Turning It Around: Since May 24th, the Syracuse Mets rank sixth in the 20-team International League with a .264 batting average and rank third with 137 runs scored. From the beginning of the season to May 23rd, the Mets were last in the league with a .205 batting average and ranked second to last with 154 runs scored.

Giveaways: Syracuse leads the International League with 73 errors this season. Indianapolis ranks second with 69. The Mets have allowed the third-most unearned runs in the League with 47 of 348 total runs allowed being unearned. Indianapolis leads the lead with 62 unearned runs allowed out of 313 total runs. Norfolk ranks third with 65 errors and second having allowed 51 unearned runs out of 352 total runs.

Streaking: Travis Blankenhorn has reached base in 22 of his last 26 games, including hits in 19 of 26. During his last 26 games, Blankenhorn is hitting .298 (28-for-94) with 11 RBIs, two home runs, seven doubles, seven walks, 26 strikeouts, and a .353 on-base percentage.

From the beginning of the season to May 11th, Blankenhorn hit .167 with 12 RBI, 4 homers, three doubles, four walks, 28 strikeouts, and a .216 on-base percentage.

Power Surge: Since May 2nd, Mark Vientos is hitting .323 (31 for-96), with 25 RBIs, ten home runs, four doubles, nine walks and a .393 on-base percentage in 24 games. Vientos was on Syracuse's 7-day Injured List from June 3rd until he was activated on June 12th, hitting four home runs in his first three games back.

From the beginning of the season to May 1st, Vientos was hitting .164 (9-for-55) with seven RBIs, a home run, four doubles, a triple, nine walks, 22 strikeouts, and a .288 on-base percentage in 18 games.

Do the Palka: Since reaching a season-low batting average of .205 on May 28th, Daniel Palka has reached base in 18 consecutive games. During this stretch, the 30-year-old is hitting .375 (27-for-72) with 20 RBIs, five home runs, six doubles, 12 runs scored, eight walks, 20 strikeouts, and a .438 on-base percentage. Palka's five hits on Tuesday were a career high.

From the beginning of the season to April 29th, Palka hit .288 (15-for-52) with 20 RBIs, six home runs, five doubles, 13 runs scored, 11 walks, 12 strikeouts, and a .413 on-base percentage.

From April 30th to May 28th, Palka hit .150 (12-for-80) with seven RBIs, four home runs, ten runs scored, nine walks, 27 strikeouts, and a .236 on-base percentage.

Smith Shines: Dominic Smith has hits in 11 of the 13 games he has played with Syracuse since joining the Triple-A Mets on May 31st. Smith is hitting .291 (16-for-55) with nine RBIs, two home runs, five doubles, and a .361 on-base percentage with Syracuse.

Timelier Hitting: The Syracuse Mets are 15th in the league hitting with runners in scoring position out of 20 teams with a .245 batting average with runners at second and/or third. Syracuse has been trending better the last four series:

- Spent the entirety of the 2021 season pitching with the Pittsburgh Pirates.

- Appeared in 361 career MLB games (233 starts) over a 13-year career.
- Named an All-Star during the 2010 season while pitching with Oakland. He put up borderline Cy Young Award-worthy statistics that season, finishing the campaign with an 18–8 record and an ERA of 2.97.
- A member of the Chicago Cubs bullpen during the 2016 season. Did not make any appearances during the postseason, but was still given a World Series after making 50 appearances during the regular season.
- Had a resurgent season with the San Francisco Giants during the COVID-shortened, 2020 season. Made 11 appearances (six starts), posting an ERA of 3.24 in 25.0 innings with 31 strikeouts.
- Born and raised in California. Attended Vista High School and committed to Dartmouth College before eventually signing with the A's.
- Won a bronze medal while pitching for Team USA during the 2008 Beijing Olympics.
- He ranks among the top 20 active pitchers in career victories

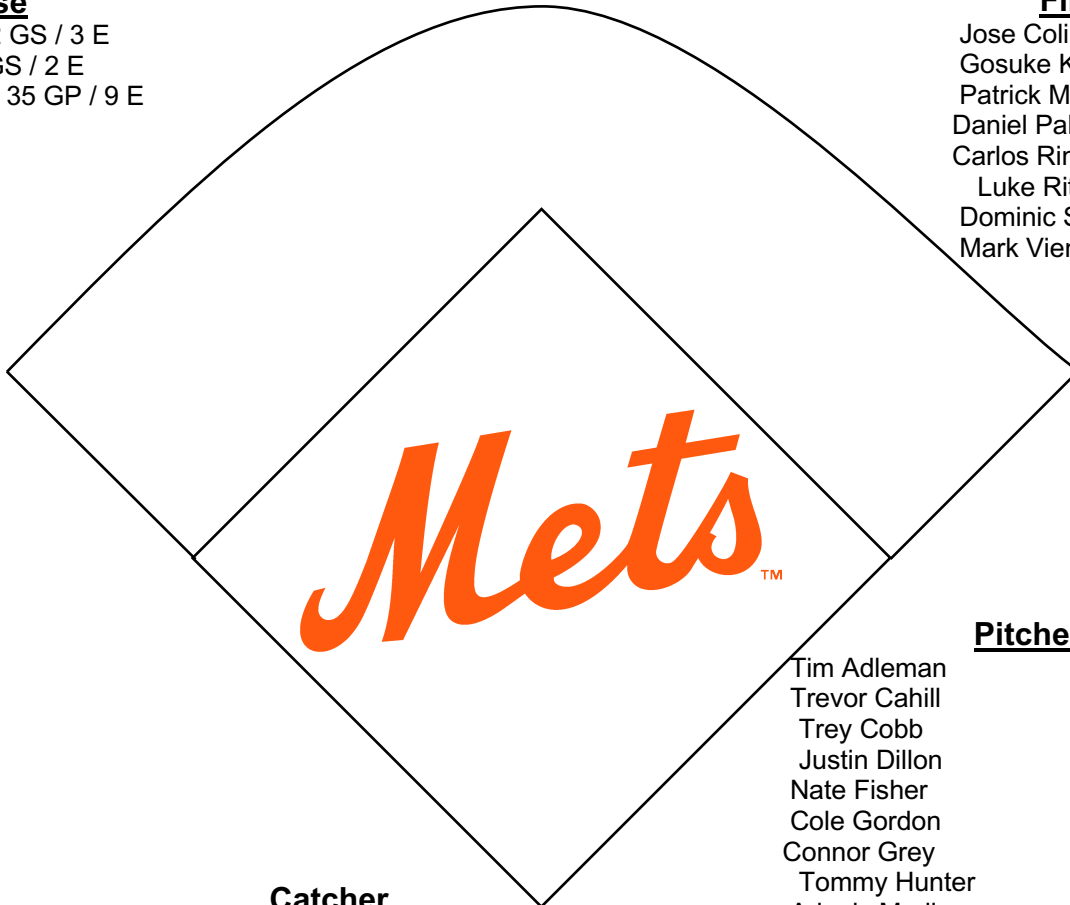
