YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the SeaWolves, 12-4. Erie opened a 3-0 lead in the first with a bases-loaded walk by Eliezer Alfonzo and a two-run single by Chris Meyers. In the second, **Thomas Gavello** closed the score to 3-2 with a two-run single. Trei Cruz drove in three runs with a double in the third to extend the Erie lead to 6-2. In the fourth, **Zach Morgan** hit a two-run single to pull the Flying Squirrels back within two. The SeaWolves scored four in the sixth to pull ahead, 10-4. Eduardo Valencia hit a solo homer, Jim Jarvis added a two-run double and Cruz hit an RBI single. In the seventh, Alfonzo hit an RBI double and Meyers added an RBI single to cap the scoring.

BOMBS AWAY: The Flying Squirrels tied their season high with four homers on Wednesday, with **Carter Howell**, **Cal Mitchell** and **Jairo Pomares** belting solo homers and **Thomas Gavello** hitting a two-run shot in the ninth. The Flying Squirrels also homered four times on May 2 against the Patriots at The Diamond. The four homers were tied for the second-most by an Eastern League team in a game this year. It was the 25th time in franchise history the Flying Squirrels have homered at least four times in a game. From 2010-2019 in the franchise's first 10 years, it happened seven times. Since 2021, the Flying Squirrels have homered four-or-more times on 18 different occasions. Four home runs in a game was the single-game team record until 2022, when the Flying Squirrels had three five-homer games and a seven-homer game. On August 31, 2023, the Flying Squirrels set the franchise single-game record with eight homers at Hartford.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. Richmond dropped four-of-six at The Diamond against the SeaWolves from May 13-18. The two teams meet again for a six-game series at UPMC Park from August 5-10.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,935 fans per home game, which ranks third among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are 3-14 in their last 17 games. They dropped four-of-six in last week's home series against the Senators. The previous week, they went 1-5 at Binghamton and lost three times on walk-off hits. Of Richmond's 39 losses this season, 20 of them have been by two runs or less (13 by one, seven by two). The Richmond offense has the second-fewest strikeouts (423) in the Eastern League but are last in runs scored (171). Richmond's pitching staff has a league-high 4.90 ERA.

THE SEAWOLVES are in first place in the Southwest Division, one game ahead of Akron. They are 7-1 in their last eight games. For the year, the Erie offense leads the Eastern League in batting average (.266), runs (301), hits (469), total bases (760), doubles (109), OBP (.347), SLG (.431) and OPS (.778). Erie's roster features eight of MiLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including C/1B Thayron Liranzo (No. 5), RHP Jaden Hamm (No. 7), RHP Troy Melton (No. 10), RHP Joseph Montalvo (No. 17), OF Roberto Campos (No. 20), INF Max Anderson (No. 21), OF Justice Bigbie (No. 25) and RHP RJ Petit (No. 28). Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects list features four Erie players, including Liranzo (No. 5), Hamm (No. 11), Melton (No. 24) and Bigbie (No. 26).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Jack Choate** makes his 11th start of the season and the fourth of his career against the SeaWolves. He last pitched on Saturday against the Senators at The Diamond and was charged with his second straight loss, surrendering four runs over four innings with five strikeouts. In his three previous career starts against Erie, Choate is 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA (11 ER/14.2 IP). On May 13, Choate threw five innings and allowed two runs against the SeaWolves in a loss at The Diamond. In the finale of that series on May 18, he allowed four runs over five innings in a no-decision. Last year, Choate spent most of the season with High-A Eugene, going 1-3 with a 2.90 ERA in 19 outings (18 starts). He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in August and made eight starts for the Flying Squirrels, posting a 1-4 record with a 5.82 ERA to close the season. Choate finished 2024 ranked first among qualified, full-season Giants minor-league pitchers in BAA (.231) and WHIP (1.21) while ranking second in ERA (3.79). Choate was selected by the Giants in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Assumption University. He entered 2025 ranked by Baseball America as the No. 28 Giants prospect and No. 27 by MLB.com. **For more on Choate, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Jaden Hamm makes his 11th start of the season and his third against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Friday at Reading and allowed three runs in five innings in a no-decision. He faced the Flying Squirrels on May 13 at The Diamond and worked 4.2 scoreless innings. On May 18 in Richmond, he surrendered four runs over four innings in a no-decision. Hamm spent the 2024 season with High-A West Michigan and went 5-4 with a 2.64 ERA in 24 games (23 starts). He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 11 Tigers prospect and No. 7 by MLB.com. Hamm was selected by the Tigers in the fifth round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Middle Tennessee State.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to catch 28 stolen base attempts this season, which is tied for second among the 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey is tied for second among Double-A catchers with 17 runners caught stealing, which is tied for first in the EL. Morgan is fourth in the Eastern League with 11.

BERI'S BACK: Outfielder/first baseman **Victor Bericoto** returned to the Richmond roster on Tuesday. He was placed on the injured list with Triple-A Sacramento on May 9 and played six games with the ACL Giants on a rehab assignment before returning to the Flying Squirrels. Bericoto opened the season with Richmond and hits .319 with three homers, four doubles and eight RBIs in 13 games before being promoted to the River Cats on April 20. In his Richmond career dating back to 2023, Bericoto has homered 25 times, which is tied with **Frankie Tostado** for the eighth-most in franchise history, two behind a four-way tie for fourth place.

