Agustin Ruiz hit an RBI triple. David Griffin tossed five innings of one-run ball with six strikeouts in his third Double-A start this season.

Jordan's Brand: Rowdey Jordan made a massive impact in the last series. Jordan drove in four runs in a game for the first time in his professional career on Saturday. It was the 10th time in his career that he drove in at least three runs in a game. Jordan only drove in four runs in a game twice in four seasons at Mississippi State (as a freshman on March 7, 2018 v. New Mexico State & and as a sophomore on March 24, 2019 v. Auburn). In six games last week against Portland, Jordan had six hits with nine runs batted in and four runs scored. He had two triples, a homer, a double, four walks, and a stolen base.

Just Drew It: Outfielder **Drew Gilbert** snapped a seven-game hitting streak on Sunday, recording four multi-hit games in that span. He had six multi-hit games over his first 13 games with Binghamton. On Friday, Gilbert hammered his second home run with the Ponies, eighth in Double-A and 14th overall this year. In 15 games with Binghamton, Gilbert is hitting .345 (19 hits), with a .940 OPS, 11 RBIs, eight runs, two doubles, a triple, and two homers.

Action Jackson: Infielder **Jeremiah Jackson** has reached base safely in 15 of his first 16 games with Binghamton. He had 12 RBIs in his first 12 games with the Ponies. In six games against Portland last week, Jackson built a six-game hitting streak with a hit in each game. He drove in three runs, scored three runs, drew three walks, was hit by a pitch, and stole a base.

JT 3(+ hits): First baseman JT Schwartz dominated the New Hampshire Fisher Cats in the six-game series earlier this month. Schwartz had three-straight three-plus hit games to start the series, with a four-hit game and two three-hit games. In six games against the 'Cats, Schwartz hit .579 (11-for-19) with a 1.373 OPS. He had three doubles, two runs batted in, a run scored, two walks, and a stolen base. He recorded a .636 on-base percentage and .737 slugging percentage in the series.

Last Start: Tidwell allowed six runs on six hits over 3.2 innings in the series opener against Portland last Tuesday. He walked four and struck out five.

2022: Tidwell was drafted by the New York Mets in the second round (52nd overall) of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Tennessee. He threw one inning for the FCL Mets before being promoted to Low-A St. Lucie. He made four starts for Low-A St. Lucie, and allowed two runs on four hits over 8.1 innings with nine strikeouts and six walks.

BACKGROUND: Tidwell ranks as the New York Mets' No. 2 pitching prospect and No. 10 overall prospect. The 22-year-old is in his first full season of professional baseball. In his 17 starts with High-A Brooklyn in 2023, Tidwell held hitters to the lowest opponent batting average in the South Atlantic League (.190), earned the second most wins (8), and carried the third lowest ERA (3.09). The second-round pick out of Tennessee had a decorated collegiate career. As a freshman in 2021, he posted a 3.74 ERA with 90 strikeouts in 98.2 innings. During his final year with the Volunteers in 2022, Tidwell was named to the NCAA Knoxville Regional All-Tournament Team. He was also named to the 2021 SEC All-Freshman Team and earned Freshman All-American Honors from Perfect Game and D1Baseball. Helped lead Loretto High School to 2017 Class A State Title. He hit .557 with 30 XBHs and 6 HR while posting an 8-0 record with 107 Ks in 53 innings as a junior in 2019.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five career saves and a 5.36 ERA.

Darin Everson- Hitting Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 1st year in the Mets organization. Everson spent the previous five seasons as the Colorado Rockies Hitting Coordinator and 10 years in the Rockies organization. During his tenure, he served as the organization's Triple-A hitting coach in 2017, Double-A hitting coach from 2013-2014 and as the club's Double-A manager from 2015-2016. He previously was part of the Marlins organization for four years and served as an Associate Scout with the Baltimore Orioles from 2003-04. Everson played professionally as a catcher and first basemen for seven seasons with the Montreal Expos, Pittsburgh Pirates, and Boston Red Sox organizations.

Mariano Duncan - Bench Coach - 2nd season with Binghamton - 5th year with Mets organization. Duncan returns to the Southern Tier to begin his second year as Bench Coach with the Rumble Ponies. He previously served as the bench coach for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) in 2021. He is entering his fifth year in the Mets organization. The former infielder played 12 major league seasons with the Los Angeles Dodgers, Cincinnati Reds, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Toronto Blue Jays. He was a member of two World Series championship teams (1990 Cincinnati Reds, 1996 New York Yankees) and was inducted into the Dominican Republic Baseball Hall of Fame in 2008.
