclones swept Jersey Shore in Friday's doubleheader with a dominant performance...Brooklyn captured the opener, 10-1, and the nightcap, 9-3...The 'Clones outscored Jersey Shore, 19-4, and outhit them, 23-9, in the double-dip...The two teams will play another doubleheader on Sunday to make up for the washed-out affair on Wednesday...Brooklyn split its first doubleheader in 2025, losing Game 1 vs. Hudson Valley on April 12, 2-0, and winning Game 2, 2-1...Brooklyn is now 1-0-1 in doubleheaders in 2025, holding a 3-1 overall mark...In 2024, the Cyclones were 2-1-3 in doubleheaders, holding a 7-5 record overall...Friday marked Brooklyn's first doubleheader sweep since August 11, 2024, vs. Hudson Valley...The Cyclones won the opener, 4-2, and the finale, 3-1.

FRANKIES 457: RHP **Frankie Montas** will make a Major League rehab start for the Cyclones on Saturday at Jersey Shore...Saturday's originally scheduled starter, RHP **Noah Hall**, is slated to follow him in relief...Montas will make his New York Mets' organizational debut in the contest, as he has not pitched in an official game this year...The 32-year-old was placed on New York's 15-day injured list on March 27 (retro 3/24) with a right lat strain...He was transferred to the 60-day IL on May 1...Montas signed a 2-year, \$34 million deal with the Mets on December 4, 2024...The right-hander split the 2024 season between the Cincinnati Reds and Milwaukee Brewers, posting a 7-11 record with a 4.84 ERA (81 ER in 150.2 IP), 66 walks, and 148 strikeouts...Montas has a career 44-46 mark with a 4.09 ERA (338 ER in 744.1 IP) and 760 K's over 160 career appearances and 129 starts.

ALL BÁEZ ON ME: After recovering from knee surgery, INF **Jesús Báez** has slowly started to re-turn to form...The 20-year-old has reached base safely in 11-of-13 plate appearances in the series against Jersey Shore and went 6-for-8 at the plate in Friday's doubleheader with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI...Báez has reached safely in 15-straight games since May 3 vs. Wilmington, hitting .365/.484/.596/1.080 with 10 runs scored, 3 doubles, 3 home runs, 15 RBI, 3 stolen bases, and 11 walks to 7 strikeouts...Báez also enters Friday with a 6-game hitting streak since May 15 vs. Winston-Salem, going 11-for-21 (.524) at the plate with 6 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, 9 RBI and 6 walks...On Tuesday, the infielder tied a Cyclones' single-game franchise record, working 4 walks at Jersey Shore...The feat has been accomplished 11 times, most recently by LF **Ryan Clifford** on April 21, 2024, at Jersey Shore...During May, Báez is 2nd in the South Atlantic League in RBI (18), 3rd in on-base percentage (.466), tied for 4th in OPS (1.066), 6th in batting average (.350), and tied for 8th in slugging percentage (.600).

SWIPER KEEP SWIPING: Brooklyn is off to a historic start on the basepaths in 2025...The Cyclones' 7-6 win over Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...Brooklyn continued to wreak havoc on the bases in a May 17 win over Winston-Salem, during which the Cyclones stole 6 bases courtesy of 3 players...Brooklyn enters play on Friday with 95 steals, good for the 2nd most in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen (114)...The 95 swiped bags are the most by the Cyclones through the team's first 42 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital ERA (2005-present) by 25 swipes...The 2024 club is 2nd with 70 steals through 42 games...The Cyclones' single-season franchise record is 181 steals set in 2024.

HOW SWEEP IT IS: With Sunday's 7-6 walk-off victory vs. Winston-Salem in 10 innings, the Cyclones completed their first 6-game sweep since 2022 and their first at home since 2021...Brooklyn had not completed a 6-game sweep since taking all 6 contests at Jersey Shore from August 23-28, 2022...The Cyclones outscored the BlueClaws, 53-18, in that series...It was Brooklyn's first 6-game sweep on Coney Island since July 20-25, 2021, vs. Wilmington...The 'Clones outscored the Rocks, 41-22, in that set...Brooklyn's 6-game winning streak was snapped Tuesday at Jersey Shore...It was the first time the team had won 6-straight games since September 3-9, 2022, vs. Wilmington and at Winston-Salem...The Cyclones clinched the Second Half South Atlantic League North Division crown during that win streak...Additionally, the Cyclones' 29-13 record through 42 games is tied with the 2010 squad for the franchise's best through 42 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital ERA (2005-present).