DID I HEAR YOU SAY YOU'RE GOING FAR AWAY AGAIN?: **Bryce Eldridge** was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on Tuesday. He began his season with Richmond on April 22 after missing the start of the season with an injury. He hit a solo home run in his first plate appearance of the year. The 20-year-old first baseman played at four levels in the Giants organization in his first full professional season last year, including nine games with Richmond in September. For 2024 in 116 games, Eldridge hit .291 with 23 homers and 92 RBIs. He is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 20 prospect in baseball. Eldridge was the fifth Virginia-born player to suit up for the Flying Squirrels in franchise history. For his time with Richmond from late-April through last weekend, Eldridge was ranked tied for fourth in the Eastern League in extra-base hits (15), tied for sixth in total bases (64), tied for third in homers (7) and 10th in OPS (.862).

HARRIS TO SAC: Reliever **Trent Harris** was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on Tuesday. He made 13 appearances for the Flying Squirrels this year and in 12 of them he did not allow a run. The only three runs he surrendered this season came on a three-run, walk-off homer on May 20 at Binghamton. Harris struck out 25 batters and walked four over 16 innings of work with the Flying Squirrels. His 14.06 K/9 ranked 10th in the Eastern League (min. 10 IP) and his 39.1 strikeout percentage was fifth-best in the league. Harris played at High Point University before transferring to NCAA DI UNC Pembroke. After signing with the Giants as a non-drafted free agent in 2023, he entered this year rated by MLB.com as the No. 11 prospect in the system.

HELLO, GAVELLO: Catcher/infielder/outfielder **Thomas Gavello** joined the Flying Squirrels from High-A Eugene on May 9. In his Double-A debut on May 10 at Harrisburg, he hit a double on the first pitch he saw in the game. He followed with two hits, including another double, in his second game the following day. On May 29, he hit his first Double-A homer, a two-run shot to right. On Wednesday night in his first plate appearance, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer with two outs in the ninth inning. Since joining Richmond, Gavello has picked at least one hit in 12-of-16 Double-A games he has played, including five doubles, and is batting .364. He has played one game at shortstop, one at third base and 13 games in left field, the first games of his professional career in the outfield.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Seth Lonsway** is ninth in innings pitched and 10th in ERA (3.22). **Jack Choate** is sixth in strikeouts (53). **Joe Whitman** is tied for eighth in strikeouts (51) and 10th in BAA (.227). **John Michael Bertrand** is second in innings pitched (55.2)

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 219 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster features five players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Joe Whitman** (No. 10), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 13), **Sabin Ceballos** (No. 16), **Aeverson Arteaga** (No. 27) and **Jack Choate** (No. 28). **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control in the Giants system. **Adrian Sugastey** is ranked as the top defensive catcher. Arteaga is rated as the best defensive infielder and best infield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including Whitman (No. 7), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27).

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1961: The Richmond Virginians swept a doubleheader against the Toronto Maple Leafs, 2-0 and 3-1, at Parker Field. Jake Gibbs made his professional debut. He had been an All-American quarterback at Ole Miss, later inducted to the College Football Hall of Fame in 1995, and was drafted by the AFL's Houston Oilers and the NFL's Cleveland Browns that year, but opted to sign with the Yankees for a \$100,000 bonus, the largest the team had ever given out at that time. He finished his pro debut doubleheader with five hits, a steal and an RBI. In the first game, Art Ceccarelli threw a shutout and Bill Carr, a Mississippi State alum, hit a two-run homer. In the second game, Gibbs gave Richmond an early lead with an RBI single. With the score tied, 1-1, in the eighth, Pedro Gonzalez and Carr drove in runs to give Richmond a 3-1 lead. **1966:** The Richmond Braves beat the Buffalo Bisons, 5-4, at Parker Field. Down by a run in the bottom of the ninth, Richmond manager Bill Adair brought up pinch-hitter Tommie Aaron, who hit a walk-off, two-run homer. It was Richmond's 12th win in its last 15 games. Jim Beachamp hit an RBI triple in the eighth to close the score to 4-3. **1993:** The Richmond Braves beat the Rochester Red Wings, 8-0, at The Diamond. Ryan Klesko hit a homer in the fourth inning off the speaker tower in center field, estimated between 475 and 490 feet. Klesko, 21 years old and the top power prospect in the minors, was in the middle of trade rumors along with Kent Mercker as the Braves were looking to acquire Fred McGriff from the Padres. Mike Birkbeck and three relievers combined for the shutout. **1998:** The Richmond Braves beat the Toledo Mud Huns, 6-3, at The Diamond. Jamie Arnold, making his Triple-A debut, hit Toledo's Juan Encarnacion with a pitch in the eighth inning. Encarnacion charged the mound and jumped at Arnold spikes-first. Arnold grabbed him from the air, spun him to the ground and got a few punches in. Marty Malloy gave the R-Braves a 3-1 lead with a three-run double in the second inning.