CAN EW BELIEVE IT?: IF/OF **A.J. Ewing** has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season and was recognized as the South Atlantic League Player of the Week on Monday...In 5 games vs. Winston-Salem, the 20-year-old went 9-for-18 (.500) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 3 RBI, 5 walks, and 6 stolen bases...Ewing led the SAL in steals (6) and on-base percentage (.609) for the week...He is the first Cyclone to receive a league weekly honor since INF **Nick Lorusso** and LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** took home Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, for May 20-26, 2024...Entering play on Saturday, the Springboro, Ohio native is tied for 2nd in Minor League Baseball in triples (6), 3rd in stolen bases (31) and batting average (.378), and 9th in on-base percentage (.467) and OPS (1.026)...Since debuting with Brooklyn on April 29, Ewing leads the league in steals (17) and is tied for 1st in hits (28)...He is also 4th in batting average (.359), tied for 4th in triples (2), 8th in on-base percentage (.432), and 10th in total bases (40)...The 2023 4th-round pick enters Saturday riding a 26-game on-base streak since April 18...During the on-base streak, Ewing has hit .363/.458/.520/.978 with 22 runs scored, 5 doubles, 4 triples, a home run, 14 RBI, 18 walks, and 24 stolen bases.

REIM TIME: INF **Jacob Reimer** remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...The former 4th-round pick recorded more RBI (8) in the first 2 games of 2025 than he had in 25 outings (7) in an injury-plagued 2024...Reimer launched his 7th home run of the season in May 15's win vs. Winston-Salem...Entering play on Saturday, Reimer is tied for 2nd in Minor League Baseball in extra-base hits (26), tied for 5th in doubles (16), 7th in slugging percentage (.609), tied for 7th in total bases (92), and 10th in OPS (1.020)...The former 4th-round pick leads the South Atlantic League in runs scored (37), OPS (1.020), extra-base hits (26), and doubles (16), and is tied for 1st in hits (49)...Reimer is also 2nd in total bases (92) and slugging percentage (.609), 3rd in RBI (32), 4th in batting average (.325), tied for 4th in triples (3), tied for 6th in home runs (7), and 8th in on-base percentage (.411).

ALL ABOUT THE BERGE-AMINS: OF **Carson Benge** has been heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...The 2024 first-round pick enters Saturday tied for the South Atlantic League lead in triples (4)...He is also tied for 2nd in runs scored (32), 4th in OPS (.973) and extra-base hits (18), tied for 4th in slugging percentage (.537) and doubles (10), 5th in batting average (.313), on-base

vs. JERSEY SHORE: After sweeping a 6-game homestand vs. Winston-Salem, Brooklyn hits the road for a 7-game series with the BlueClaws...Jersey Shore enters the series after dropping 4-of-6 at Wilmington...The BlueClaws are 8-10 at home this season and dropped 3-of-5 to Brooklyn in Lakewood from April 22-27...Jersey Shore boasts 8 of the Phillies' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: INF **Devin Saltiban** (9), INF **Bryan Rincon** (14), INF **Carson DeMartini** (15), OF **John Spikerman** (16), LHP **Mavis Graves** (17), RHP **Alex McFarlane** (18), RHP **Micah Ottenbreit** (28), and OF **Dylan Campbell** (30)...Saltiban and Spikerman are currently on the injured list...In 119 meetings since 2022, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 62-57 (.521)...Brooklyn is 34-31 (.523) in 65 games at ShoreTown Ballpark.

percentage (.436) and total bases (70), tied for 5th in total bases (72), tied for 6th in hits (42), 7th in walks (28), and tied for 10th in RBI (25)...The 22-year-old is riding had an 11-game hitting streak since May 8 at Asheville snapped on Friday, but has reached base safely in 16-straight games since May 3 vs. Wilmington, hitting .345/.500/.709/1.209 with 16 runs scored, 5 doubles, 3 triples, 3 home runs, 16 RBI, 16 walks, and 6 stolen bases.

KEEP THE 'COASTER MOVING: The Cyclones have yet to drop a series through the first 40 games of the 2025 season...Through Brooklyn's first 7 series of the year, the Cyclones hold a 5-0-2 record...In home series, Brooklyn is 3-0-1, splitting their first full 6-game set with Hudson Valley from April 8-13...The Cyclones have not lost a series since they dropped 5-of-6 at home vs. Jersey Shore from August 20-25, 2024...Since then, Brooklyn is 7-0-2 in a series of any length.

WHAT A RELIEF!: Brooklyn's bullpen has been dominant in the 2025 season...Entering play on Saturday, Cyclones relievers have a 17-6 record with a 3.38 ERA (72 ER in 192.0 IP), 10 saves, 94 walks, and an eye-popping 250 strikeouts...Brooklyn's relief staff holds the 7th-best strikeouts-per-9-innings ratio in Minor League Baseball (11.72). Chicago-NL's Triple-A Iowa is first (12.72)...The Cyclones relievers have also held opponents to a .183 batting average, which is the lowest in the South Atlantic League and 3rd-lowest in MiLB...Miami's Double-A Pensacola (.161) leads the Minors...On the year, Brooklyn relievers have a 31.65% strikeout rate.

SUPER SUERO: C **Chris Suero** has been unstoppable in 2025...On April 17, he delivered the go-ahead 2-run double in the 9th, in a 7-3 comeback win at Aberdeen...On April 15, the 21-year-old recorded the 2nd multi-home run game of his career in an 8-7 victory...Suero powered a 2-run blast in the 2nd and added another 2-run shot in the 3rd...The Bronx native homered in 3-straight at-bats dating back to his solo shot in the 6th inning on April 13 vs. Hudson Valley...Entering play on Saturday, Suero is 2nd in the South Atlantic League in hit-by-pitches (11) and tied for 6th in home runs (7) and tied for 9th in stolen bases (15).

MARCO POLO: IF **Marco Vargas** has not stopped hitting since joining the Cyclones at the end of April...The 19-year-old has reached safely in all 18 games played with Brooklyn, and in all 31 contests he has appeared in this year between the Cyclones and Single-A St. Lucie...During the 30-game on-base streak, Vargas is hitting .300/.415/.373/.788 with 24 runs scored, 3 doubles, a triple, a home run, 17 RBI, 22 walks, and 10 stolen bases.

HOMER HAPPY: Brooklyn's offense erupted in the 2nd inning on May 9 at Asheville...RF **Eli Serrano III**, DH **A.J. Ewing**, and CF **Carson Benge** clubbed back-to-back-to-back home runs with 1 out in the frame off Asheville's RHP **Yeriel Santos**...It marked just the 2nd time Brooklyn had hit 3-straight home runs in Minor League Baseball's Digital ERA (2005-present)...**2B Luke Ritter**, **1B Joe Genord**, and C **José Mena** first accomplished the feat with back-to-back-to-back shots in the 6th inning on June 20, 2021, at Wilmington...SS **Jesús Báez** added a 4th home run in the frame, marking the first time in MiLB's Digital Era that the Cyclones powered 4 long balls in a single inning...The feat has been accomplished just 2 other times in MiLB this season...Miami's Double-A Pensacola accomplished the feat with 4 homers in the 3rd inning on April 26 vs. Knoxville...Chicago-NL's Triple-A Iowa blasted 5 home runs in the 7th inning on April 16 vs. St. Paul...Brooklyn enters Saturday ranked 3rd in the South Atlantic League in home runs (39)...Since 2005, only the 2021 team (45) has hit home runs through the team's first 42 games.

HALL PASS: After an injury-shortened 2024, RHP **Noah Hall** has returned to form in 2025...Over his first 8 starts, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 3-2 with a 1.82 ERA (8 ER in 39.2 IP), 42 strikeouts and only 26 hits allowed...Entering Saturday, Hall is 3rd in the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.82), 5th in batting average against (.183), tied for 8th in double plays induced (3), and 10th in innings pitched (39.2)...Hall's 44.8% infield fly ball rate leads the circuit and his 55.6% groundball rate is 2nd...The University of South Carolina product became not only the 1st player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the 1st player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days.

SIR SERRANO: OF **Eli Serrano III** put together his best game as a professional in April 24's win at Jersey Shore...The 21-year-old went 5-for-6 at the plate, scored 3 runs, doubled twice, blasted a solo home run in the 8th, and drove in 3...Since 2005, Serrano was the 1st Cyclone to record 5+ hits, 3+ runs, 3+ extra-base hits, a home run, and 3+ RBI in a single game...He is only the 2nd Brooklyn player to record 5-or-more hits, hit a home run, and drive in 3-or-more runs in a single game since 2005...**2B Luke Ritter** also accomplished the feat with 5 hits, a home run, and 3 RBI in a 5-4 win vs. Lowell in 11 innings on June 28, 2019...Ritter's home run was a game-tying blast in the 9th...Serrano is also the 2nd Cyclone to tally a 5-hit game at the High-A level and 9th overall since 2005...LF **Alex Ramirez** was the last player to accomplish the feat with a franchise-record 6 hits on July 21, 2023, at Hudson Valley...Entering Saturday, Serrano is tied for 4th in the South Atlantic League in doubles (10) and tied for 6th in extra-base hits (16) and RBI (27).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 11 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF **Carson Benge** (3), INF **Jesús Báez** (7), LHP **Jonathan Santucci** (12), INF **Boston Baro** (13), INF **Marco Vargas** (14), RHP **Nate Dohm** (18), INF **Jacob Reimer** (20), C **Chris Suero** (21), OF **Eli Serrano III** (22) and C **Ronald Hernández** (26), and OF **A.J. Ewing** (27)...Of those 11, 5 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...The Cyclones also possess 10 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per *Baseball America*...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Vargas (17), Suero (20), Reimer (21), Dohm (23), Ewing (24), and RHP **Raimon Gómez** (26)...Brooklyn also hosts 11 of SNY's Top 30 from **Joe DeMayo**...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), and Gómez (28).

COMEBACK REPORT: Montas will make his New York Mets' organizational debut in Saturday's matchup at Jersey Shore...The 32-year-old did not pitch in Spring Training and was placed on New York's 15-day injured list on 3/27 (retro 3/24) with a right lat strain...He was transferred to the Mets' 60-day injured list on May 1...Montas signed a 2-year, \$34 million deal with New York on 12/4/24...Montas also dealt with injury during the 2023 season...Missed the first 160 games recovering from right shoulder surgery on 2/21/23...Missed time during the 2022 campaign with right shoulder inflammation...Missed time in 2016 with a fractured right rib cage.

2024: Split the season between the Cincinnati Reds and Milwaukee Brewers...Named the Reds' Opening Day starter and fired 6.0 scoreless innings with 4 strikeouts and 0 walks in an 8-2 win vs. Washington...Was his 100th career start and 3rd career start on Opening Day...Removed from his start due to a right forearm contusion after throwing only 16 pitches on 4/21 vs. Los Angeles-AL...Placed on the injured list the following day...Returned from the IL on 5/7 vs. Arizona, allowing 2 runs (1 earned) over 6.0 innings...Allowed 1 hit over 7.0 scoreless innings on 6/4 at Colorado...9th pitcher in Major League history to throw 7.0 or more scoreless innings and allow 1 or fewer hits in Colorado...Acquired by the Milwaukee Brewers from the Cincinnati Reds in exchange for OF **Joey Wiemer**, RHP **Jakob Junis**, and cash considerations on 7/30...Strikeout rate jumped from 19.0% to 28.7% with the Brewers...Finished with 70 K's in 57.1 innings with Milwaukee...Struck out 8 or more batters in 3-straight starts from 9/6-17, including a pair of 10-strikeout performances...Had only 1 such start through his first 25 outings of the season...Started Game 2 of the National League Wild Card Series against the Mets...Allowed 3 runs (1 earned) over 3.2 innings.

ON THE MOVE: Prior to the 2024 trade deadline, Montas had already been traded on more than a few occasions in his professional career...The Sainagua, D.R. native originally signed with the Boston Red Sox as an international free agent on 12/14/09...Acquired by the Chicago White Sox with INF **Cleuluis Rondón** and RHP **J.B. Wendelken** in a 3-team trade on 7/31/13...White Sox also acquired OF **Avisail García** from Detroit...Boston received RHP **Jake Peavy** from Chicago-AL and RHP **Brayan Villareal** from Detroit...Boston also acquired INF **José Iglesias** from Detroit...Dealt to the Los Angeles Dodgers along with INF **Micah Johnson** and OF **Trayce Thompson** as part of another 3-team deal on 12/16/15...The Cincinnati Reds acquired INF **Brandon Dixon**, INF **José Peraza**, and OF **Scott Schebler** from Los Angeles-NL...Chicago-AL acquired INF **Todd Frazier** from Cincinnati...Sent to the Oakland Athletics along with RHP **Grant Holmes** and RHP **Jharel Cotton** on 8/1/16...OF **Josh Reddick** and LHP **Rich Hill** were traded to the Dodgers...Acquired by the New York Yankees along with RHP **Lou Trivino** on 8/1/22...LHP **Ken Waldichuk**, LHP **J.P. Sears**, RHP **Luis Medina**, and INF **Cooper Bowman** were sent to Oakland.

LET ME BE FRANK: The best season of Montas' Major League career came in 2021 with the Oakland Athletics...The right-hander finished 6th in the American League Cy Young Award voting and set the A's franchise record for strikeouts-per-9-innings by a starter (9.96)...Montas set career highs in wins (13), starts (32), innings (187.0), and strikeouts (206)...The 206 K's were the 2nd-most in a single season in the A's Oakland era (1968-2024)...Tied for the AL lead in starts, ranked 3rd in innings pitched, and 4th among qualifiers in ERA (3.37)...Named AL Pitcher of the Month for September/October after going 3-0 with a 2.19 ERA (9 ER in 37.0 IP) and 40 strikeouts in 6 starts...After the All-Star break, compiled a 2.17 ERA (21 ER in 87.0 IP) in 14 starts...In the second half, ranked 2nd in the AL among qualifiers in ERA and 3rd in strikeouts (102).
